Handy tips for preparation of MAT/ATMA 2020

1. Read, understand and apply

The most important step in preparation for any exam is to read an idea carefully, know it inside out and check out to use it in real-world situations. Add that to the limited time you get to answer a question and you discover yourself to be efficient with all the answers that you give. Remember, knowing an idea is straightforward but having a thorough knowledge of it increases your IQ generally, thus saving you time during exams.

2. Notes



Many people find it time-consuming to form notes of what they read and instead find yourself browsing every book they referred just before the clock starts ticking. Keeping a journal of straightforward notes with headings and subheadings of your topics is enough to remind the concept you observed. confirm to possess your share of notes ready before the exam for efficient revising.

3. **Practice**

Of the five sections that MAT covers, four of them require rigorous practice to save lots of time during exams. within the MAT exam pattern, there are a complete of five major but different sections. 4. **Solve sample papers**

Search for sources that provide with sample question papers of MAT or previous years' question

5. **Crash courses**

6. **Stay focussed**

7. Time management

However, you'll also leave some easy inquiries to be solved one by one in between a couple of difficult ones to avoid frustration during exams. Also, before you attempt the difficult questions, mentally calculate the quantity of your time left, the number of inquiries to be attempted and divide them equally so that majority of some time isn't spent on one difficult question.
