


## Introduction

Bachelor of Computer Applications popularly known as BCA is an undergraduate academic course in Computer Applications for aspirants willing to build their career in the field of Software & Information Technology. Bachelors of Computer Applications degree can be obtained typically in a minimum of three years with six semesters.

Numerous reputed colleges offer courses in Computer Applications, but it is required that candidates qualify the entrance examinations conducted by these colleges or other recognised universities. Few colleges also grant admission to BCA course on the basis of Higher Secondary Examinations marks. Certain colleges even conduct a session of Personal Interview after the entrance examination, before commencing with the final admission procedure.

## Important BCA Entrance Exams

### Bharatiya Vidyapeeth Undergraduate Management Aptitude Test (BUMAT)

BUMAT (Bharati Vidyapeeth Undergraduate Management Aptitude Test) is conducted by Bharati Vidyapeeth University for admission to its BBA/BCA course.

Both BBA and BCA programmes are offered at BVU's following campuses:

- Abhijit Kadam Institute Of Management And Social Sciences, Solapur
- Institute Of Management And Entrepreneurship Development, Pune
- Institute Of Management And Research, New Delhi
- Institute Of Management And Rural Development Administration, Sangli
- Institute Of Management, Kolhapur
- Yashwantrao Mohite Institute Of Management, Karad

#### **BUMAT Exam Pattern**

BUMAT is conducted offline in pen-paper mode, and the duration of the exam is 2.5 hours.

Candidates are provided 4 answer options along with each question. Only one out of these options is to be selected by the test-takers. Every correct answer carries 1 mark. There is no negative marking.

BUMAT 2018 will be divided into the following sections:

## Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University Common Entrance Test

Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University (GGSIPU) conducts a common entrance test, IPU CET for admissions to its various UG and PG level programmes.

### IPU CET Exam Pattern

IPU CET exam is conducted in an offline mode, and the question paper comprises a total of 150 questions. Students need to complete the paper in the set time duration, which is 2-½ hours.

For every question answered correctly, the aspirants will get 4 marks while for every incorrect answer, one mark will be deducted. The questions in the exam will be from General English, General Knowledge & Numerical Ability – all these are given equal weightage.

## Symbiosis Entrance Test (SET)

Symbiosis Entrance Test or SET is a common entrance exam for undergraduate courses offered at institutes of Symbiosis International University. SET score is valid for admission to Symbiosis Centre for Management Studies, Pune and Noida campuses.

### SET Exam Pattern

SET is conducted in two sessions, morning and afternoon for 2.5 hours. The question paper consists of MCQs in which the candidate has to select one appropriate answer from four options given. There will be no negative marking.

The question paper is divided into four sections:

## Gitam Science Admissions Test (GSAT)

GITAM Institute of Science conducts GSAT (GITAM Science Admission Test) to offer admission to aspirants in UG and PG level science programmes offered by it. GITAM Institute of Science is a part of GITAM University and it offers many undergraduate as well as postgraduate programmes to aspirants.

### GSAT Exam Pattern

Separate exams are conducted to offer admission to aspirants in different courses offered at GITAM Institute of Science. The test pattern for GSAT BCA exam is as mentioned below:

GSAT test for admission in BCA comprises 60 multiple choice questions of one mark each.

**Note:** Aspirants who have qualified GAT (GITAM Admission Test) are also eligible to secure admission in BCA, BEM, MSc Biotechnology (5 year integrated) and BSc courses.

## Lucknow University Computer Science Admission Test (LUCSAT)

Lucknow University conducts LUCSAT (Lucknow University Computer Science Admission Test) for admissions to its two year BCA & MCA programmes. The BCA programme offered by the University lays emphasis on application development by incorporating soft development skills. The major thrust is endowing students a sound background in computing, business function, mathematics related to information technology.

### LUCSAT Exam Pattern

A 90 minute (1.5 hour) exam, LUCSAT comprises multi-choice questions carrying 100 marks. Each question is of 4 marks. One mark is deducted for each incorrect answer. Zero mark is awarded for each un-attempted question.

Entrance Test Question paper consists multiple choice questions. Details are explained below:

## All India Management Association – Centre of Management Studies Under Graduate Aptitude Test (UGAT)

The All India Management Association conducts AIMA Under Graduate Aptitude Test (UGAT). This exam is a gateway for admission to under graduate programs like BBA, BCA, BHM, Integrated MBA (IMBA) etc. Year after year, the conducting body, AIMA declares a list of UGAT participating institutes.

### **AIMA UGAT Exam Pattern**

UGAT tests candidates on their knowledge of English, Logical Reasoning, General Knowledge and Numerical & Data Analysis. The exam is conducted in pen and paper mode as well as online mode i.e. computer-based mode. Candidates need to mention their preferable exam mode at the time of filling the application form.

The duration of the exam is mostly of 2 hours. The test pattern for BCA is as follows:

## RAMA University Entrance Test (RUET)

Rama University Entrance Test (RUET) is a national aptitude test, for candidates seeking admission to Graduate, Postgraduate and PhD courses offered by Rama University. Admission to all the courses offered by Rama University is granted only on the basis of entrance test. The date of entrance test varies for different courses.

### RUET Exam Pattern

The entrance test is mandatory to get admission in Rama University. This applies to all the courses offered at our university. For different courses there are different exam dates.

The test will be of multiple choice containing 120 questions on following subjects/topic in single question Booklet.

## North Maharashtra University Undergraduate Common Entrance Test (NMU UG CET)

North Maharashtra University (NMU) offers admission to various undergraduate programs through the common entrance test, NMU UG CET which is conducted by the University. The NMU Undergraduate Common Entrance Test (UGCET) is a gateway for candidates seeking admission to BBA, BMS, BMS (e-Commerce), BCA, and MCA (Integrated), MBA (Integrated) into the Affiliated Colleges/University Department.

### NMU UG CET Exam Pattern

The question paper consists of MCQs in which the candidate has to select one appropriate answer from four options given. There will be no negative marking. Get further details on the exam pattern below.


## Sri Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Learning Admissions Test (SSSIHLAT)

Sri Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Learning Admissions Test formally known as SSSIHLAT is a common entrance test conducted by Sri Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Learning. This exam is a gateway for candidates to get enrolled into a variety of courses offered at the institute.

### SSSIHLAT Exam Pattern

The admission test is largely objective, and it includes multiple-choice questions that are evaluated by an Optical Mark Recognition (OMR) system. The OMR system is foolproof and 100% accuracy is guaranteed during evaluation. Negative marks are awarded for every incorrect answer – this is usually 25% of the total marks allocated for that particular question. The pattern of entrance test is as follows:
