Langara College Admissions 2023: Application Fees & Deadline

Situated in scenic Vancouver, Langara College provides university, career and continuing education to over 23,000 students every year. The Musqueam people, on whose territory the college is located, have named it the “House of Teachings”. Langara was established as an independent public college under the Provincial College and Institute Act in 1994. In 2018-19, Langara awarded 2,845 credentials to students. The average age of students admitted at Langara College is 23.9 years. In Fall 2020, the college had 2,363 continuing studies students, and 14,450 term enrolment students. It is interesting to note that Langara College’s age demographics reflect an almost equal population of girls and boys, with girls leading by a few numbers since 2018. In 2020, Langara College received research funds of around CAD 900,000 from various agencies, while the faculty has received research grants of over CAD 1 million in the past five years.

How to Apply for UG Admission at Langara College?

Eligibility & Documents Required for Langara College UG Admission



The eligibility requirements vary depending on the choice of program. Below are the general guidelines for admission to Langara College. You may meet either one or all of the requirements mentioned below:

- Successful completion of Grade 12 or equivalent
- Students must be at least 19 years old, as on the first date of the first semester
- Successful completion of Adult Basic Education or General Educational Development program

English Language Proficiency Requirements

International students are required to prove English language proficiency by way of writing one of the tests required by the college. Langara has divided the proficiency requirements into three categories, which have different requirements. Langara College Admission Process

Langara College intake season

Langara College recommends that you apply as soon as possible because a few programs accept students on a first-come-first-served basis. As soon as the seats are filled, the college will stop accepting applications. While ideally, as an international student, you should start applying at least six months prior to the start of the semester, the college starts accepting applications 11 months prior to the start date of the session.



The following are the intake months for the below-mentioned programs:

Program	Intake Months
University Transfer Program	September, January, and May
Post-Degree Diploma Programs	September (most), January, and May
Career Studies and Limited Enrolment Programs	September (most), January, and May

As an international student, it is important to keep in mind that the Visa processing may take up to six to eight weeks. Hence, you should plan your applications accordingly.

How do I start my application? Is there any Pathway option available?

To start your application process, you must go to the official college website and go through the admission requirements of the program of your choice thoroughly.

There are two ways to submit an application:

- Online Application (the fastest)
- Paper Application (longer processing time than the former)

There are no pathway programs for international students.

What are the steps to an application?

To apply to Langara, you must log on to the official college website to start your application process. If you are applying to two programs, you only need to send your application for the first program.

The application to Langara is completed on the Education Planner BC (EPBC).

Step 1: Log on to the official college website and click on “Apply Now”.



You will be taken to the official EPBC website. Once there, create an account on EPBC.

The college receives applications from all over the world, which are mostly evaluated on a first-come first-serve basis. From all the countries represented in the college, Langara has the most number of students

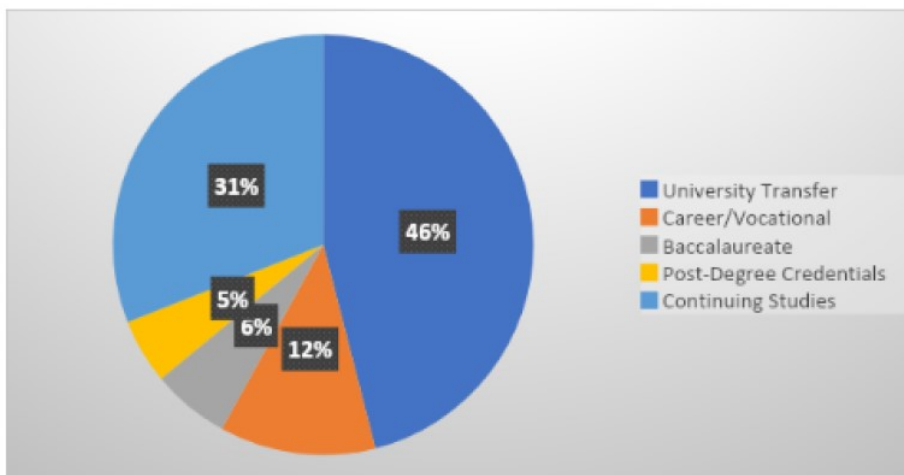


from India. The acceptance rate of the college is 85%.

According to the 2020-21 data, Langara has a total of 4,688 international students studying at the college. Out of this, 2,664 students come from India, the highest in the college.

