What's new at VNSGU placements 2022? The University has not released the placement report 2022 on the official website yet. However, it recently released NIRF 2022 report. According to the NIRF report 2022, VNSGU has concluded its 2021 placements with over **277 students placed**. Out of the total students placed, **9 students** were from **UG programmes** and **268** were from **PG programmes**.

Further, the median package offered to **UG (4-year) and PG (2-year)** students during VNSGU placements 2021 was **INR 1.1 LPA and INR 1.75 LPA**, respectively. The top recruiters of **VNSGU** during the past years include Amazon, Infosys, Accenture, Wipro, Cognizant, etc.

Final Placements:

- The median salary offered to UG (4-year) students in 2021 dropped by nearly 66% when compared with 2020
- The median package offered to PG (1-year) students dropped by nearly 59% in 2021 when compared with 2020

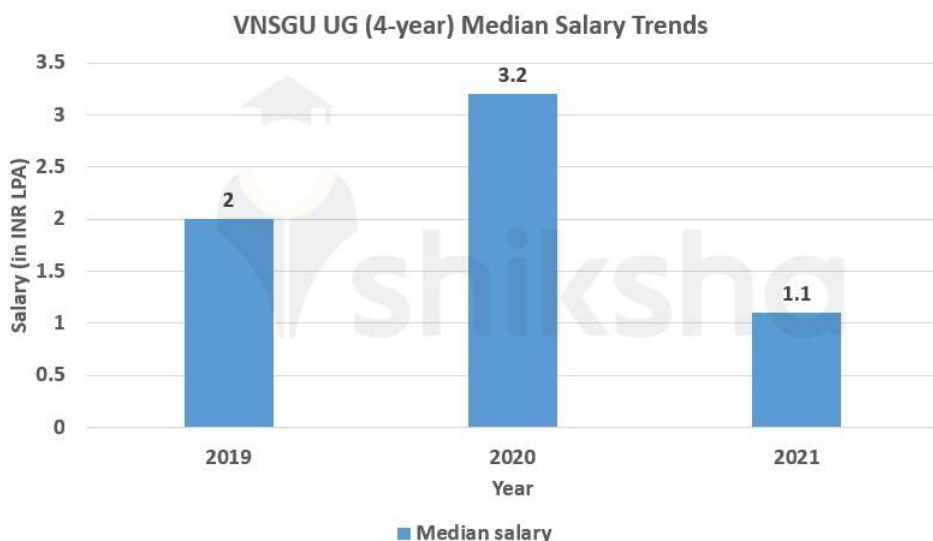

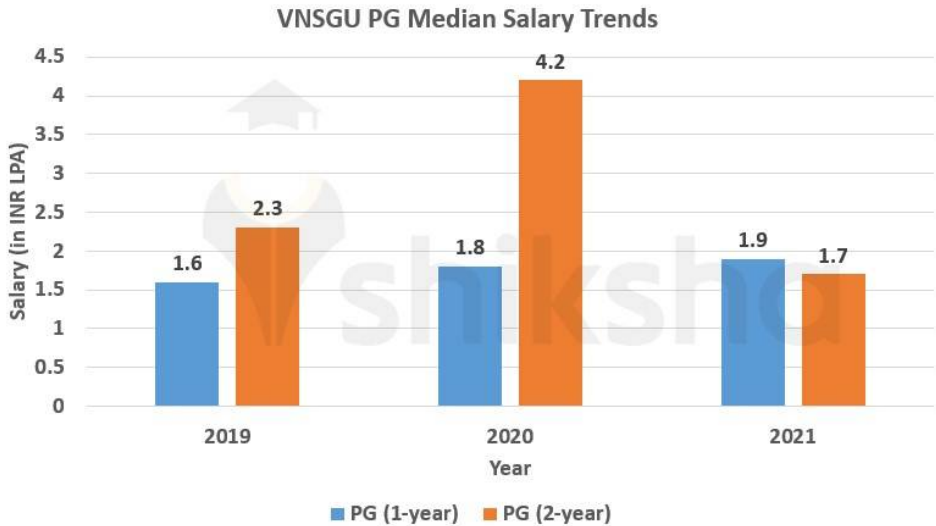
VNSGU PG Placement Trends: 2019 vs 2020 vs 2021

