This prestigious accreditation signifies that the university meets the highest standards of quality and excellence in education, research, and student support. 

1. Level 1 Universities in Australia - Top Global Rankings

Globally, level 1 universities in Australia rank among the top 200 universities. These universities may differ in their ranking positions based on the ranker. Yet, the list of level 1 universities in Australia is similar for both QS and THE, which include the above-given top 10 universities in the list irrespective of their ranking position. 2. Level 1 Part of Eminent Go8:

Known as the oldest and the most distinguished set of universities, Go8 universities in Australia or the Group of Eight, is constituted of the following Australian universities:

- · Australian National University
- The University of Melbourne
- The University of Sydney
- The University of New South Wales (UNSW)
- · The University of Queensland
- Monash University



- · University of Western Australia
- · University of Adelaide

These Go8 Universities of Australia are research universities that receive 71% of the grant each year under Category 1. With their research, these universities generate USD 24.5 billion annually and contribute to the Australian economy. Admissions at Go8 are moderately easy; hence, they admit around 425,000 students annually across all eight universities. Thus, competition may be slightly tougher, but getting through these universities is worthwhile.

3. Quality Education at Level 1 Universities in Australia

These level-one universities in Australia are recognised for their high-quality education, with a focus on research. Level 1 universities in Australia have a reputation for their:

- Advanced curriculum
- Syllabi and course structure because they are designed in a modern manner
- The subject combinations are defined for understanding the industrial-level or employer-level skilling.
- Hence, students studying in Australia will learn based on current industry market trends or employer expectations.

Thus, the quality of education is high and dynamic with the changing trends at level-one universities in Australia, which is one more reason why Indian students should study in Australia at these universities.

4. High Employability Rates at Level 1 Australian Universities

Level 1 universities in Australia consistently rank among the top for producing highly employable graduates. As per the graduate employability data for 2025, THE ranks the following different Australian level 1 universities in this category:

In 2025, THE ranked only 09 Australian universities for its graduate employability rankings, out of which only 06 Level 1 universities made it to the list. Thus, these level 1 Australian universities have proved their mettle in the employability rankings also globally, which is another reason to study at level 1 universities in Australia.

5. Top Courses & Avg Tuition at Level 1 Universities in Australia

Apart from the traditional course options, like Management, Engineering & Tech, Science, Humanities and Arts related courses, level 1 universities also offer short courses in Australia. Students apply for admission to these courses across Go8 universities and other top universities in Australia. The cost of education in Australia varies for each level of study. Check out the course level-wise fees below:
