### **How to Prepare for RRB NTPC General Awareness?:**

The General Awareness section is one of the **most scoring sections in RRB NTPC and carries the maximum marks**. To prepare for the RRB NTPC General Awareness section, candidates should read newspapers and magazines to stay updated with current affairs. Candidates should watch the news to increase their knowledge of current affairs. **Take notes of news on climate change, political steps, governance, historical inventions, scientific inventions, economy, polity, science and technology, and sports, etc.** Stay updated with national and international events. Candidates must take one or two mock tests for RRB NTPC exam to increase speed and accuracy. Static GK forms an important part of the General Awareness section and invests 30 to 45 minutes daily on Current Affairs. For RRB NTPC General Awareness, candidates need to remember a lot of information and revise daily. Allocate at least one hour daily for RRB NTPC General Awareness. Candidates must prepare topics such as information on books and authors, countries, capitals and currencies, awards, honours and recognition, etc. Candidates must
