The [Harvard University](#) placement is improved from last year for MBA graduates. According to the Career Data available at the Harvard Business School's website for the class of 2023, a total of **73%** were available for employment, which was **71% in 2022**. As per **Harvard Business School placements 2023**, **86%** of MBA graduates received an offer and among them, 80% of students accepted the offer. The median base salary for MBA graduates is **USD 175,000** or **INR 1.5 Cr** (USD 1 = INR 83.02) and a median signing bonus of **USD 30,000** or **INR 25 L** (USD 1 = INR 83.02) (**57% Receiving**). - 73% of students sought employment
- 86% of students received an offer
- 80% accepted the employment offer
- 89% of students were employed in the U.S.
- 11% of students were employed internationally at locations like Asia, Australia & Oceania, Canada, Europe, Latin America, Middle East & North Africa, and Sub-Saharan Africa
