ABOUT VAMNICOM



VAMNICOM is located in Pune, a historic city, which is the cultural capital of the state of Maharashtra, and educational centre of India. The city presents a fine blend of academics and industry, as leading industries like Telco, Philips, Finolex, KSB Pumps amongst numerous others, have their base in Pune.

The Vaikunth Mehta National Institute of Co-operative Management (VAMNICOM) is conceived as an intellectual nerve centre for the Co-operative Movement and it is financed by the Ministry of Agriculture, Government of India.

VAMNICOM associates with various international agencies / organisations like the International Co-operative Alliance (ICA), International Labour Organisation (ILO), Food & Agricultural Organisation (FAO), Asian & Pacific Agricultural Credit Association (APRACA), etc. The Institute conducts exchange programmes in collaboration with the department of International, Technical & Economic Co-operation (ITEC), Ministry of External Affairs and offers training programmes for senior executives from co-operatives in developing countries. Also it conducts collaborative programmes with National Institute for Co-operative Development (NICD), Sri Lanka, Association of Asian Confederation of Credit Unions (ACCU), Bangkok, Thailand, The Cooperative College of Malaysia, Malaysia. The institute has also been an active promoter in the establishment of the Centre for International Co-operation and Training in Agricultural Banking (CICTAB) which is engaged in organising training programmes in the field of agricultural / rural banking to professionals from SAARC countries. Entrepreneurship Development Programmes of National Science and technology, Entrepreneurship Development Board (NSTEDB) and Ministry of Science & Technology, Government of India are organised by the newly created Project Management Unit at the Institute.

PGDM – AGRI-BUSINESS MANAGEMENT

VAMNICOM's Centre for Management Education offers a two-year Post Graduate Diploma in Management (PGDM) programme from the year 1993. The centre seeks to mould its young students who come from different academic backgrounds and with diverse skills into competent professionals of tomorrow. The students learn to combine the use of technical skills with the understanding of the socio-cultural system to emerge as leaders in their fields and make significant contribution through management in all sectors of the society. Considering the ever growing requirement for professional Managers in the field of Agri Business, the PGDM programme has been structured with specialization in Agri Business Management (ABM). Students evolve through a structured process that enables them to:

- ✦ Develop required conceptual base in the different subject areas of relevance
- ✦ Acquire the relevant skills in using modern management tools and techniques
- ✦ Develop application skills of appropriate management techniques in the context of agri business

The PGDM has been recognised by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Government of India and recognised by Association of Indian Universities as equivalent to M.B.A. degree.

The programme comprises two segments, viz., classroom and Summer Internship. Of these, the first involves an exposure to concepts, skills and knowledge in the classroom, while the later involves first-hand experience of understanding organizations. Evaluation of students' performance in the Programme is a continuous process, offering opportunity for frequent and regular corrections. All the segments of Programme – classroom study, fieldwork, summer Internship– are evaluated and the results are placed on students' grade card. Students are expected to meet the standards of performance prescribed by the PGDM Committee / Handbook for each segment.



CLASSROOM SEGMENT

The PGDM programme is designed with classroom teaching component integrating case method pedagogy. 41 credits are required to be completed in six terms. 26 credits of subjects offered on Core Management areas and 12 credits of specialization subjects are offered in the area of Agri-Business Management. Three credit courses are devoted to project courses to equip the students to take up challenging assignments in the Agri Business sector.

SUMMER INTERNSHIP SEGMENT

Every student has to undergo eight weeks of Summer Internship which is compulsory during April and May after completion of the first year course. The report prepared by the student will be evaluated by the organization where the student was placed for internship and the same is required to be presented in the class room. The cost involved in summer internship will have to be borne by the students themselves. However, most of the organisations provide financial assistance to students for undertaking summer internship.

ACADEMIC NORMS

The performance of the students in each course in each term shall be evaluated through quizzes, assignments, exercises, class-participation, presentations, projects, short tests, etc., in addition to a mid-term examination and an end-term examination. The respective instructors will inform the combination of the evaluation components and the weightages thereof. The objective of the evaluation, apart from ensuring that students attain the necessary minimum standards, is also to help the students to improve their performance in the courses. Therefore, the evaluation of components shall be arranged so that the students get feedback on their performance at regular intervals. Every full credit course may have at least three clearly visible evaluation components and two such components of evaluation for every half-credit course. No single component should have a weightage of more than 50% of evaluation. The grading system will be based on the five-point scale listed below.

