MCC has evolved over the years by branching out into various disciplines with the opening of several institutes such as Mount Carmel Institute of Management, Mount Carmel Centre for Postgraduate Studies & Research, Mount Carmel PU College, Mount Carmel Centre for Scientific Research and Advanced Learning, and Mount

Carmel Centre for Extended Education.

A pioneer in women’s education since more than six decades, Mount Carmel College has transformed the lives of tens of thousands of young women, many of whom have become celebrities in their respective fields of service across the world.

Today, the college has 36 departments offering courses in multifarious disciplines and enjoys a strength of about 4500 students from all over India, Asia-Oceanic and African countries.

Mount Carmel College (MCC) was established by the Congregation of Carmelite Sisters of St. Teresa in 1945 in the state of Kerala, and transferred in 1948 to Bangalore to fill a critical gap in women’s education in pre-independent India. By opening up quality educational opportunities for women across the barriers of caste and creed, MCC set a new trend on the educational scenario of India. The college has grown and diversified remarkably over the past six decades in tune with the changing educational needs of society.

The college adopts the latest teaching techniques and novel learning-/teaching-aids, and offers a number of ways for the students to benefit from its education while allowing students to take up challenges and demonstrate their capabilities.

MCC was first affiliated to Madras University, followed by the University of Mysore, and is permanently affiliated to Bangalore University since 1993. It obtained autonomous status in 2005. In 1999 it received **5-star accreditation** from NAAC, and was re-accredited with **‘A+’** in 2006. In 2012 the college successfully completed its third round of accreditation and was graded **‘A’**. It is recognized by UGC as a

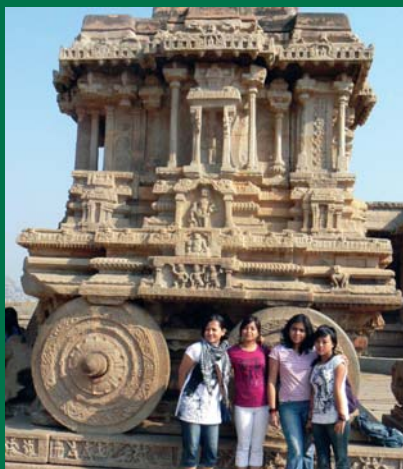




CERTIFICATE COURSES

OSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

Mount Carmel College offers a number of PG courses across streams. These are of 4-semester duration under autonomous regulations and affiliated to Bangalore University. It also offers the AICTE-approved MCA and MBA/PGDBM Programmes. In the academic year 2014-15, Mount Carmel College introduces Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and Credit Grading Point Average (CGPA) for post graduate programmes. This offers a wider choice to students and promotes interdisciplinary learning.



M.A. Economics

The course covers core subjects like Micro Economics, Macro Economics, Public Economics, Industrial Economics, Agricultural Economics and Econometrics.

Eligibility B.A. or equivalent with at least 50% aggregate marks in the core subjects in all the 3 years.

M.Com. - Regular

The course covers core subjects like Marketing, Financial Management, Management Accounting, Quantitative Techniques, International Business, Cost Accounting and Taxation.

Eligibility B.Com. or equivalent with at least 50% aggregate marks in the core subjects in all the 3 years.



M.Com -Industry Integrated

The course is a practical oriented program which focuses on building skills and competencies required for the global corporate world. On the job experience is a part of the course curriculum.

Eligibility B.A, B.Sc, B.Com or BBM with at least 50% aggregate marks in the core subjects at the UG level.

MIB -Master of International Business

The course prepares students for Corporate and Global careers with its focus on application based curriculum. It incorporates on the job training and placement assistance.

Eligibility B.E, B.A, B.Sc, B.Com or BBM with at least 50% aggregate marks in the core subjects at the UG level.



M.Sc. Bio-Chemistry

Biochemistry is a central discipline to all branches of Biology/Life Sciences. It has emerged as a highly creative discipline with wide career choices. The program offers industry interaction and consists of following papers Biochemical Toxicity, Protein Folding & Dynamics, Biochemical Techniques, Genetics, Food biochemistry, Clinical Biochemistry, Plant Biochemistry, Molecular Biology, Developmental Biology, Molecular Pharmacology, Membrane Biology & Cell Signaling, Neurobiochemistry, Nanobiotechnology, Industrial Biochemistry etc.

