Agency (NTA) on December 15. NEET UG 2023 exam will be conducted on May 7. The NEET 2023 registration date has not been announced yet. The [NEET 2023 notification](#), along with other information such as application dates, eligibility criteria, exam pattern, exam cities, etc. will be released soon, in the first week of March. Earlier, NTA officials had mentioned that the NEET 2023 application form would be released by February-end, but it was not released till the end of the month. As per the latest speculation, the NEET UG application process 2023 will commence in the first week of March. NTA has still not announced the NEET 2023 application date officially.

The removal of the upper age limit and inclusion of [BSc Nursing](#) courses through NEET has made the biggest and sole medical entrance exam to be even more coveted. Generally, students start preparing right after their Class 10 or even before that. Being the highly competitive exam that NEET is, you need to start preparing at least two years in advance. As [NEET 2023 date](#) has been announced and a few months are left for the exam, students must be focusing on the exam preparation in full fervour. Candidates who appeared for NEET last year and have decided to drop the year, should also gear up and not lose any time to prepare for NEET UG 2023.



After the announcement of the NEET UG 2023 date, a number of students have requested NTA to postpone the exam date. The main reasons for this request are few months left for the exam, ongoing counselling process, among others. However, NTA or MHRD has not responded to the postponement request yet. Hence, it is expected that NTA will not postpone the NEET 2023 exam date.

## NEET UG 2023 Eligibility Criteria

Below mentioned are the basic or primary eligibility criteria for NEET 2023.



- Candidates must have attained the age of 17 years at the time of admission or will attain the same by December 31, 2023. Accordingly, the minimum date of birth of candidates should be December 31, 2006.
- Candidates should be of either Indian origin, NRI, or Overseas Citizens of India category.
- Applicants should have passed or appeared in the Class 12 Board exam in the Science stream with Physics, Chemistry and Biology as core subjects.
- Candidates should secure a minimum aggregate of 50 per cent and 45 per cent (Reserved category candidates).

## NEET UG 2023 Application Form

NTA will release [NEET 2022 application form](#) online. NEET UG 2023 application process starts with registration, followed by filling details in the application form, uploading documents, and paying the application fee. Candidates will have to register first to submit the application form for NEET 2023. Registration for NTA NEET 2023 will start most likely in the first week of March. The whole application process will be held online for the exam. Candidates are advised to check the eligibility criteria before applying for NEET 2023 exam. As part of registration, candidates will have to provide basic details such as name, date of birth, nationality, gender etc. Candidates should have a valid email Id and mobile number for registration. After filling in the details in the application form for NEET 2023, candidates will have to pay the fee online to complete the process. NTA opens the application correct window to modify certain details in the NEET 2023 application form. In case a candidate changes the category during the application, the application fee will also be impacted and he/she will have to pay the extra fee amount, if applicable.

The [NEET exam pattern](#) and structure underwent several changes in the past two years. While the entire structure changed in the year 2021, the duration was increased by 20 minutes in 2022. It is expected that the NEET 2023 exam pattern will remain the same. Let us take a look at the highlights of the NEET 2023 pattern.

## NEET 2023 Preparation

[NEET preparation](#) is a long-term method and aspirants generally start preparing two to three years in advance. They first start by completing the Class 11 syllabus followed by the Class 12 syllabus. According to the toppers, since the syllabus is similar to the Board exams, it is not much of a challenge to balance Board exam preparation with that of NEET preparation. A majority of students enrol on coaching institutes to prepare for the exam, but there are exceptions as well. Some of the preparation tips as suggested by experts and toppers are given below.

- Know the exam pattern and structure of NEET
- Assess the topic and chapter-wise weightage of the NEET syllabus
- Select the books and study materials to refer for NEET
- Take ample mock tests and solve previous years' NEET question papers
- Revise

## NEET Question Papers

As NEET is conducted in a paper-pencil-based mode, test-takers are given the hard copy of the question papers at the end of the exam to be



carried out in the exam hall. NTA also uploads previous years' question papers on the official website of the exam for each code and set. [NEET 2022 question papers](#) were of the sets Q, R, S and T. Each set had six sub-sets. The question papers are available in 13 languages. Solving previous years' question papers is a must for the aspirants and is an integral part of the preparation process.

Solving previous years' NEET question papers is one of the most critical aspects of preparation. Even though the exam pattern and structure have undergone changes over the last couple of years, the question types and topics can give much-needed exposure to the question types. Hence, practising from the previous years' NEET question papers is a must if you wish to excel your performance.

NEET 2023 will be conducted in 13 languages, namely, English, Hindi, Urdu, Punjabi, Assamese, Bengali, Odia, Gujarati, Marathi, Kannada, Telugu, Tamil and Malayalam. The exam will be conducted in over 500 cities across India and abroad.

Conducted once a year, NEET is taken over 15 lakh candidates each year. For NEET 2022, over 18 lakh candidates applied and 95 per cent of them appeared for the exam. NEET is the entrance exam for [MBBS](#), [BDS](#), [BSc Nursing](#), [BAMS](#), [BHMS](#), [BUMS](#), [BSMS](#) and other medical courses offered in India.

## FAQs Regarding NEET 2023

### **Q: When will the NEET 2023 registration process begin?**

A: The NEET 2023 registration process is expected to begin in the first week of March. Although there is no official notification on the NEET 2023 application date, as per media reports it likely that the application process will begin soon.

### **Q: In which month will NEET 2023 be conducted?**

A: NEET 2023 will be conducted on May 7, same as the speculated date. Although the schedule for NEET was delayed for the past two years, NTA has been endeavouring to conduct the exam in its original or pre-pandemic timeline from 2022 onwards.

### **Q: When will NTA release the NEET 2023 notification?**

A: The NEET 2023 exam date has been announced on December 15. NTA is expected to release the detailed NEET 2023 notification by the first week of March.

### **Q: How many students will appear for NEET 2023?**

A: Approximately 18 lakh candidates are expected to appear for NEET 2023. As per the previous year's data, over 18 lakh candidates had applied for NEET 2022 exam.

### **Q: What should be my date of birth for appearing in NEET 2023?**

A: As per the NEET eligibility criteria, candidates should be minimum 17 years of age as on December 31, 2023. Hence, their date of birth should be at least January 1, 2006.

### **Q: Will NEET 2023 be conducted twice?**

A: Although NTA and the Ministry of Education were mulling the idea to conduct NEET twice a year, it has not been materialised yet. NEET 2023 will also be conducted once a year, as per the date announced. NTA has confirmed that NEET 2023 will be conducted once a year through an RTI



response.

**Q: Will the NEET 2023 exam pattern and syllabus remain the same?**

A: It is expected that the NEET 2023 exam pattern and syllabus will remain the same as the last year. In case any change is introduced, it will be stated in the NEET 2023 information brochure.

**Q: Will NEET be discontinued from next year?**

A: NTA has announced exam date for NEET 2023, which means that the exam would be conducted for the academic year 2023-24. Students who are preparing for NEET 2023 must continue the preparation as per plan and do not get distracted or diverted from their goals.

**Q: Will there be a common entrance exam for NEET, JEE and CUET from next year?**

A: UGC Chairman M Jagadesh Kumar has indicated the idea to conduct a common entrance exam for NEET, JEE and other top undergraduate level common entrance exams. However, the idea is at a nascent stage and no official announcement has been made yet. Moreover, NTA has announced that the dates of NEET 2023, JEE Main and CUET, inferring that these exams will be conducted separately and will not be combined.
