Placements: I have visited the college and got to know from students studying there that in 2014-18 batch, almost all the eligible students have got placements. There are great opportunities for mechatronics students. Companies that have visited the campus recently are Arabol Lubricants, Kaps Group, Duratuff Glass, Trigent, E2E, etc. Students are allowed to be volunteers for the placement drives, and junior students can get an exposure of managing such events as well as they can learn how to appear in the interview and about the interview procedures. Since they manage all activities under the guidance of faculty members.


Infrastructure: The campus is Wi-Fi enabled, and there are well-maintained laboratories. The library is well-equipped, and the classrooms have AC and projector facilities. Overall, it is a beautiful campus with lush green surroundings. Hostel rooms in the AC hostel are very beautiful. An ambulance is available round the clock on campus. Football, volleyball, basketball, cricket, gymnasium and all kind of facilities are available on the campus including a swimming pool.

The college has the good infrastructure and facilities. Till 2016, the placements are good.

Placements: Till 2013, when our college was affiliated to Staffordshire University, UK, the placement was good. Even from every batch, around 60-70% of the students got placed every year. Some from the campus drive and the rest of some used to be placed from outside. But nowadays, the percentage of getting placed is less than 40%, and this is because, after 2013, our college has no more affiliation from Staffordshire. So now its affiliated to KUK. There is a placement cell in our college. Now its all depend on the student if they are talented enough. They already get the placement. Still, the small companies used to visit our campus, but most of the students are not able to be selected because of lack of skills.

Infrastructure: Our campus has good infrastructure as compared to the others. But this is only better for computer science students only. The whole campus is fully Wi-Fi enabled. There is the number of labs available consisting of good quality of computers and software. Earlier IBM(Center of Excellence) used to provide the free training to the students of our college. But nowadays they are not providing anymore. All the classrooms are fully A/C, but nowadays, the canteen is not as much good as used to be before. They have a lack of variety of foods and related materials. But our hostel facilities are better from the others. There is the good quality of rooms. The mess provides the good quality of foods. Every semester, there is a sports week, where the number of students used to participate in interesting games, which encourages them to make a career in the sports also. Our campus is not so big, which is just spread over 27-acres.

Faculty: Our HODs and some more faculty members are highly qualified. They provide such quality of lectures for us. They use the projector to give lectures(i.e., to show PPTs and animations if related) also whiteboards. I am not much aware of the student to faculty ratio. But our college provides the B.Tech in computer science, mechatronics, BBA, and MBA. There was an electrical branch, but this year, no students admitted in that branch. Placements: About the placement cell, it is very dull. Currently, the TPO of the college is not so much reasonable and effective after changing the previous TPO who was Sammer Ghaba. He took so much effort for the students. Also, the number of students is decreasing day by day by changing the university from Staffordshire to Kurukshetra University. The current TPO will tell you he is going to call the technical-related company but when you will go in interview room the HR will tell you they are hiring for BPO or some other post instead of a technical post. The fee structure is also higher in comparison to other colleges which are located in Panipat. So, according to me, placements are not good here. You will pay a high fee and you will get nothing.


Infrastructure: The infrastructure is a little better but the college is not so much big. Also, sports-related games don't occur here. The disciplinary committee is so strict they will treat you like a child and you will not feel that you are in a professional-level course. By spending some time here, you will be bored by the infrastructure.

Faculty: When I took the admission here, that time there were lots of good faculty members available. But as my time went out, every year, good faculty members left. About the Staffordshire University course, it was so easy. Here you will get the knowledge of practical things mostly. They will teach you 7-8 programming languages and also assignments on these. Really unsatisfied due to faculty, bad placement, poor infrastructure.

Placements: The college placement condition is very bad as only 20-25% of students are getting placed in a company. Only pool campus drives get organized in the college. There isn't any company which comes for only this college. Even if students are getting placement, they are getting very low packages of 10-15k per month. The college never suggests students for summer or industrial training and internships. Students should do everything on their own. Even sometimes consultancy companies come in this college for pool campus drives and they just take money to offer jobs, but give jobs to 25-30% students only. I will never suggest anyone to take admission in this college.

Infrastructure: Poor infrastructure of this college. They write 26 acres campus, but that is fake. 60% of the area comes under Maharaja Agrasen Santana Dharma school only. Only 14-15 classrooms are there in the whole college for all the courses including 2 computer labs, one mechanical workshop, one electrical lab and nothing more. Worst canteen service, hostel services are good but fees are very high, mess food is good but not so good according to price they are taking from students. They provide access to a limited 14 GB Wi-Fi to a student for the whole semester in this digital India. One football ground is only there. No other grounds or play courts or swimming pool are there, as they have mentioned on the website. They are just providing good hostel services like hotel, nothing good in studies at all.

Faculty: Only 2-3 faculty members are experienced in this college but they aren't good enough to teach, as they lack the basic concepts and real knowledge. Unqualified and freshers are hired every semester to teach in this college and the rest of the teaching is history. Students to faculty ratio is about 30:1. No one gets industry exposure as nothing of that kind of thing is provided during the college. The course curriculum is not good.
