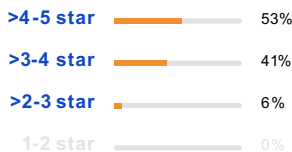

Placements: IITTM is well-known for its education and academia and as well as for the practicalities of concepts they thought. By considering all that in a minimised way, MBA at IITTM-Gwalior has a very decent placements with an average package of Rs. 2.5 lakhs per annum. Though it is all depends on your capabilities, as an individual. Until now, IITTM has provided 100% placements as I've been noticing and hearing from my seniors. IITTM is a well-known brand in the outside corporate world in the tourism field. Tourism is a vast subject, and it's all up to you how you perceive the opportunities. It is an average college, with average placements.

Placements: Almost all the students were placed in college. Although the packages differed among students. 3-3.5 Lacs per annum is the average package offered. Cox and Kings, Thomas Cook, Ramoji Film City, etc., visited the campus for placements. The college also helps the students with their internships.

Infrastructure: Wi-Fi, PA System, a rich library, an air-conditioned auditorium, volleyball and football grounds, Billards room, and separate hostels for boys and girls are available.
