Mount Carmel College Admission 2021: Dates, Registration, Eligibility, Application Procedure

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Mount Carmel College Bangalore, also known as MCC Bangalore offers UG, PG, PG diploma and doctoral courses approved by UGC. The college is affiliated from Bangalore University and admissions are offered on the basis of merit and interview. The application for PG courses starts in January and application for UG programmes starts in the month of February.

Latest updates:

February 9, 2021: Applications for PG Programme is open now.

February 9, 2021: Applications for UG Programme starts from February 15, 2021.

Applications are invited online and students can fill the form through official website. Interview dates are announced once the application forms are filled. The result of interview is declared immediately after the interview. Students need to submit the course fee on the day of declaration of final results of interview itself. 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MCC Bangalore Admission 2021: Fast Facts

The admission to the UG courses is based on the merit and performance of candidates in the Personal Interview (PI) round. However, for BBA, the candidates need to appear for a college-level entrance test.

UG Courses

- For BA, BSc and BCA programmes, candidates are shortlisted for the PI round based on their marks in Class 12
- BCom admissions are based on scores in **Mount Carmel Management Aptitude Test (MCMAT)** followed by PI round
- BBA admissions are based on scores in MCMAT as



well as candidates' performance in Group Discussion and Personal Interview (GD and PI) round

PG Courses

- Admissions to the PG courses are merit-based

The application dates at MCC Bangalore starts in month of January and February. The application for PG courses starts by end of January and application for UG courses in 2021 starts in second week of February. Check the table for details:

MCC Bangalore UG Admission 2021

MCC Bangalore offers six full-time programmes at UG level including BCA, BBA, BA, BVoc, BSc, and BCom. UG Students are expected to study one mandatory language



subject (they are required to select the same second language as studied during the last qualifying examination). The eligibility criteria for all the UG programmes is mentioned below:

MCC Bangalore PG Admission 2021

MCC offers four full-time courses at PG level that include MA, MSc, MCA, and MCom. Students pursuing MSc in Tourism Management International Twinning Programme, get a chance to do their second-year studies at **Binary University Malaysia** after completing first-year at MCC. The eligibility criteria for all the PG programmes is mentioned below:

MCC Bangalore Application Process 2021

Candidates need to fill the online application form available at the official website of MCC (www.mccbmr.edu.in). The application forms for UG programmes are available in March every year and applications are accepted through online mode only. The application steps are mentioned below:



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Step 1: Check the official website and go to 'Admission' tab.

Step 2: Click on 'Apply online' tab given below.

Step 3: Fill the application form.

Step 4: Pay the application fee online which is **Rs 600** for UG courses and **Rs 900** for PG courses.

Step 5: Affix a recent passport-size photograph and signature on the form (less than 100 KB in size).

Step 6: Click on 'Final submit' to finally submit your form.

Take a print out of the application form acknowledgement for future communication with MCC Bangalore. Course fee is paid at the time of admission.

MCC Bangalore Admission Documents

Here is a list of documents that a candidate must carry at the time of Interview:

- Admit card of MCC Bangalore Interview
- Mark sheets and certificate of Class 10/ Class 12/ Graduation degree
- Receipt of the payment against application fee



- Two passport-size photographs

Result of interview is announced just after the admission and students are required to pay the course fee immediately to take admission in the respective course.

MCC Bangalore Placements

The recruitment season at Mount Carmel College Bangalore begins in August every year. The placement drive continues till mid-April. In 2020 placement season, large number of top names in industry visited the campus for recruitment, including KPMG, Deloitte, Wipro, Yes Bank, PwC, etc.

The table below represents the overall average, median and the highest salary of Mount Carmel College Bangalore Placements in 2020:

At 21%, the highest share of students was placed in the Education sector. This was followed by Business



Operations and Consulting with 14% and 13% recruitment, respectively.

MCC Bangalore Admission 2021 FAQs

Q. What is the admission process for UG programmes offered by MCC?

A. Admission to the UG programmes is based on a candidate's performance in Personal Interview (PI) round and merit. However, for BBA, candidates need to appear for MCMAT, an entrance test conducted by MCC.

Q. What does MCMAT stand for and what type of questions are there in the test?

A. MCMAT stands for the 'Mount Carmel Management Aptitude Test' which is conducted for admission to the BBA programme. The test includes questions related to Mathematics, English, Reasoning, GK and Current Affairs.

Q. How many specialisations are there under BBA and what is the criteria to be eligible to apply?

A. The college offers four specialisations under BBA programme which include HR, Finance, Marketing and International Business (IB). To be eligible to apply, the



candidate must have completed a two-year PUC in Commerce/ Arts/ Science (from Karnataka) or Class 12 (CBSE/ ISC) or equivalent.

Q. What are the skills a candidate must have for admission to BA (Hons) in Communication Studies?

A. According to the eligibility criteria, a candidate should have excellent command over the English language, an interest in current affairs and Media, a creative mind and the ability to work hard.

Q. What all courses and specialisations are offered at PG level?

A. MCC offers four full-time courses at PG level including MA, MSc, MCA, and MCom. The specialisations under each course are mentioned below:

- MCom: Financial Analysis and International Business
- MA: Public Policy (Inter-Disciplinary), Economics and English
- MSc: Biochemistry, Biotechnology, Electronics, Food Science & Nutrition, Mathematics, Computer Science with Data Science, Nano Science & Technology, Botany, Life Sciences, Psychology and Tourism Management International Twinning Programme



- MCA: Computer Application

Q. What are the mandatory documents to carry at the time of admission?

A. Here is a list of documents candidates must carry at the time of admission:

- Admit card of MCMAT and valid scorecard
- Mark sheets of Class 10/ Class 12/ UG/ PG
- Receipt of application fee payment
- Two passport-size photographs

Q. When does the UG application process start at MCC Bangalore?

A. The application forms for UG admission are generally available in March every year.

Q. How much is the fee for BBA programme?

A. The annual fee for the BBA programme is Rs 1.5 lakh.

Q. Is there any application fee charged by the college?

A. Yes, the application fee for UG and PG programmes is Rs 590 and Rs 826, respectively.



Q. Does MCC have any international level programme at PG level?

A. Yes, the college offers MSc in Tourism Management which is an International Twinning programme. Through this programme, students get a chance to do their second-year at Binary University Malaysia after completing their first-year at MCC itself.
