What's new at Mumbai University IDOL?

- Admission is open to BA/BCom/BSc for the 2023-24 July session and the application portal is open till **Jun 30**.
- Admission is also open to MA/MCom/MSc Part-1 for the 2023-24 July session and the application portal is open till **Jun 30**.

Institute of Distance and Open Learning of Mumbai University (Mumbai University IDOL) admissions are offered to the first year, second year and third year for all the UG programmes and in Part-I and Part-II for all PG programmes. The application process for the January 2021 session across all courses is over. Mumbai University IDOL is an institute under Mumbai University that offers multiple distance learning programmes at UG and PG level. [Mumbai University](#) started its correspondence education in 1971 and offers admission based on merit.

Mumbai University IDOL Admission 2023: Highlights

Institute of Distance and Open Learning of Mumbai University admission to all the courses is offered based on a valid score in the qualifying exam except for MCA. Admissions are

offered here in two sessions, i.e. **January and July** for all the courses of IDOL. Candidates seeking admission must visit the official website of the University to apply online. A few Highlights around MU ICOL admission 2021 are listed below:

- Admission to BA, BCom, BSc in CS, BSc in IT and MCA programmes is offered in the First Year (FY), Second Year (SY) and Third Year (TY) at IDOL
- Courses such as MA, MA in Education, MA/MSc in Maths, MSc in Computer Science are offered in Part-I and Part-II each
- Admission to PGDFM and PGDORM programmes is offered at both Sem-I and Sem-II level
- Selection for all UG & PG courses except for MCA is subject to fulfilling the minimum eligibility of the University
- For MCA (FY), the University conducts an **MCA Entrance Test** for admission

Mumbai University IDOL UG Admission 2023

At the undergraduate level, the Institute of Distance and Open Learning of Mumbai University offers all the courses such as BA, BCom, BSc in CS and BSc in IT programmes at FY, SY and TY level. Admission to all these courses is subject to meeting the minimum eligibility criteria as mentioned in the below table:

Course	Eligibility Criteria
BA (FY)	A pass in Class 12 or a 3-year Diploma from a recognised board or University
BA (SY)	Passed FY BA with ATKT in not more than 2 subjects from a recognised University
BA (TY)	- Passed FY BA and SY BA from a recognised University - ATKT in not more than 2 subjects during SY BA and completely pass in FY BA
BCom (FY)	A pass in Class 12 or a 3-year Diploma from a recognised board or University
BCom (SY)	Passed FY BCom with ATKT in not more than 2 subjects from a recognised University
BCom (TY)	- Passed FY BCom and SY BCom from a recognised University - ATKT in not more than 2 subjects during SY BCom and completely pass in FY BCom
BSc in Computer Science (FY)	A pass in Class 12 with Mathematics and Science



BSc in Computer Science (SY)	A pass in FY BSc in CS or from a recognised University
BSc in Computer Science (TY)	A pass in FY and SY of BSc in CS or equivalent exam
BSc in IT (FY)	A pass in Class 12 with Mathematics and Statistics
BSc in IT (SY)	A pass in FY BSc in IT or a 3-year Diploma from a recognised University
BSc in IT (TY)	A pass in FY and SY of BSc in IT or equivalent exam

Mumbai University IDOL PG Admission 2023

Mumbai University IDOL offers a number of courses at the postgraduate level such as MA, MA in Education, MCom, MA/MSc in Maths, MSc in Computer Science MCA, PGDFM and PGDORM. Out of all these, MA, MCom and MSc programmes are offered in Part-I and Part-II, MCA is available at FY, SY and TY level and PGDFM & PGDORM programmes are offered at both Sem-I and Sem-II level.

- Admission to all PG courses except for MCA is offered to candidates meeting with the University-set
- For MCA (FY), the University conducts an 'MCA Entrance Test' for admission. For the remaining MCA programmes, admission is granted on the basis of a candidate passing the previous year.

Course	Eligibility Criteria
MA (Part-I)	A bachelor's degree in any subject
MA (Part-II)	A pass in MA (Part-I)
MA in Education (Part-I)	- Must have passed B.Ed / BA with Education as one of the subjects - Students who've passed B.P.Ed, B.Ed (Physical), B.Ed (Special Education) are NOT eligible for admission
MA in Education (Part II)	A pass in MA in Education (Part-I)

