What's new at KLS IMER? Karnataka Examination Authority (KEA) has released the Karnataka PG CET 2022 Round 2 Allotment Results on **Feb 13, 2023 for MBA, MCA, and MTech** courses. The last day for payment of fees is **Feb 20, 2023**. Also, the last date for reporting to the allotted college is **Feb 20, 2023 (5 PM)**.

Karnatak Law Society's Institute of Management Education and Research known as **KLS IMER**, was established in 1991. The institute is AICTE-approved, affiliated to **Rani Channamma University**. KLS IMER Admission 2023: Highlights

For KLS IMER admissions, the entrance exams accepted are [MAT](#) / [XAT](#) / [CAT](#) / [CMAT](#) / [KMAT](#) / [Karnataka PG CET](#).

- Candidates planning to take admission through government quota, need to produce their score of Post Graduate Common Entrance Test (**PGCET**), conducted by the Government of Karnataka
- In case candidates have completed their graduation from any other university than **Rani Channamma University, Belgaum**, they need to show a migration certificate obtained from the respective university and eligibility certificate from Rani Channamma University
- For management quota, admissions are based on score/ percentile in the qualifying exam (CMAT/ MAT/ CAT/ XAT/ KMAT/ PGCET) or any other entrance test recognised by AICTE, New Delhi

KLS IMER MBA Admission 2023

The institute offers three specialisations under the MBA programme with **120 seats**. To apply for KLS IMER MBA programme, candidates need to meet the below-mentioned eligibility criteria:

MBA	
Specialisation	Eligibility Criteria
Finance	- Must have completed graduation with a minimum aggregate of 50%



HR	(For SC/ ST category, there's a relaxation of 5%)
Marketing	- Final year students are also eligible to apply on a provisional basis

KLS IMER Application Process 2023

The applicants need to submit the KLS IMER application form along with the important documents mentioned below:

- Eligibility certificate
- Marksheet of Class 10, 12 and graduation
- Scorecard of entrance exam
- Migration certificate (if applicable)

KLS IMER Course Fee 2023

KLS IMER MBA course fee is approximately Rs 4.20 lakh (for two years). Here is a year-wise split of the fee:

Course	First Year (in Rs lakh)	Second Year (in Rs lakh)
MBA	2.10	2.10

KLS IMER Scholarships 2023

The institute is known for its merit scholarship given to the **top five** rank holders in **PGCET** and **K-MAT** entrance exam. The **PGCET** rankers (within 500 ranks) are awarded Rs 50,000 and **K-MAT** rankers (within 500 ranks) are provided Rs 25,000. Generally, KLS IMER provides three types of scholarships as listed below:

1. **Minority Scholarship** is offered by the State Government to eligible students from SC/ ST category
2. **Merit Scholarship** for top five rank holders in **PGCET** and **K-MAT** entrance exam
3. **Minority loan** offered to the eligible students by various nodal agencies

KLS IMER Admission FAQs

A. The admission fee of two years MBA programme is Rs 4.20 lakh.

A. Candidates must be a graduate with a minimum aggregate of 50 per cent. However, there is a relaxation of 5 per cent for SC/ ST category candidates. Final year students are also eligible to apply on a provisional basis.

A. Karnataka Post Graduate Common Entrance Test (PGCET) is a state-level exam conducted offline in the English language.

A. For management quota, the admissions are based on score/ percentile in the qualifying exam (CMAT/ MAT/ CAT/ XAT/ KMAT/ PGCET or any other entrance test recognised by AICTE, New Delhi.

A. Yes, to apply for any of the specialisations, the eligibility criteria is common.
