Guru Nanak Institute of Management, is a private management institute that was established in 1996 in Punjabi Bagh, Delhi. It was established by the Delhi Sikh Gurdwara Management Committee and is affiliated to [Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University \(GGSIPU\)](#).

The Institute offers BCom (Hons), MCA and PGDM programmes in various specialisations, such as Finance, Marketing and Human Resource & Business. The admissions are conducted under the guidance of GGSIPU. It also offers an education loan facility to the economically weak students in collaboration with Punjab and Sind Bank.

## **Guru Nanak Institute of Management Admission Process 2021: Fast Facts**

The Institute offers a total of three UG, PG and PG diploma programmes. Guru Nanak Institute of Management admission process is conducted online through the official website of the Institute. Admission to all the programmes is entrance-based, and candidates need to secure minimum aggregate in the qualifying exam to apply for any of the programmes. The course-wise details are mentioned below:

### **UG and PG Courses**

- Admission to BCom (Hons) and MCA is based on [IPU CET](#) scores
- Candidates, who have completed Class 12 in any stream, can apply for BCom (Hons)



- A candidate must have completed a bachelor's degree to apply for MCA programme

## PGDM Course

- PGDM admissions are based on [CAT](#) / [MAT](#) scores
- Candidates, who have completed graduation in the relevant stream, can apply for PGDM programme
- Final selection of students is based on the entrance exam scores and their performance in Group Discussion and Personal Interview (GDPI)

## Guru Nanak Institute of Management Exam Dates 2021

The Institute accepts several national-level entrance exams, such as CAT and MAT for PGDM admissions. The admission to UG and PG programmes is based on IPU CET exam. The important exam dates for Guru Nanak Institute of Management admissions are given in the table below:

## Guru Nanak Institute of Management BCom (Hons) Admission 2021

At the UG level, the Institute offers a full-time BCom (Hons) programme. The duration of the programme is three years, divided among six semesters. The intake for the BCom (Hons) course is 60 students every year. This is a full-time programme and candidates need to secure at least 140 credits for the completion of degree. The course curriculum is designed to provide students a wide range of managerial skills, in addition to their core subjects, such as General Business Principles, Accounting, Finance, Business Management, Human Resources, Marketing and Economics. Admission to BCom (Hons) is entrance-based, and candidates are shortlisted based on their entrance exam scores. Below mentioned is eligibility criteria for BCom (Hons):

## Guru Nanak Institute of Management MCA Admission 2021

The Institute offers a full-time MCA programme under affiliation with GGSIPU with a seat intake of 60 students. MCA is offered with a course duration of three years and it is divided into six semesters. The first three semesters provide basic and core concepts of Information Technology, whereas the next two semesters are focused on Web and Networking concepts. The last semester of the curriculum is devoted to internships in leading IT organisations. It also gives an opportunity for students to work on live projects and gain industry experience. MCA admissions are based on IPU CET exam, and final selection of students is based on the marks secured in IPU CET. The eligibility criteria for MCA is mentioned below:

## Guru Nanak Institute of Management PGDM Admission 2021

Apart from the UG and PG programmes, it also offers a PG Diploma in Management with a course duration of two years. It is a full-time programme and is approved by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE). The curriculum of the programme provides continuous academic input combined with constant industry interactions which have resulted in a 100 per cent placement record over the years. It is offered in three different specialisations. Admission to PGDM is based on CAT/ MAT exams. The final selection of students is based on the entrance exam scores and their performance in GDPI.

## Guru Nanak Institute of Management Application Process 2021

Admission to all the programmes is conducted through an online as well as offline mode. Candidates need to fill an application form with a fee of Rs 500 to apply for a particular programme. For offline application process, candidates need to visit the admission office and collect the application form. Follow the below-mentioned steps for the online Guru Nanak Institute of Management application process:

1. Visit the official website of the Institute, [www.gnim.ac.in](http://www.gnim.ac.in)
2. Click on the “Admission Form” under Admission tab
3. Download the application form and fill the required details
4. Submit the application form along with a demand draft
