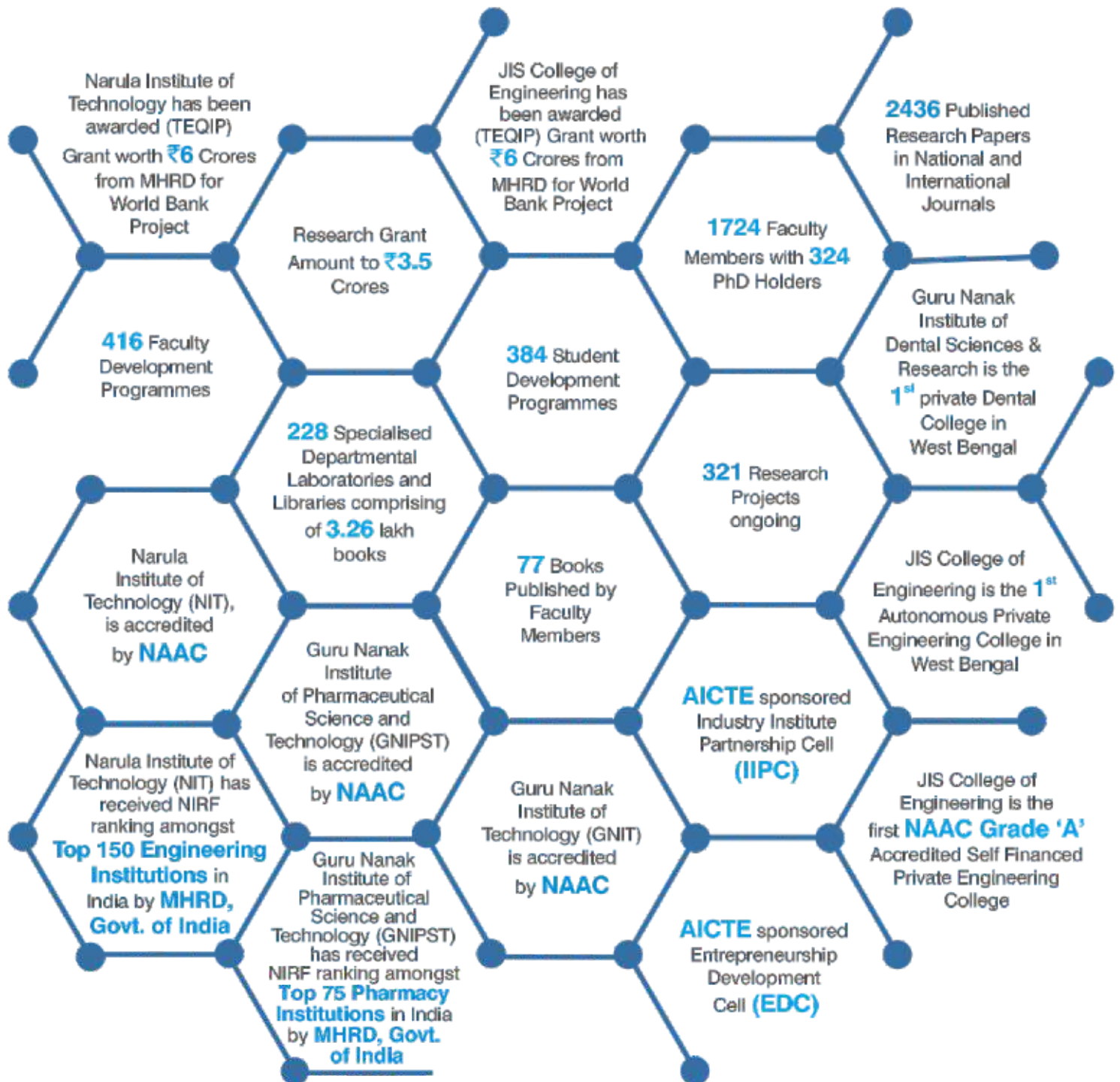

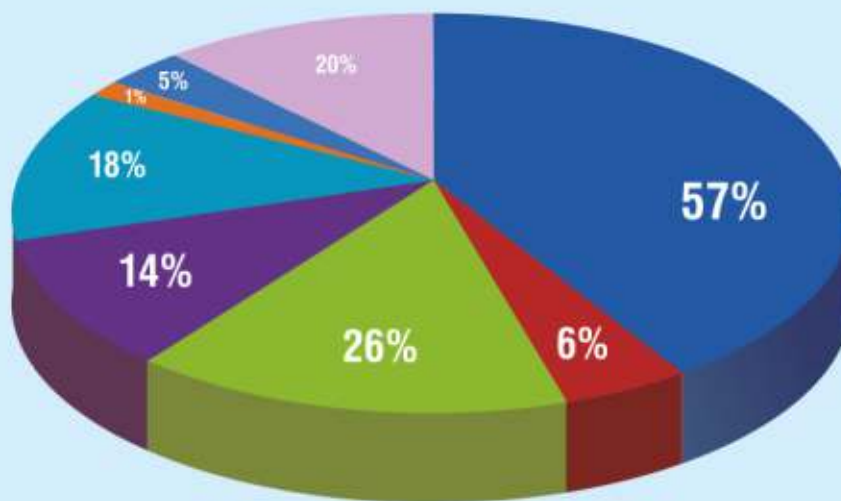

Act XIII of 2000) and also as per the notification by All India Council for Technical Education on the prevention and prohibition of ragging in technical Institutions, Universities including Deemed-to-be-Universities imparting technical education F.No. 37-/Legal/AICTE/2009.

