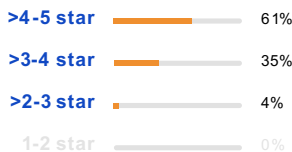

**Placements:** The placements are good for branches such as CSE, ECE, EE, and ME. EE department achieved 61.3% of students placed in 2020 with an average salary package offered is 6 LPA, and the highest salary package offered is 14.7 LPA. Top recruiters were Adobe, Accenture, Paytm, Reliance Industries, Oracle, etc are visits to hire students. Last year, Amazon also started visiting our campus to recruit. Most of them are placed in IT companies, and some opted for the GATE exam. The top roles offered are business associates, junior analysts, etc. Students interested in IT sector gets internship easily while few core companies visit campus for an internship so, students interested in the core have to go off-campus.

**Infrastructure:** Our college has a very beautiful campus, and very good infrastructure and the buildings are new. Laboratories are well-equipped with the latest instruments. The library
