Admission to the programmes offered by this university is merit and entrance-based.

St. Xavier's College Mumbai Admission Process 2021

Candidates seeking admission to the courses offered by St. Xavier's College, Mumbai should submit the application form before the last defined date of application form submission as the college doesn't accept late applications. Candidates should also note that application form will be considered complete only



when the candidate has submitted the full fees for the academic year. Here are some highlights regarding the admission process of the programmes offered at St. Xavier's College Mumbai:

UG courses

- Candidates for BA, BSc and BCom are selected on the basis of marks scored in Class 12
- BCom programme selection procedure involves one extra step of personal interview conducted by the college itself. The interview round is done by Vice Principal of Commerce department or his representative
- For BMS and BMM, candidates are selected on the basis of marks obtained in Class 12 and entrance exam conducted by the University

Certificate and Diploma courses

- Admission to Certificate and Diploma programmes is based on the merit in the last qualifying exam and performance in interview

PG courses

- Admission to the MPP programme is based on the scores obtained in entrance exam which is also



conducted by the college

- For MA programme, candidates are selected on the basis of marks scored in the entrance test and personal interview round conducted by the college itself
- Selection to the MSc programme is based on the marks obtained in graduation

PhD course

- For PhD programme, candidates are selected on the basis of marks scored in Pre Entrance Test (PET) conducted by the University of Mumbai

St. Xavier's College Mumbai UG Admission 2021

At UG level, the college offers BA, BSc, BCom, BMM and BMS programme. The duration of these programmes varies from course to course. Detailed admission criteria for each of these programme is mentioned below:

St. Xavier's College Mumbai Admission 2021: BA, BSc

St. Xavier's College, Mumbai offers full-time three-year BSc (IT) and BA programmes, each consisting of six semesters. There are no entrance exams for BSc (IT)



and BA programmes, candidates are selected on the basis of marks scored in Mathematics at Class 12. BSc and BA programmes have a total seat intake of 360 students each. Eligibility criteria for BA and BSc programme is listed below:

St. Xavier's College Mumbai BCom Admission 2021

St. Xavier's College, Mumbai offers BCom programme with a course duration of three years, each year consisting of two semesters. The total seat intake for BCom programme 240 students. Admission to BCom programme comprises of two steps in which the first step involves filling the application form and submitting it at the college office (Commerce Section). Candidates, for BCom programme are shortlisted on the basis of marks scored in Class 12. In the second step, shortlisted candidates have to appear for an interview with Vice-



Principal of Commerce department or his representative.
The below-mentioned table enlists the eligibility criteria for BCom programme:

BCom	A minimum of 45% aggregate in Class 12 in Maharashtra board or any other recognised board

St. Xavier's College Mumbai Admission 2021: BMM, BMS

The total course duration for BMS and BMM programme is three years consisting of six semesters. Admission to BMS and BMM programme is based on marks obtained in the entrance test and Class 12 boards. Entrance test has a weightage of 60 per cent, whereas, Class 12 marks has a weightage of 40 per cent. The total seat intake for BMS and BMM programme is 60 students each. Candidates must also satisfy the below-mentioned eligibility criteria to qualify for admission to these programmes:

St. Xavier's College Mumbai PG Admission 2021

Apart from UG courses, St. Xavier's College, Mumbai also offers three different PG programmes which are MA, MPP, and MSc. The course duration for each of these programmes is two years. Given below are the details regarding course-wise eligibility, seat intake and selection criteria.

St. Xavier's College Mumbai MA Admission 2021

The college offers MA in two different specialisations with a total seat intake of 60 students. Admission to this programme is done on the basis of merit in entrance test score and interview score conducted by the college itself. The entrance exam consists of an essay section and objective section. In essay section, candidates have to write an essay on a set of given topics whereas, for objective section, candidates have answer the MCQs correctly. Candidates must also satisfy the below-mentioned eligibility criteria to qualify for admission:

St. Xavier's College Mumbai MPP Admission 2021

For Master of Public Policy (MPP), candidates are selected on the basis of marks scored in the entrance exam. The entrance exam consists of questions from two topics which are listed below:

Case study: Candidates have to answer a few questions based on a policy-oriented case study.

Essay: Candidates have to write an essay on a topic selected from a set of given topics from various disciplines.

The below table enlists the eligibility criteria for MPP programme:

St. Xavier's College Mumbai offers MSc in five different specialisations. For MSc programme, candidates are selected on the basis of merit in the graduation scores. Candidates must meet the below-mentioned eligibility criteria to qualify for the merit list being prepared by the college for admission:

Apart from the full-time UG and PG programmes, St. Xavier College Mumbai offers six different Diploma and certificate programmes. Admission to these programmes is based on the merit in the last qualifying exam and performance in interview. The candidates need to fulfil the below-mentioned eligibility criteria to qualify the merit list:

St. Xavier's College Mumbai PhD Admission 2021

St. Xavier's College Mumbai offers PhD in three different specialisations. The course duration is of three years and candidates need to complete the course within a maximum time span of six years. Admission to the PhD programme is based on the marks scored PET exam conducted by the University of Mumbai. Given below table enlists the specialisation, seat intake and eligibility criteria:

St. Xavier's College Application Process 2021

Candidates applying for BCom programme, need to pay an application fee of Rs 500, whereas, the application fee for other courses is Rs 820. Admission for all the courses is active till the second week of May. Candidates must apply within the stipulated time by following the steps mentioned below:

For admission to BCom programme:

Step I: Candidates should first visit the admission office of college (commerce section)

Step II: Collect the application form (for BCom programme) by submitting Rs 500 as application fee

Step III: Fill in the correct details as mentioned in Class



10 marksheet with a black ink pen

Step IV: Candidates will be selected on the basis of marks scored in Class 12

Step V: Selected candidates have to then appear for personal interview round with the Vice Principal of the Commerce section or his representative

Step VI: Final selected candidates will be intimated about their selection through SMS and mail (sent to their registered email id)

Application process for all other programmes:

Step I: Visit the official website

Step II: Click on the 'Courses & Admissions' section and further on 'Admission' tab

Step III: You will be redirected to the admission page, fill the application form with correct details, including your guardian details and previous academic qualifications. You must fill the correct details as mentioned in the Class 10 marksheet

Step IV: Conclude the application process by paying the application fee of Rs 820 using debit card/ credit card or net banking



List of documents to be submitted at the time of admission:

For admission, selected candidates are required to be present in-person on the date of admission and, they will have to furnish all the documents mentioned below:

- Class 12 statement of marks
- Baptism certificate (for minority community - Christians)
- Caste certificate (wherever applicable)
- Documentary evidence for special category status
- Passing certificate (required for getting eligibility certificate)
- Migration certificate (required for getting eligibility certificate)

List of documents required for PhD programme:

- Copy of Curriculum Vitae
- Copy of MSc and BSc marksheet
- Copy of PET/ NET/ SET/ MPhil certificate
- Caste certificate (if any)
- NOC letter from the employer, if employed presently



- Approval letter, teaching experience letter and NOC for teaching faculty members for college

The below table states the seat reservation for different categories:

The college also reserves seats for different programmes:

For BA: 50 per cent of total seats are reserved for the Christian minority and Management quota.

For BCom and BSc: 45 per cent of seats are reserved for the Christian minority and 15 per cent for the



Management quota.

For BMS and BMM: A relaxation of 5 per cent will be offered to students belonging to the Christian minority and 10 per cent for students belonging to SC/ST category.

Important FAQs regarding St. Xavier's College Admission

Q. Is there any seat reservation for UG courses offered at St. Xavier's College?

A. For the BA course, 50 per cent of seats are reserved for minority Christian students and management quota. For BCom & BSc courses, 43 per cent of seats are reserved for Christian Minority and 15 per cent for Management Quota.

Q. Does St. Xavier's College offer any kind of scholarships to its students?



A. Yes, under the Government of Maharashtra Scholarship scheme, various scholarships are awarded to students who belong to various backward classes and students domiciled in Mumbai. SC candidates with a family annual income of less than Rs 2 LPA are eligible for a scholarship. VJ / SBC / OBC students with a family annual income of up to Rs 1 LPA can avail of the above scholarship benefits. OBC students with a non-creamy-layer certificate are eligible for scholarships as well.

Q. What is the mode of the application process at St. Xavier's College?

A. The application process of St. Xavier's College, Mumbai is both through online and offline mode. Students can apply and make the payment online for all the courses, except for BCom. The application process for BCom is done through offline mode only.

Q. How many courses are offered at St. Xavier's College Mumbai?

A. St. Xavier's College Mumbai offers a total of 15 courses across the streams of humanities & social sciences, accounting & commerce, mass communication & media, science, business & management sciences, IT



& software, medicine & health sciences, and engineering.

Q. Which are the most popular courses at St. Xavier's College Mumbai?

A. The most popular courses offered under the UG wing are BA, BSc, and BCom and MA under PG wing. Apart from UG and PG courses, the college also offers diploma and certificate courses across multiple specialisations.

Q. How many students are admitted for MA programme at St. Xavier College Mumbai?

A. A total of 60 students are admitted for MA programme.

Q. Does St. Xavier College Mumbai have any seat reservation criteria for Christian minority community?

A. Yes, out of the total management seats, the college reserves half of the remaining management quota seats (50 per cent of 85 per cent of total seats) for Christian minority community for Arts, Science and Commerce field. The total seat intake for Arts and Science programmes is 153 students while for Commerce programme it is 102.

Q. How many students are admitted for BSc IT



programme at St. Xavier College Mumbai?

A. A total of 60 students are given admission to BSc IT programme at St. Xavier College Mumbai.

Q. What is the total seat intake for BMS programme?

A. The total seat intake for BMS programme is 60 students.

Q. Which all documents need to be submitted at the time of admission?

A. Candidates must submit the following documents at the time of admission:

- Class 12 statement of marks
- Baptism certificate (for minority community - Christians)
- Caste certificate (wherever applicable)
- Documentary evidence for special category status
- Passing certificate (required for getting eligibility certificate)
- Migration certificate (required for getting eligibility certificate)
