## How to score 600 in NEET?

If you are aiming for more than 600 marks in NEET exam. The first and foremost thing is you should believe that it is possible to achieve this high score. When you start preparing for an examination religiously, chances are you will clear the examination in one attempt. As in the case of [NEET](#), if you know what to study and how to study, you will clear NEET 2026 on your first attempt. There is an abundance of write-ups on [NEET preparation](#). However, if you are someone with big dreams and want to score more than 600 in NEET 2026, you need something extra. This article focuses on the 'something extra', that is, tips that will ensure that you get your perfect score.

- Start studying with the NCERT textbooks, especially for Biology, because almost all of the questions asked in NEET exam refer directly to topics from these books.
- Prepare your time plan for studying.



- You should have a plan that gives you time to study all three subjects each day (Physics, Chemistry, and Biology).
- In addition to doing this, you should also do previous year NEET exams' questions and complete practice/mock tests to improve your speed and accuracy.

## How to Get 600+ Marks in NEET?

### Tip # 01: Start your preparation early

Look back at each of your mistakes after every mock test; this will help you identify areas that need to be upgraded/revised. Remember, when preparing for the NEET exam, the goal is not to memorize answers to questions, but instead to truly understand the concepts of the exam, especially those regarding Physics and Physical Chemistry. It may also help to write down short notes for easy studying of material. Finally, be consistent with all aspects of studying, control your stress, and have good habits (e.g., proper diet, sleep, exercise) to get the best out of yourself on the day of the NEET exam.

Students should start the preparation early. To get high marks something more than 600, they need to go through the syllabus properly. It is advisable to start NEET preparation from Class 11. This will give you two years to prepare for this entrance test. You will also get ample time to prepare revision notes. So, all those who started early have an advantage here.

### Tip # 02: Realistic goals

Make realistic goals towards achieving more than 600 marks. When you prepare a timetable



for the NEET exam preparation, comprise all activities which should not be performed simultaneously. If one comes after spending 10 hours in school, they cannot plan for a self study of more than 12 hours. It is better to make realistic goals which can help you stay motivated and focused. When you achieve your realistic goals it also keeps you positive.

### Tip # 03 - Know the syllabus

It is very important to know the syllabus well for preparing for the NEET exam. You cannot get high score without knowing the entire syllabus. Many students think that syllabus for CBSE exam and NEET are same. But this is not true, they may be overlapping but the syllabus for NEET is more elaborate. If your aim is to get 87 per cent of the questions right, you cannot afford to miss important chapters while preparing. Cover the complete [NEET syllabus 2026](#) before starting to practice.

### Tip # 04: Identify weak spots

You should identify the topics in syllabus in which you are weak. Then prioritise these topics irrespective of their weightage. Dedicating more time to the weak topics will help you analyse the pitfalls. Work on these and you will not have any more weaknesses and eventually plan on how to score 600 in NEET.

### Tip # 05: Mock tests

NEET mock tests and sample papers are available in abundance online. It is very important for students to solve these to get good marks in the NEET exam. To get high marks in this exam you need to practice as many mock tests as possible. Find mistakes which you are committing again and again and try to find the key areas where you are losing marks. The aim is to minimise the negative marking. However, getting the [NEET mock test](#) as per the latest pattern may be challenging. You may request your mentors to design the mock test paper as per the latest pattern, or you can modify the sections as per the new pattern and solve those accordingly.



## Tip # 06: Be true to yourself

An unbiased analysis of your preparation will help you understand your weaknesses. You must, at any point, be true to yourself about your preparation. If you have not read some chapter properly, you should know that here you need to focus more on those chapters so that you will not miss out on any questions.

## Tip # 07: Be consistent



Consistency is what transforms an average into excellence

The last and most important tip of all is to be consistent. It is essential to stick to your timetable no matter what. You may reduce the number of hours that you spend on self-study for a day, but you must never skip it. Procrastinating will only add to the pile of things that you need to complete before the examination and will only add stress.

NEET exam has a total of 180 questions. All these questions are of +4 marks each. There is also negative marking in the exam. If you can complete 150 correct answers, you can get more than 600 marks in exam. It is better that if you are not confirmed don't attempt a question because to compensate for negative marking, you need five more correct answers.
