Astronomia-Astronomy Club (Department of Physics and Electronics)

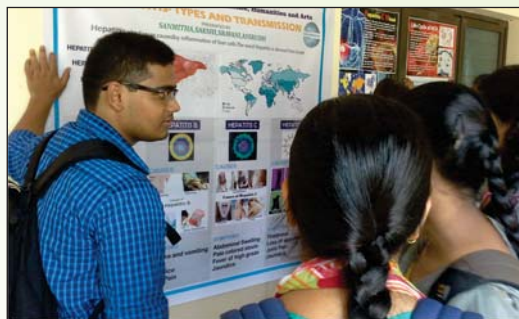
- ◆ The Astronomy club-Astronomia- was established in 2013.

Annual Lecture Series

Gyanatarangini Vyakyanamala was organized on 27 March 2015 for post graduate students of Microbiology, Biochemistry and Computer Science. Eminent scientists and academicians addressed the students, giving them an insight into various fields of their expertise.

The inaugural session began with the gracious presence of Chief Guest Padmasree D. Balasubramanian, Director of Research, LV Prasad Eye Institute, Hyderabad; Dr. S. Venkataraman from ADRIN, Department of Space, Hyderabad; Vice Chairman J.L.N.Sastry; Hon. Code of Conduct

Code of Conduct

- ◆ Students must be regular and punctual for lectures, practicals, seminars and other such academic activities.
- ◆ Students are required to pursue a regular course of study before being permitted to appear for the Annual Examination. A regular course of study includes Attendance of not less than 75% of the lectures and practicals held. This will be strictly enforced.
- ◆ The College may condone a 10% deficiency in attendance in cases where students have participated in Sports/NCC, or on medical grounds subject to producing a medical certificate.
- ◆ Attendance will be computed on a monthly basis.
- ◆ Students are advised to be regular to the morning assembly.
- ◆ The college aims at upholding the highest standard of Discipline. Students must adhere to decorum and discipline on the campus.
- ◆ “Ragging” is strictly prohibited. If any student indulges in any form of ragging, he/she will be summarily rusticated from the college. Further, the student will be liable to penalty as directed by the Government of A.P. Act no 26, dated 4th July, 1997, which bans ragging within and outside any educational institution in the state.
- ◆ Students must not cause damage to any property on the campus and should not indulge in objectionable practices such as defacing walls, damaging furniture and tampering with fittings. Strict action will be taken in case of any such damage caused.
- ◆ Cheating, forgery and furnishing of false certificates are serious offences.
- ◆ Library rules must be honoured.
- ◆ Smoking, consumption of alcohol/intoxicating drugs, eve-teasing and speeding of vehicles on the campus are strictly prohibited.
- ◆ Outsiders must not be invited to the campus without permission. Students who do so will be penalized.
- ◆ The college must be kept posted with change of address, if any, whether local or permanent.
- ◆ Students whose conduct, attendance or progress is not satisfactory
 - (a) Will not be allowed to appear for the Annual Examination
 - (b) are also liable to be asked to leave the college.
- ◆ Students are expected to possess the prescribed textbooks, laboratory record books, etc.
- ◆ Any act of disobedience and misconduct will be dealt with severely by the college authorities and the matter will be communicated to the parents/guardian.

P.G. Courses : Admissions are done by the Director of Admissions, Osmania University, Hyderabad, through a common entrance test conducted by Osmania University (except MBA). Admissions to MBA are done by the convener ICET, except NRI / Management Quota.

U.G. Courses :

- Admission to B.Com. (Hons) is through an entrance examination conducted by the Department of Commerce, OU.