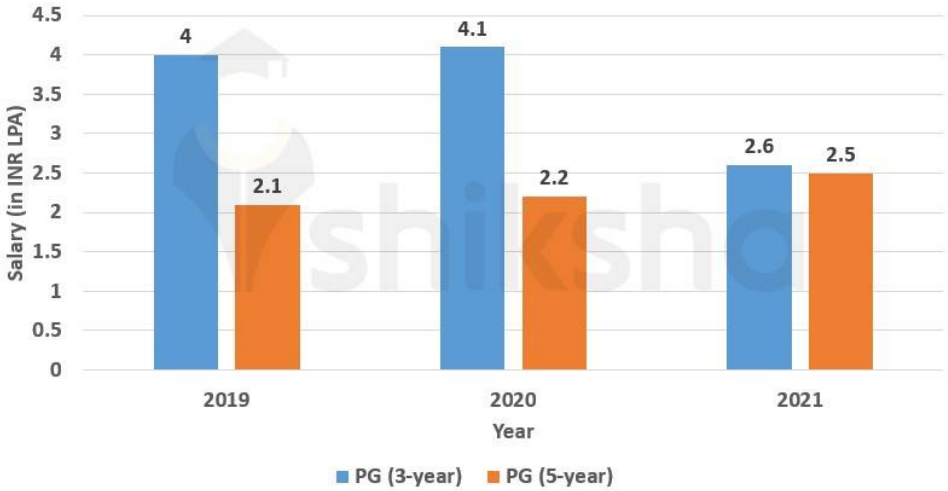

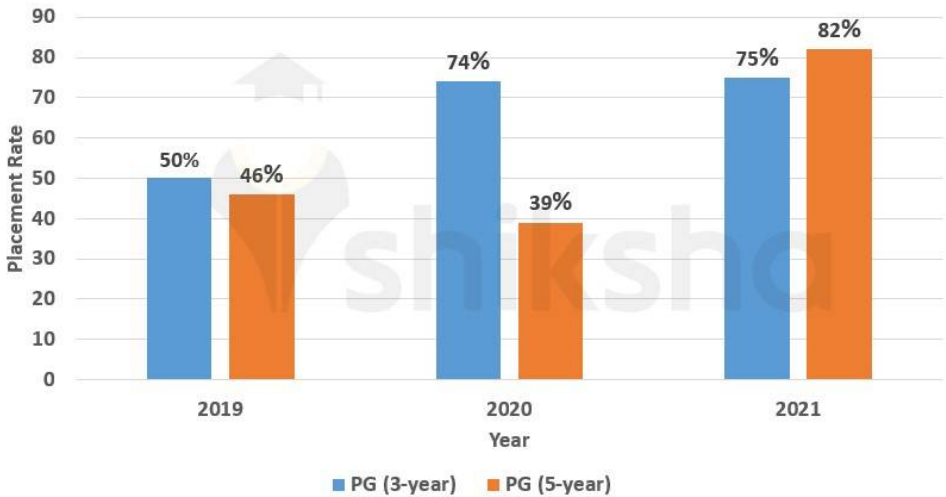

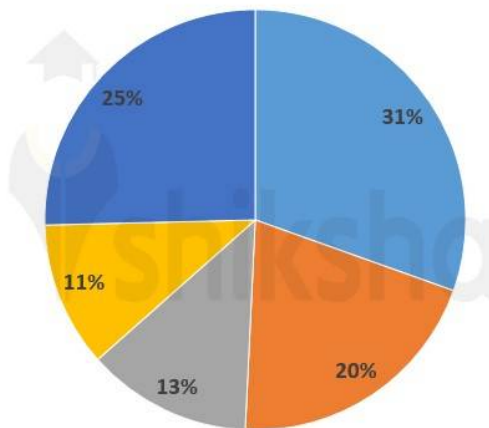

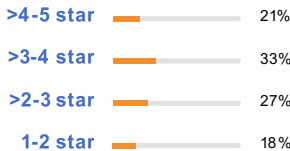

Placements: Almost 100% of the students got placed because we are in the government medical college, and we all go for an internship in the government hospital. The salary offered for all students is the same, which is Rs. 70,000 per month. Government hospitals are recruiters for us. Almost 100% of the students got placements in the same hospital, and the head of the department is the top role offered by the government.
