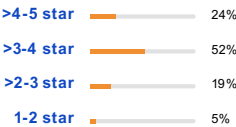

Placements: Our college has done exceptionally well in placements compared to the same-tier colleges in our branch. The highest package was 40 lakh, and companies like Samsung and BMW visited our college. Also, students do internships in their 3rd year, and around 95% of them got placed .

Infrastructure: My stay in the hostel is okay. But food needs to be improved, and while college has good labs, they have also equipped with new systems in our labs classrooms are okay; the canteen has better food compared to the hostel; not much sports is played; it's a small campus.

Our college has good placements and I recommend it for you.

Placements: Our college attracts renowned recruiting companies such as Cisco, Wipro, and Accenture. Approximately 85% of students secure placements here, with the highest package being around 27lpa. On average, students receive a package of 9lpa. Internships are expected to be completed during the 4th and 5th semesters, typically in lesser-known companies.

Infrastructure: The college infrastructure is satisfactory, although the labs are not very modern. The labs are well-equipped and provide Wi-Fi for research purposes. The library offers a wide range of books and resources. However, the hostel facilities are not up to par, and the food is average. On the other hand, the food in the canteens is quite good.

Faculty: The teachers at our institution are highly qualified, with many of them holding Ph.D. degrees and possessing extensive knowledge in their respective fields. They are always ready to assist and provide guidance to students. The quality of teaching is commendable, and our course curriculum ensures that we are well-prepared for the industry. Although the semester exams can be challenging, students can still pass with ease, especially if they study independently. Typically, around 90% of the students successfully clear the exams.

Placements: It's a new course in our college; we are the first batch, so no placements have happened since we are only in the 2nd year now. Top companies like Wipro, Infosys, Cisco recruit in our college. Top roles are offered in our course, like cyber engineer, data analyst, etc.

Infrastructure: This is a very old college from 1980, not so much modernly developed. No Wi-Fi is there; classrooms need to be refurbished. The library is okay with limited resources. Placements: SDE roles offered at Cisco, Phonepe and F5 are all above 20 LPA. Many companies offer between 7 and 12 LPAs, including Impress, Oracle, and Eurofins. The number of companies has fallen this year but is expected to pick up in the next placement season, though not to COVID levels.