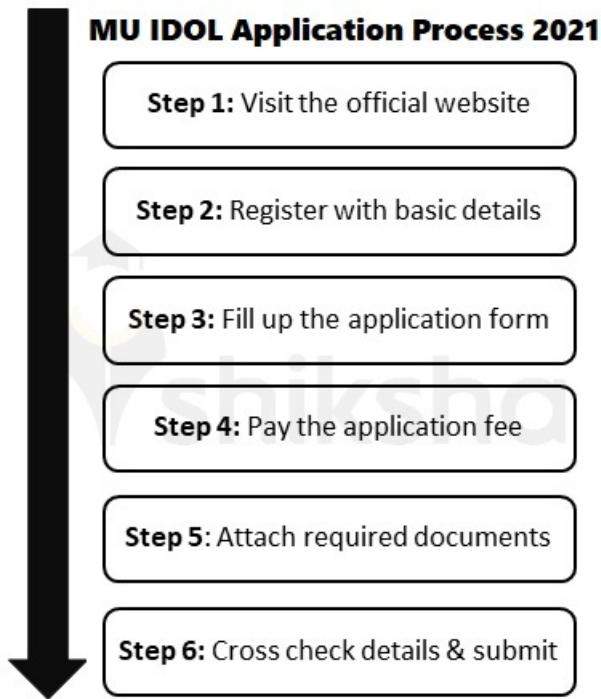


MCom (Part-I)	Candidates must have a BCom/ BMS/ BBI/ BAF degree (BMM only for Management specialisation)
MCom (Part-II)	A pass in MCom (Part-I)
MA/MSc in Maths (Part-I)	A pass in TY BA/ BSc with Mathematics as a major subject
MA/MSc in Maths (Part-II)	Candidates who've passed MA/MSc in Maths (Part-I) can apply
MSc in IT (Part-I)	Candidate must have passed BSc with IT/ Computer Science/ Maths/ Physics/ Statistics/ Electronics OR BCS OR BE (in any branch)
MSc in IT (Part-II)	A pass in MSc in IT (Part-I)
MSc in Computer Science (Part-I)	A pass in BSc with Statistics OR Physics OR Mathematics OR BSc in Computer Science OR BSc IT OR BCS OR BE (in any branch)
MSc in Computer Science (Part-II)	Candidates must have passed MSc in Computer Science (Part-I)
MCA (FY)	A UG degree in any specialisation with a minimum of 45% aggregate (40% for reserved category candidates) and Mathematics at Class 12 or higher level
MCA (SY)	A pass in MCA FY
MCA (TY)	A pass in MCA FY and TY
PGDFM (Sem-I and Sem-II)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Candidates must have a University degree in any stream - Defence service personnel are admitted even if they are not degree holders

PGDORM (Sem-I and Sem-II)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Candidates must have a University degree in any stream with two years of work experience- Must have recognised professional qualification with least five years of professional experience

Mumbai University IDOL Application Process 2023

Candidates seeking admission to the first year of all the courses must visit the official application portal of Mumbai University for distance education and apply online.



A step-by-step process is mentioned below:

Step 1: Visit the online application portal of Institute of Distance and Open Learning,



University of Mumbai (idoloa.digitaluniversity.ac).

Step 2: Click on the most 'Admission' tab appearing on that page.

Step 3: On the next window that opens up on the screen, click on 'Register'.

Step 4: Fill in the complete registration form and create a 'User-id' and 'Password' which will be further used to fill up the online application form.

Step 5: After filling the registration form, click on 'Submit' and log in with the user-id and password created during registration.

Step 6: Fill up the application form, pay the application pay, attach all the required documents and submit the form.

NOTE: Those seeking admission to SY and TY are required to obtain the application form from IDOL, at Vidyanagari Campus.

List of documents required

- Mark sheet and certificate of Class 10, Class 12
- Date of birth proof
- For second-year admission to courses: Original mark sheet of FY (in case of more than one attempt, student need to scan & upload first and last attempt mark sheet of FY)
- Previous year identity card/ admission form (if applicable)
- Marriage certificate/ gazette notification (for female married students) in case of a change in name

Mumbai University IDOL Admission FAQs

Q. What all courses are offered by Mumbai University IDOL?

A. Mumbai University IDOL offers multiple distance learning programmes at UG and PG level. Some of the courses offered by it include FY BA, SY BA, TY BA, FY BCom, SY BCom, TY BCom, MA Part-I, MA Part-II, MCom Part-I, MCom Part-II, MA/MSc Part-I (Mathematics) and MA/MSc Part-II (Mathematics) among others.

Q. Do students of IDOL get a degree same as regular students?

A. Yes, weightage given to both the degrees is same. Students having Mumbai University's IDOL degree are considered the same as a regular degree student. Another advantage of pursuing a course from MU's IDOL is that students can complete their course along with their job simultaneously. The only thing that they need to do is stay in regular touch with the teachers or a guide through Personal Contact Programmes (PCP).

Q. What is the first half and second half all about at Mumbai University IDOL?



A. There are two semesters - winter semester and summer semester. The first half is known as the winter semester which starts in November and the other one is the summer semester which starts by the end of the winter semester, i.e. in April.

Q. Can a student who passed Class 12 from Science stream get admission to Commerce stream subjects at MU IDOL?

A. Yes, even if the candidate has Mathematics and Geography during Class 12 (Science), he/she can get admission for FY BCom at IDOL.

Q. How many ATKT's are allowed to get admission for the next academic year at MU IDOL?

A. ATKT's in only two papers with an aggregate of 200 marks are allowed to get admission to the next academic year.

Q. When and where do I procure the MU IDOL admission form from?

A. FYBA/ BCom/ BSc and FY MA/ MCom/ MSc admission take place online while for SY courses, the admission forms could be collected from IDOL, at Vidyanageri Campus.

Q. Whom should I contact in case of queries related to timetable and syllabus of MU IDOL?

A. Student can get in touch with the PCP coordinators for their queries regarding syllabus and timetable.

Q. What is the schedule to attend lectures at MU IDOL?

A. The lectures take place daily in the evening from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm including Sunday lectures, which are conducted at the PCP centers.

Q. In how many days are the students required to submit their TC and migration certificate after taking admission at MU IDOL?

A. After completing the admission process, candidates are required to submit their TC and migration certificate within two months.

Q. Can a student get admission to Mumbai University IDOL if they have already secured admission at an MU affiliated college?

A. Yes, one can secure admission to IDOL no matter if they are already admitted to an MU affiliated college. All that the candidates require is to cancel their admission from the previous institute, take the NOC, take online admission to MU IDOL and submit the TC to the previous institute which will be sent directly to IDOL.