A	Excellent
B	Good
C	Satisfactory
D	Low Pass
F	Fail

Besides, plus (+) and minus (-) signs against A, B, C and D may be added to indicate varying degrees of performance.

Attendance is compulsory in all academic activities. Absence from any session would invite penalty. In case of credit courses; the course GPA would be reduced at the rate of 0.05 per session for absence from a course with permission of the Programme Director on medical grounds, and at the rate of 0.10 per session for any other type of absence. If a student remains absent for more than six sessions in a full credit course and more than three sessions in a half credit course then she/he would be awarded an overall "F" grade in that course.

Minimum Standards

- In each term, a student must obtain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of not less than 2.0; and
- should not obtain "D" grades in more than two courses (in entire Programme) and
- should not obtain "F" in more than one course (in entire Programme) and
- should have cleared any incomplete (I) grade in any course in a term.

Clarification:

If a student obtains "D" in two courses then she/he should not obtain "F" in any other course. If a student obtains "F" in one course, then she/he should not obtain "D" in any other course. If a student fails to fulfill the conditions of minimum standards at any stage of the programme, she/he will be asked to withdraw from the programme at that term itself.

For further details on rules & regulations with regard to conduct of the programme, evaluation / examination pattern & discipline to be maintained etc. refer **PGDM Handbook** which is available on our website.



PROGRAMME COST

The programme fee payable is Rs. 3.19 lakh in First year and 3.21 lakh in Second Year which includes Tuition fee, Examination fee, Internet charges, Sports, Cultural and Students activities, Local Industrial visits, Course Material, Text Books, Group Insurance, Placements Fees, Lodging charges and Preparatory Classes Fees. In addition to programme fees, students are required to pay deposits of Rs. 10,000/- towards Library, Mess and Hostel in the First Year. The fees are payable at the beginning of each term. However, the students who pay the total annual fees at one time will get 5% deduction on Tuition fee. All the students are required to bring their own laptop at the beginning of programme as per the prescribed configuration.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission procedure for the PGDM-ABM (23rd batch) programme commencing in June, 2015 is as given below:

The selection to PGDM-ABM Programme is based on National Level Test scores comprising of

- Latest Written Test score of CAT / MAT / XAT / ATMA / CMAT (GMAT / GRE for foreign Nationals)
- Group Discussion
- Personal Interview

Securing minimum prescribed marks in Personal Interview and Group Discussion are compulsory to become eligible for taking admission.

Note: Candidates interested in pursuing PGDM - ABM at VAMNICOM, Pune are advised to apply and appear the referred national level test directly and apply online to VAMNICOM on or before 31st March 2015 with valid score

Eligibility

- Any graduate from a recognized University, with minimum education of 15 years (10+2+3) full time with atleast 50% marks for the General / OBC (non creamy) candidates and 45% marks for SC / ST candidates in Graduation.
- Latest Valid Test scores of any one of the National level Tests - CAT / MAT / XAT / ATMA / CMAT at the time of application. These guidelines may get modified / subject to be modified depending upon AICTE guidelines from time to time.
- The percentage obtained by the candidate in the Bachelor's Degree would be based on the practice followed by the University / institution from where the candidate has obtained the degree.
- Applicants who have appeared for bachelor's degree examination and awaiting results may also apply subject to fulfillment of conditions by 14/08/2015
- Reservation of seats for OBC (Non Creamy) SC / ST / Physically Challenged persons as per Govt. of India rules.

HOW TO APPLY

The prescribed application form may be downloaded from the website and apply with valid score of CAT / MAT / XAT / ATMA / CMAT on or before 31st March, 2015 by post along with demand draft of Rs. 500/- in favour of "The Director, VAMNICOM, Pune". Online submission of application form is also available.

The Group Discussion and Personal Interview will be conducted at Bengaluru, Bhubaneswar, Dehradun, Chennai, Gandhinagar, Jabalpur, Jaipur (Rajasthan), Kalyani, Nagpur, New Delhi, Patna, Pantnagar and Pune during April & May 2015, subject to sufficient number of students opting for it.

