Eligibility Criteria

- The programme will be open to the graduates from any recognized university or institute with minimum qualification in/with commerce, management, law, arts, science and engineering except fine arts.
- Candidates who have appeared in common Admission Test (CAT) 2016 Conducted by IIMs are only eligible to apply.
- The candidate must hold a Bachelor's Degree, with at least 55% marks or equivalent CGPA (50% in case of the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST) and Persons with Disability (PWD)/ Differently Abled(DA) category) awarded by any of the Universities incorporated by an act of the central or state legislature in India or other Educational institutions established by an act of



Parliament or declared to be deemed as a University under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, or possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Ministry of HRD, Government of India.

- Candidates appearing for the final year of bachelor's degree/equivalent qualification examination and those who have completed degree requirements and are awaiting results can also apply. If selected, such candidates will be allowed to join the programme provisionally, only if she/he submits a certificate latest by June 30, 2017 from the Principal/Registrar of her/his College/Institute (issued on or before June 30, 2017) stating that the candidate has completed all the requirements for obtaining the bachelor's degree/ equivalent qualification on the date of the issue of the certificate.
- GNLU may verify eligibility at various stages of the selection process. Applicants should note that the mere fulfilment of minimum eligibility criteria will not ensure consideration for short listing by GNLU. Prospective candidates must maintain a valid and unique email account and a phone number throughout the selection process.
- GNLU Academic Regulations and norms, as appropriate, will be applicable to the admitted students.

Activities at GNLU

Research & Publications

At GNLU various initiatives by students and faculty has resulted in the fruitful publication of four journals- The GNLU Law Review (TGLR), The GNLU Journal of Law, Development and politics (GJLDP), The Developing World Review on Trade and Competition (DWRTC) and The Gujarat Law Journal (GLJ), all of which have been nourished with patronage from leading minds in the respective fields of research. Student Welfare and Grievance Redressal Committee (SWGRC)

Academic Support Programme (ASP)

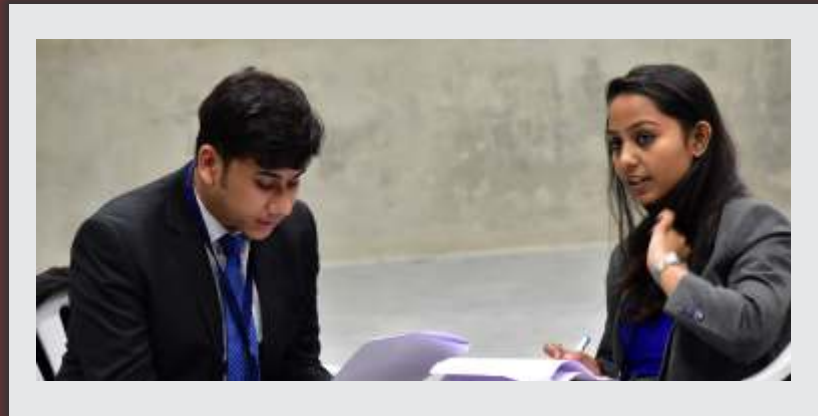
Recognizing that each student has a different capacity, ability with regard to academics, the ASP helps students to realize their academic potential with the help of their peers by providing a support system.

Hague Academy – 2013 Academy Programme

GNLU in association with the Hague Academy of International law, the Netherlands, organized the 40th session of 2013 External Programme at GNLU from 1 to 8 November 2013. This was the first time that the external programme (which was established in the year 1969) was organised in South Asia and GNLU had the honour of hosting the same in its new campus.

Student Research Development Council (SRDC)

The SRDC is formed to promote awareness about and participation in research amongst students. Participation and engagement in such scholarly activities will not only enrich the academic experience but enable one in gaining more knowledge and a deeper appreciation of the academic field. It will also provide students with tools and skills for improving their research capabilities.



GNLU Centre for Business and Public Policy (GCBPP)

GCBPP aims to pursue interdisciplinary research in the field of business management, public policy and law with focus to create and disseminate scholarly knowledge that facilitate corporates, policy makers, government, academicians, small and medium enterprises and non-profit organizations at a national and international level. It also aims at providing the platform for exchange of scholarly views and promotion of ethical and socially responsible entrepreneurial ventures.

GNLU Law & Economics Committee (GLEC)

GNLU Law and Economics Committee (GLEC) is one of the first of its kind in India and certainly the most active one. The objective of the GLEC is to create awareness among public at large about this nascent field of study.

Legal Services Committee (LSC)

The LSC has been set up in tune with the Bar Council of India's mandate to promote programmes for clinical legal education. In furtherance of this, free legal aid clinics, blood donation camps, legal literacy initiatives, educational activities and awareness programmes are undertaken in villages that have been adopted by the LSC. In addition to this, its members from time to time have submitted various reports and attended various conferences in matter of policy reform.



GNLU Legal Incubation Centre

In line with top research houses and international management and law schools, GNLU has also instituted a unique Legal Incubation Centre to promote legal entrepreneurship among its students with an initial investment of Rs. 10 lakhs. It would help those students who are willing to take an initiative to start the venture on their own. To make them independent, GNLU is creating a platform to groom their skills not only to start a law firm but also to take up consultancy work, pursue research, provide legal opinions and drafting of documents for companies.
