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MHT CET 2024 Score: The State CET Cell, Maharashtra has released the MAH CET score normalisation process through which candidates' performance across exam sessions is evaluated on the same scale. Check how will MHT CET 2024 score be normalised here



MHT CET 2024 Score Normalisation Process Released

MHT CET 2024 Normalisation Process: The Maharashtra CET Cell has released the normalisation process to ensure that every candidate is assessed on the same scale and is not disadvantaged due to the difficulty level of the exam. As MHTCET is held in multiple shifts. They will



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receive various sets of questions across different shifts, and despite efforts to maintain consistency, the difficulty of these MHT CET question papers may vary. To address this, the normalisation method will be used.

MHT CET 2024 exam dates have been announced. As per the schedule, the MHT CET exam for Engineering will be conducted from May 2, 3, 4, 9, 10, 11, 15, 16 & 17 while the MHT CET Pharmacy exam will be held on April 22, 23, 24, 27, 28, 29 & 30, 2024. Those appearing for MHT CET can check the score normalisation process.

How MHT CET Result 2024 will be calculated by using the normalisation process?

Normalisation is a standard method used to compare MHTCET scores from tests conducted in multiple shifts, similar to practices in other major educational exams in India. The CET Cell will calculate percentile scores for candidates based on their performance relative to others. Candidates' scores will be converted into a scale from 0 to 100.

A candidate's percentile score indicates the percentage of candidates who scored below that particular score in the exam. These scores will be precise up to five decimal places to reduce the occurrence of ties. The examination MHT CET results for each session is prepared in the form of

- Raw Scores
- Percentiles Scores separately for each of the three subjects (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry) and the total

The candidate's Percentile Score will be determined using the following formula:



$$\text{Total Percentile (T1P)} = 100 \times \frac{\text{No. of candidates appeared from the session with raw score equal to or less than T1 score}}{\text{Total no of candidates appeared in the session}}$$

$$\text{Mathematics Percentile (M1P)} = 100 \times \frac{\text{No. of candidates appeared from the session with raw score equal to or less than M1 score in Mathematics}}{\text{Total no of candidates appeared in the session}}$$

$$\text{Physics Percentile (P1P)} = 100 \times \frac{\text{No. of candidates appeared from the session with raw score equal to or less than P1 score in Physics}}{\text{Total no of candidates appeared in the session}}$$

$$\text{Chemistry Percentile (C1P)} = 100 \times \frac{\text{No. of candidates appeared from the session with raw score equal to or less than C1 score in Chemistry}}{\text{Total no of candidates appeared in the session}}$$