The Institutions which are conducting CAT / MAT / XAT / ATMA / CMAT have no role either in selection process or in the conduct of the programme.

CO-OPERATIVE/GOVERNMENT SPONSORED CANDIDATES

Three seats are reserved for Co-operative, and Central/State Government employees. A Co-operative Organisation having more than 25 employees and having a turnover of more than one crore per annum and Government can sponsor their employees for the PGDM programme. The seats are reserved for such sponsored candidates provided they fulfill the following conditions:

- Any graduate from a recognized University, with minimum education of 15 years (10+2+3) full time with atleast 50% marks for the General / OBC (non creamy) candidates and 45% marks for SC / ST candidates in Graduation.
- The sponsoring organisation should be willing to grant leave to the candidate (if selected) for the period of study and it should make payment of fees and other dues of the candidates to the Institute. Fees will not be accepted from the candidate directly. The candidate should have the valid test score of CAT / MAT / XAT / ATMA / CMAT and appear for the Group Discussion and Personal Interview at Selected Centre.

WARDS OF NCUI / NCCT / VAMNICOM EMPLOYEES

Admission Procedure followed are same as given for General Candidates. Three seats are reserved for the wards of NCUI / NCCT / VAMNICOM employees.

FOREIGN NATIONAL CANDIDATES

20 seats are reserved for Foreign National students / officials working in cooperative or Rural Financing Institutions in SAARC countries and Afro-Asian countries fulfilling the following conditions:

- Any graduate with a minimum of 15 years (10+2+3) of education with minimum 50% marks or its equivalent grade (all the subjects in all the years put together) from a recognized University
- They should possess valid test Score of GMAT / GRE and appear for the Group Discussion and Personal Interview.
- Fee structure followed for Indian students will be applicable for all the Foreign national students / officials deputed for the programme and payable in US\$ (except Nepal and Bhutan nationals who may pay in Indian currency).

SCHOLARSHIPS AND OVERSEAS SUMMER INTERNSHIP

NCUI Scholarship of Rs. 40,000/- per annum is given to six students as per the norms of National Co-operative Union of India, New Delhi.

IFFCO Scholarship of Rs. 15,000/- per annum is given to Two SC and One ST students on merit basis.

VAMNICOM Scholarship of Rs. 30,000/- each is given to one male / female topper student of first year.

CLCTAB Meritorious Prize for two Indian & two foreign nationals.

As part of a MoU between VAMNICOM and National Institute of Co-operative Development (NICD), Sri Lanka, two of the PGDM students will get Summer Internship at Sri Lanka. Under this agreement, VAMNICOM provides one way air travel expenditure from Mumbai or to and fro air travel expenditure from Chennai/Bangalore. Lodging & boarding facilities are provided by NICD, Sri Lanka.

URICM uses VAMNICOM Merit list for admission of the candidates for two year full time Post Graduate Diploma in Management - Agri Business Management. VAMNICOM has no role either in selection process or in the conduct of the programme.



INFRASTRUCTURE



The Library: VAMNICOM has an extremely well endowed and computerized library catering to the research and consultancy needs of the faculty members, students and research scholars with a total collection of about 40,000 books covering different disciplines. It also subscribes to over 182 Indian and foreign journals in the fields of Co-operation, Agriculture, Economics, Banking and Management, etc. The Institute has annual subscription of E-Journals-J-gate, IMC & Delnet which facilitates Students to have access to e-journals & e-books.

Computer Lab: The Institute has the state of the art IT set up to facilitate the students and participants. In all 85 computers in the Institute are connected through Local Area Network. The Internet facility is made available through broadband connectivity in Classrooms & Hostels.



Classroom: The classrooms are equipped with modern teaching and training aids and air condition facility.



Sports Facilities: Facilities for indoor games like Badminton, Table Tennis and Carom games and outdoor games like, basket ball, handball, etc. are provided by the institute.



PGDM Hostel: The PGDM is a fully residential programme and all students stay in the hostels. Two separate hostels- Godavari & Indrayani for boys and girls respectively - have the capacity to accommodate all the students in the spacious and well-furnished rooms with 24 hours broadband connectivity located within the campus.