Eligibility is B.Sc with Chemistry or Bio-Chemistry, with an aggregate of 50% minimum in optional subjects.

M.Sc. Biotechnology

The course covers core subjects like Medical, Animal, Plant and Environmental Biotechnology; Genetic Engineering, Immunology, Biophysics, Biostatistics, Biochemistry, Cell and Molecular Biology, Microbiology; with advanced diploma in Bioinformatics.

Eligibility B.Sc. with Biotechnology, Zoology, Botany, Microbiology, Environmental Science as core subjects and at least 50% aggregate marks.



M.Sc. Electronics

The course offers Embedded Systems, Nanoelectronics and VLSI Design with extensive laboratory training to meet the latest requirements of industries and R&D organizations.

Eligibility B.Sc. or equivalent with at least 50% aggregate marks in the core subjects.

M.Sc. Fashion Technology

Two year full-time course purely design-oriented to enable students to pursue a career in the highly competitive and creative fashion industry.

Eligibility

- Bachelor's degree in Fashion & Apparel Design / Textiles and Clothing / Fashion Technology.
- Any bachelor's degree along with Postgraduate Diploma in Fashion Technology / Commercial Arts, with 50 % of marks in aggregate.





M.Sc. Food Science & Nutrition

The program focuses in facilitating nutritionists to apply knowledge drawn from relevant sciences to promote an understanding of the effects of nutrition on growth, development and well-being. The curriculum has been designed to create a link between food industry and health industry to provide opportunities to work in research, food industry, hospitals and health promotion sectors. It is a comprehensive in depth program which involves project work and internship at food industry, hospitals and public nutrition.

Eligibility

B.Sc Home Science or Family and Community Sciences / Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics/Food Science and Quality Control/ Nutrition and Dietetics / B.Sc with Human Nutrition / Applied Nutrition / Food Science and Nutrition / Food Science and Quality Control with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate from a recognized board or institution



M.Sc. Human Development

The course offers theoretical perspectives across the Life Span, Infant Development & Stimulation, Early Childhood Education, Research Methods & Scientific Writing, Vulnerable Children, Curriculum Planning & Administration for ECE, Adolescent's Needs and Challenges, Statistics, Parenting, Gerontology, Mental Health, Family and Community Dynamics, Media in Human Development, Guidance & Counselling, Legislation and the Policy Issues in Family and Child Welfare, Monitoring and Evaluation of Programs.

Eligibility B.Sc. in Home Science, NDCH and Psychology with a minimum of 50% marks from a recognised board or institution.



M.Sc. Life Sciences

The course gives comprehensive knowledge in Biochemistry, Genetics, Microbiology, Endocrinology, Molecular Biology, Genetic Engineering, Plant and Animal Systematic, Biodiversity, Biostatistics, Immunology, Bioengineering, Human Physiology, Computers and Bioinformatics.

PG Diploma in Research Methodology and Laboratory Techniques is offered along with M.Sc. Life Science

Eligibility B.Sc. with at least 50% aggregate marks in the core subjects.

M.Sc. Mathematics

Eligibility B.Sc. with Mathematics as one of the core subjects and at least 50% aggregate marks in the core subjects.



M.Sc. Nano Science & Technology

Nanoscience and Nanotechnology is an interdisciplinary area of study which is being recognized as a thrust area of research both at the national and international level. The curriculum for this programme has been designed to impart a firm theoretical foundation together with excellent practical training in the area of materials and nanomaterials.

The University Grants Commission is extending its support to the programme through Funding for Innovative Programmes under XI plan of UGC.

Eligibility Science graduates studied mathematics at the +2 / PUC level.



M.Sc. Plant Science & Herbal Wealth

The course is a link between industry and indigenous medicines. The course offers a special paper on Herbal Wealth in all the 4 semesters emphasizing the importance of medicinal herbs in primary healthcare. Scientific temper is instilled in students by way of research projects.

