Placements: From the CSE branch, almost 80% of students get placed every year. From mechanical engineering, around 40% of students get placed, while from electrical engineering, around 50% of students get placed. From civil engineering, around 30% of

students get placed every year. The highest salary package offered until now was 19 LPA, and the average salary package offered is around 5.5 LPA. The lowest salary package offered is 3.5 LPA. Top companies which visit our college for placements are Vedanta, HUL, Byju's, Cognizant, Infosys, TCS, Doubtnut, etc. Many coaching institutes and IT cells also visit here for placements. PSUs like OIL, ONGC, APDCL, NRL and BPCL visit here every year and offer very high salary packages. Students got internships in various IITs, Indian Railway, PWD, OIL, ONGC, APDCL, ASTC, Automobile, etc.

Infrastructure: The infrastructure is very good here. The new building is very good. Parks, lakes, gardens and fields are also well managed. Labs are modern and huge. Classrooms are huge, and there are projectors in every classroom, along with a huge green board. Some rooms contain digital boards, and seminar rooms are new and modern. Workshops are huge, and all the hostels are renovated this year. There are many facilities for students of the hostels. They got an unlimited internet connection with a speed of 80-90 Mbps. The quality of the food served is good in hostels. All kinds of medical facilities are available in the hostels. Sports rooms and gyms are also available for students.

Faculty: All faculty members are passed out from various IITs. They teach in a very good way, and also they are very helpful. The quality of education they provide is very good. The course curriculum is very much relevant. Students are made properly ready for industries. Teachers provide free coaching for different entrance exams.

Other: I chose mechanical because I have a great interest in cars, bikes and engines. As it is a very old college, the teaching culture here is very high. The only thing which our college should improve is it should provide more preparation for competitive exams. Our college organises an annual event called Phoenix. Many tech events and hackathons are organised from time to time. All kinds of scholarships are provided to students.

Placements: The highest salary package offered was 12 LPA offered by Oil and ONGC, and the less salary package offered is 2.5 LPA. TCS, Infosys, and Wipro are the other small companies offering placements in our college. Oil India Limited also selected students from our college and 30% from our class. Assistant manager job in Assam Electrical Generation limited was the role offered.

It has average teachers, good placements in 2018 and good infrastructure in the college and hostel.

Placements: Placements are high in computer science department compared to other branches. PSUs visit our college mostly for mechanical, electrical and instrumentation departments. However, I have seen various IT companies conduct mass recruitment here. The highest salary package offered for jobs is 18 LPA. The lowest salary package offered ranges from 3 LPA. Students could expect an average salary package of around 5 LPA-7 LPA in companies excluding mass recruiters which offer less salary packages. Some of the recruiting companies for computer science department include Cognizant, Infosys, TCS, Recom Infotech, Wipro, etc.

Infrastructure: At a regional level, this college provides great infrastructure, but libraries are available only in regular days from only 8 am to 4 pm. Wi-Fi facility available on the campus is one of the best and has a high speed. Wi-Fi is available for 24 hours a day, and the average speed is 100 Mbps. Classrooms are also of standard quality with plenty of space. Lab facilities for computer science are very good with plenty of high-speed desktop computers to provide every student with one PC. There are 10 hostels currently, and one new hostel is under construction. Among 10 hostels, 8 are for boys, while 2 are for girls. Students can enjoy the VIP electricity facility and 24 hours of unlimited high-speed internet (LAN).

Faculty: For the computer science department, there are plenty of faculty members for every topic who might be interested in. Their teaching quality is up to the mark, and they are very knowledgeable. Some of them are highly skilled in their interested topic in both practical and theoretical aspects like artificial intelligence, DBMS, microprocessors, microcontrollers, etc. I could give a rating of 7.5 stars out of 10 stars for the relevancy of course curriculum because at some point some subjects are introduced which depend on some other basic topics which are not in the course curriculum. So, students have to do some extra courses to feel comfortable with those topics. However, these basics could be easily found on Youtube, where they are explained well.

Other: I have chosen Jorhat Engineering College because it is a popular engineering college in Assam. This college is most popular for computer science and engineering, so I opted for it. Later I realised that I made the correct choice. The course is worth it. Moreover, from my experience prior, I have chosen it based on my basic knowledge of this field. Every year our college hosts two main fests which include a technical fest and a cultural fest named Phoenix. The connectivity to our college is good, and the transportation facility is available from 6:30 am to 8 pm. After that, for transportation, students would require to reserve private vehicles like auto-rickshaw, etc.

Placements: When you think about a government college, you might not think about placements. But it's not true. Half of the students in our branch got placed already. Students got placed in companies like TCS, Wipro, ONGC, etc. The placement cell of Jorhat

Engineering College is a central hub for other colleges for placements.

Infrastructure: Jorhat Engineering College offers AICTE recognised B.E. courses in civil, electrical, computer science, mechanical and instrumentation engineering. It also offers three years post-graduation in masters in computer applications. Every year students give a state entrance exam to get into these courses. JEC has 8 boys hostels and 2 girls hostel. Each hostel has a common room where students can spend their time watching TV and playing games. There are a few playgrounds for playing games. For students, there are general common rooms for boys and girls.

Faculty: Jorhat Engineering College is affiliated to Dibrugarh University which is a state-run university. So the courses are well designed for the students and are completely based on their field of study. This course is the same as the GATE syllabus, so you don't have to study for GATE separately. Teachers are experienced in their fields and very much capable of answering any of your doubts.

Other: Last year our first tech fest called Technovous 2019 was conducted at our college. This fest had various competitions, including coding, quizzes, etc. It was conducted separately from our annual cultural fest called Phoniex. This fest lasts for 3 days, and popular artists from India and abroad come to perform.

Placements: The placements to be honest are nice but not adequate, last year TCS recruited few from our college, Zaloni came and recruited some too. This year also the placements have begun and already TCS and Zaloni came again, still a lot of other companies to come. The placement cell is working very hard to bring in more companies every year. Due to fact that our college had great placements during 2012-13 season, we may tend to think that placements have deteriorated but in fact has remained constant, atleast for CSE department.

Placements: Placements offered in the college are almost satisfactory. A number of placements are based on departments. Placements are offered by both public and private sectors. Public sector jobs are mostly offered to students from civil, mechanical and instrumentation, while private jobs are offered to CSE and electrical students, based on campus recruitments, GATE scores, AMCAT scores, etc.

The feeling to be a part of this college is really satisfying.

Placements: Placements are higher for mechanical branch compared to other departments. However, the number of students getting a good placement is still very low, that is around 10%. Students usually get placed in oil refineries and automobile companies like Tata Motors or Maruti Suzuki. The average package offered was around Rs. 60,000 per month.

Infrastructure: The college provides most of the facilities like library, Wi-Fi, labs, classrooms and sports complexes. But, not all these are well-organised and working properly. The library doesn't have enough books to justify the need of students. The canteen is very old, but a new canteen is under construction right now. This is the same case with hostel rooms.

Faculty: Most of the faculty members are hardworking and sincere about their job. A few of them are not knowledgeable enough and lack proper teaching and communication skills. The student to faculty ratio is around 40:1. Teachers adopt both traditional and digital methods for teaching.