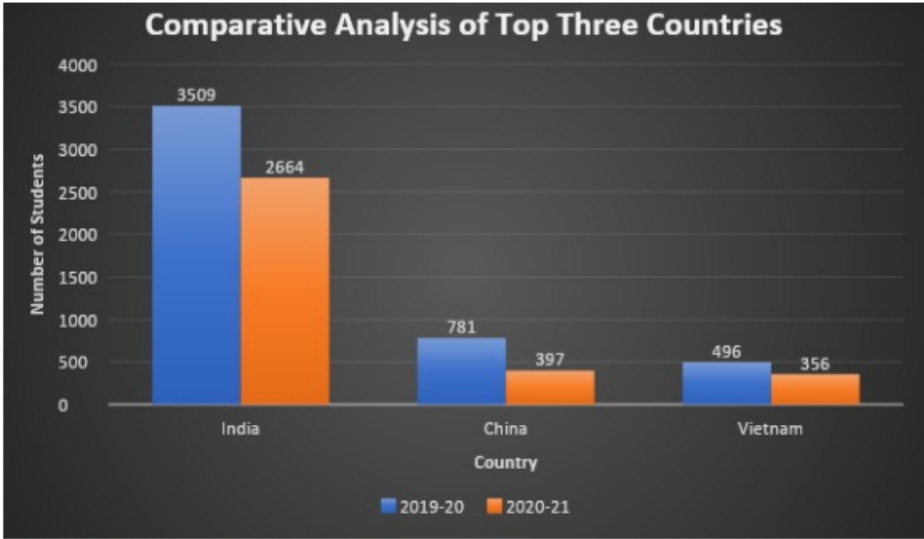

Langara College Part-Time Work While Studying

Can I work while studying here?

International students in Canada are allowed to work part-time depending on the conditions of the Visa and college they are enrolled in. Such students will also require a Social Insurance Number, which essentially allows one to be paid while working.

Off-Campus Work

As an international student enrolled in full-time studies on campus, you will be allowed to work part-time off campus. You will not require a separate work permit as your study permit will allow you to work off-campus, provided you are enrolled in a full-time degree, diploma, or certificate program at Langara.

Full-time studies include all programs that have nine or more credits per term.

English as a Second Language (Langara English for Academic Purposes) [ESL (LEAP)] students are not permitted to work off campus.

Hours of Work

Students who are eligible to work while studying can work part-time up to 20 hours per week, during their study-term, and full-time during official breaks.

On-Campus Work



International students with valid study permits, enrolled in full-time programs at Langara will be allowed to work on campus. However, there are not many job opportunities on campus.

Langara College Campuses & Accommodation

How many colleges and campuses does the university have?

Located in Vancouver, Langara College has two campus locations:

Langara College Main Campus: 100 West 49th Avenue, Vancouver

West Broadway Centre: 601 West Broadway, Vancouver

All the new buildings on campus at Langara are built to LEED Gold certification standards. This makes them environment-friendly, energy-efficient, along with improving the overall health of the people living on campus. The campus also includes electronic vehicle charging stations and geo-thermal heating and cooling systems.

Is on-campus housing available?

Langara College is one of the most affordable colleges in British Columbia in terms of tuition fees. The U-Pass Compass Card, which is used for accessing public transit, and a comprehensive health and dental plan at lower rates are all a part of the Langara College tuition fees. However, Langara does not have on-campus accommodation. Students studying at Langara choose to either stay at homestays or off-campus accommodations. At the time of admission, students are supposed to show proof of funds and cannot entirely rely upon part-time work to support their education and stay in Canada.

Off-campus rental accommodation costs from CAD 500 to over CAD 1,000 per month.

Langara College Admission FAQs

Q. Where should one apply for UG and PG admission of the university?

A. For both UG and PG admission to Langara College, one can apply directly from Education Planner BC website. The application fee is 155 CAD.

Q. What is Langara College visa process for international students after getting admitted to the college?



A. Application forms for the Study Permit, which is granted by the IRCC and required for international students, are offered both online and offline. The following paperwork is required to apply for the same: - From a Designated Learning Institution, a LOA (DLI). The DLI number for Langara is O19319074622.

- Passport
- Two passport-size photos on the backs of each bearing the names and dates of birth
- Acceptance letter
- Evidence of financial assistance

Q. What is the best time to apply to Langara College?

A. It is recommended that prospective students submit their applications 11 months in advance of the semester they have chosen. For the May 2023 intake, the college is now accepting applications. For this semester, the application date is in January 2023.

Q. Does Langara College provide management degree to international students?

A. A post-graduate diploma degree in business administration is offered at Langara College. The institution also serves as a location in Vancouver for the MBA programme at the University of British Columbia. The course lasts for 21 months.

Q. Is it necessary to submit English proficiency score at Langara College?

A. Yes. Students who do not speak English must provide IELTS results as evidence of their language skills. IELTS test results must be at least 6.5 to be accepted by the college. The TOEFL score equal of an IELTS score was also recognised by the college.