Eligibility B.Sc. with at least 50% aggregate marks in the core subject.

IGNOU M.Sc. Dietetics and Food Science Management (DFSM)

The course covers core subjects like Nutritional Biochemistry, Food Microbiology, Food Science, Public Nutrition, and Advanced Nutrition.

Eligibility B.Sc. or equivalent with at least 50% aggregate marks in the core subjects in all the 3 years.



MCA

The course covers core subjects like Programming in 'C', Artificial Intelligence, Data Structure, DBMS, Systems Programming, Operations Research, Networking, and Automata Theory.

Eligibility B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com. or equivalent with at least 50% aggregate marks in the core subjects in all the 3 years and mathematics as a compulsory subject at the +2 level.



PGDBM (MBA Equivalent)

The Mount Carmel Institute of Management (MCIM) offers a reputed four semester (2-year) Postgraduate Diploma in Business Management approved by the AICTE, with specialization in Marketing, Finance, Human Resource Management, Information Technology, Banking & Insurance.

Eligibility B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com. / B.B.M. / B.E. or equivalent, with at least 50% aggregate marks in core subjects in all the 3 years.

Students are regularly taken to orphanages, old age homes, remand homes, institutions for disabled children, slums, villages, NGOs and a host of community service centres for inculcation of human values and the spirit of service.

The **NCC** unit at MCC was the first women's NCC unit to start in Karnataka (in 1954). Its NCC and NSS students have won many laurels for the college.

Experiential Learning

MCC organizes seminars, workshops and symposia regularly in various areas of current interest and hosts famous student festivals **Cul-Week** (intra-college) and **Cul-Ah** (national level), national level management festivals **CARPEDIEM** and **DIAKRISI**, national level science symposium, seminar and workshop **PRATHIBIMB**, humanities fest **FAST FORWARD** and commerce fests **UNDER CURRENTS** and **CROSS CURRENTS**. The college also provides real-life education through **earn-while-you-learn** opportunities, internships with NGOs, project work in industries, summer programmes at research institutes, field visits, participation in exhibitions and visits to villages. All its departments provide experiential learning in their own specialized areas.

SUPPORT STRUCTURE



MCC is housed in a green, eco-friendly campus of over 9.75 acres in a peaceful area in central Bangalore and has another 8 acres for its PG and Research Centres.

The campus features 8 major building blocks, 100 well-ventilated classrooms, sophisticated labs, new-generation teaching/learning aids, a well-fitted audiovisual room, an audio recording and editing studio, 3 conference halls, 4 auditoriums, a botanical garden, museums, an electronic instrumentation centre, a home management lab, nursery school and nutrition lab for home science, a bank, college bus and van, canteen, food & drinks kiosks, water purifiers, an independent 400 kVA transformer and 5 generators, PA systems, pay phones and intercom facility, campus networking, wi-fi facility, book and stationery shop, dispensary with a doctor and an assistant, a prayer room, chapel, and various other facilities and amenities.

MCC has one of the best library-cum-information centres in Bangalore, with fully computerized UG and PG sections and over 100,000 books, a good number of national and international journals, a huge collection of CDs and DVDs, online journals, internet, digital notice boards, Braille machine, competitive examination material, bar-coding facility and in-house printing & binding. In a first of its kind MCC has setup a state of the art video conference facility.

MCC has established an outstanding computing facility with about 560 latest-configuration PCs connecting all its departments in a campus-wide network. It has an information management system to provide data on admissions, attendance, fees, accounts, performance in tests and exams, and other admin aspects, and provides broad band internet facility.

MCC offers good hostel facilities with comfortable board & lodging, study & recreation and has recently added a new block for its extended student community.

MCC has specially chosen teachers who are not only highly qualified and effectively communicative but also very motivated towards students' overall development. Many of them hold PhD/ MPhil degrees and have published books, articles and papers at national & international levels and won research awards. They also

guide student research projects and act as personal mentors of students. The teachers constantly upgrade their quality through faculty development programmes and refresher courses.
