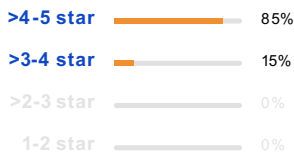

AIIMS Delhi : The Apex Medical Institute of India.

Placements: There are no direct placements after MBBS as most people opt for post graduation courses. However, after completing MBBS from AIIMS Delhi, getting a job as a general physician in most of the private medical colleges becomes easy. These jobs have salaries around 60 - 80 thousand per month initially. Many graduates choose to pursue their post graduation from USA. A student from AIIMS has a higher chance of being cleared for these courses. The stipend during internship is 17,900 per month.

Infrastructure: AIIMS Delhi has a very good infrastructure. The hospital area, classrooms, labs, and research centres are all centrally air conditioned. Wi-Fi is available in the entire campus including hostels. Classrooms are quite big with audio visual facilities and comfortable chairs. The library, known as B. Dixit library, has a large collection of medical literature including research journals. It also has Wi-Fi connection with many research

articles websites free to use. The labs have state of the art facilities and expensive equipments like electron microscope, gamma knife unit etc. The Operation Theatres are well-equipped to handle the most sophisticated of surgeries. All employees are medically covered under Employees Health Scheme (EHS). This allows us to undergo fast and affordable treatment. The hostel rooms are single seated for boys. However, for girls, during their initial years they have to share the rooms. The rooms have an almirah, a table-chair, a desk, a 3x6 feet B.Ed and an AC (optional). Hostel compound has facilities like barber shop, tailor, general store, book store, 24/7 cafe, juice shop, laundry, recharge shop, photostat shop, cobbler shop etc. There is a large gym which has most of the equipments like treadmills, dumbbells, barbells etc. It also has 3 wooden badminton courts and 2 table tennis tables. There is also a state of the art swimming pool with depth ranging from 4 feet to 12 feet. Other sports facilities include a lawn tennis court, cricket pitch, football field, and basketball court. There are more than 10 canteens in total. Some of them are quite good but others are not. Quality of food is often an important issue in the hostel. The monthly fees of these canteens is around 2000 to 3000 (including lunch and dinner). Major issues with infrastructure include clogged washrooms, water seepage, and inability to keep stray dogs out.

Faculty: All teachers are qualified, well versed, and knowledgeable. There are teachers like Dr. J. B. Sharma who are authors of famous medical books. We also get top researchers like Dr. Nalin Mehta. The teaching quality is quite satisfactory. The usual teaching method is using slides to impart knowledge. In addition, there are case studies, clinical postings, B.Ed-side classes, interaction with patients, and picture based classes. The student to faculty ratio is around 80 : 1 during lectures and 15 : 1 during clinical postings. We get a lot of exposure, as AIIMS receives hundreds of patients daily. The course curriculum is very useful, and it has helped us in learning everything necessary to become a general physician.

Other: A lot of literary, socio-cultural, and sports events are conducted throughout the year. Moreover, various seminars and conferences are organized in which eminent people participate. The fest of AIIMS known as Pulse, is the biggest medical fest in the entire south Asia. Around 50,000 medical students participate in this annual fest which is conducted in September (16th to 22nd). The campus has a good connectivity, with a metro station, bus stop, and an auto stand. The surroundings are often crowded by patients and their attendants. These patients have to stand in queues, and wait for a long time for getting an appointment. There is a provision for summer fellowship in which students can take part in research projects, and they get a stipend for this work. This gives us a lot of exposure to research methods.
