**What's new at RVCE?** Admissions 2023-24 for the first year of BE and MCA under the Management quota are open. Candidates can check in details and apply through the official website.

**Rashtriya Vidyapeeth College of Engineering (RVCE)** admission 2022 for all UG and PG courses is entrance-based. RV College of Engineering is a prestigious co-educational institute located in Bangalore, Karnataka affiliated with Visvesvaraya Technological University. Known to offer various UG and PG programs across Engineering and Technology, the college offers BTech, MTech and MCA programmes to the students.

## RV College of Engineering Eligibility for UG and PG Courses 2023

RVCE offers three UG and PG courses to the students and it is mandatory for students who wish to take admission here to meet the minimum eligibility criteria set by the institute.

Common eligibility for all UG and PG courses is as follows:

- **Eligibility criteria for UG programmes:** Aspirants must have passed their Class 12 with an aggregate of 60%.
- **Eligibility criteria for PG programmes:** Aspirants must have passed their UG with an aggregate of 50%.

At the UG level, RV College of Engineering offers a four-year BE across 13 specialisations. For admission, candidates must meet the minimum eligibility set by the institute and must appear for one among [KCET](#), [COMEDK](#), [JEE Main](#) or any other national-level/state-level entrance exam. For admission, candidates must meet the minimum eligibility set by the institute and must appear for one among PG CET / GATE / college-level entrance exams. ## RV College of Engineering Admission FAQs

### Q. What is the cutoff for RVCE?

A. The COMEDK cutoff for Aerospace Engineering for 2021 was 8552 for Round 3 the General Merit (GM) closing rank cut off. More details around the cutoff can be checked [here](#).

### Q. Does RVCE provides hostel facility?

A. Yes, RV College of Engineering has four hostel blocks out of which all the blocks have UG students while there is one block only for the PG students.

### Q. What is the fee for BTech at RV College of Engineering via management quota?

A. The management quota fee for BTech ranges from INR 14 to INR 57 lakh depending on the specialisation. [📄 Check specialisation-wise management quota fee for BTech here.](#)

### Q. How can I take admission to MTech at RVCE?

A. For admission for MTech, candidates must meet the minimum eligibility set by the institute and must appear for one among PG CET/ GATE/ college-level entrance exams.

### Q. How many specialisations are available under BTech programme at RV College of Engineering?

A. RV College of Engineering offers a four-year BE across 13 specialisations. Some of the top specialisations include Civil, Mechanical, Aerospace, CSE, EEE and ECE, among others.

### Q. How can I apply for BTech at RVCE?

A. For admission to BTech, students must meet the minimum eligibility set by the institute and must appear for one among Karnataka CET, COMEDK, JEE Main or any other national-level/state-level entrance exam.

- KCET qualified applicants are required to appear in KCET counselling conducted by KEA and COMEDK qualifiers must attend the COMEDK counselling
- During the counselling, applicants are required to fill the choice of college and course
- Seats are allotted based on the choices filled and score obtained in the



entrance exam

- Students also have an option to take admission directly in the second year of BTech via lateral entry. Read details [📄 here](#)

**Q. Which entrance exams are accepted for MCA admission at RV College of Engineering?**

A. For admission to MCA, students must meet the minimum eligibility and must appear for one among Karnataka PG CET and KMAT.