Ragging and the Legal Provisions

Ragging and the Legal Provisions Enactment of Central and the State laws, makes ragging a cognizable offence with identifying the perverse forms of ragging under such law(s), and giving punishments appropriate with the cruelty of the offence -

- A student indulged in the act of raging his/her juniors may be expelled from college/university.
- He/she may be banned/debarred from staying in hostel/mess.
- Scholarship/stipend/financial grant can be withdrawn/cancelled by the college/university.
- He/she may be debarred from appearing at future examinations of university.
- He/she may be debarred from taking admision to any other educational Institute In the state or even in the entire country.
- He/she may be charge sheeted and court of law may try the accused student.
- It may, after taking all precautions, give severe punishment to meet the end of justice.

Industry Institute Partnership Cell (IIPC)

JIS believes that students can be made industry-ready only when there is a strong relationship between the institute and industry and this can be only achieved by building a strong Industry Institute Partnership Cell (IIPC) in every institute.

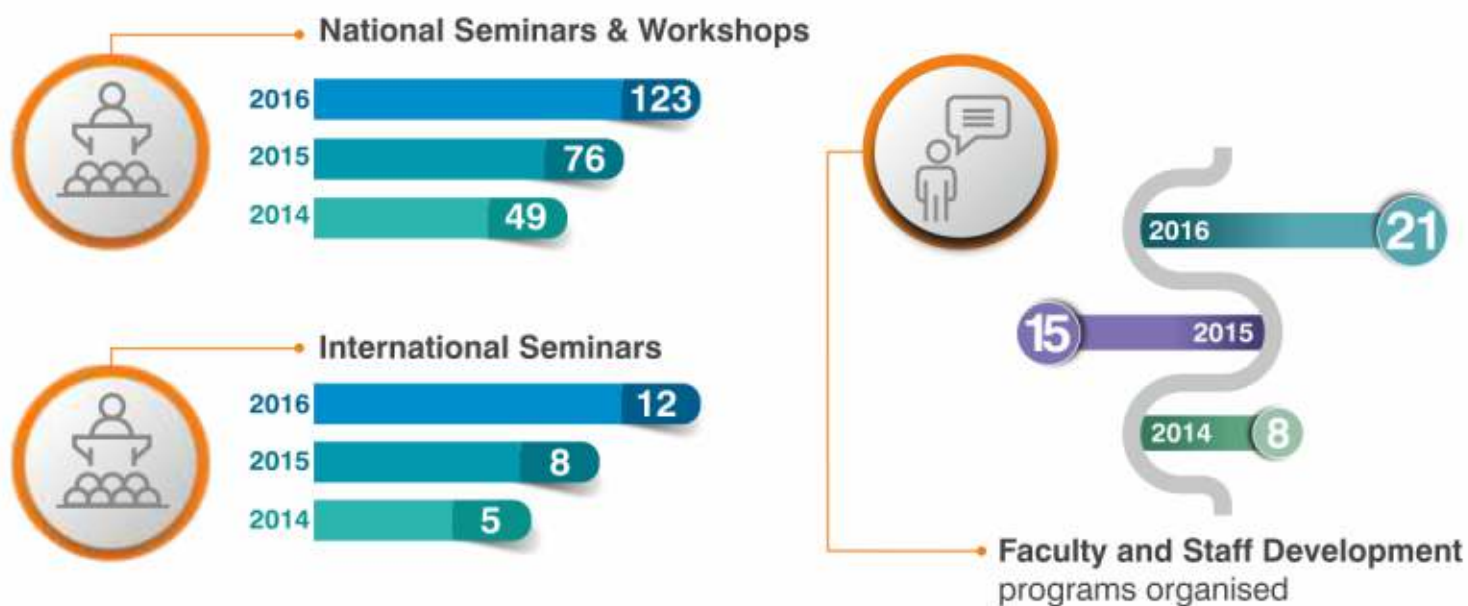
Research and Development (R&D)

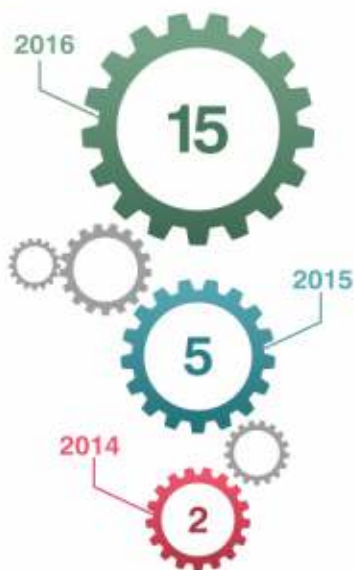


Graphical Representation of R&D Achievements

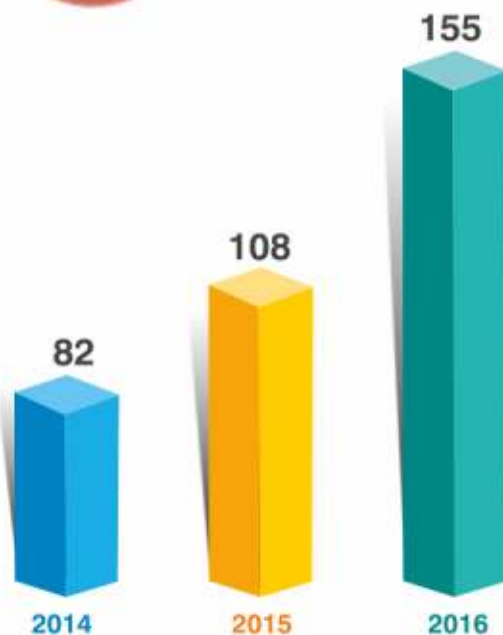

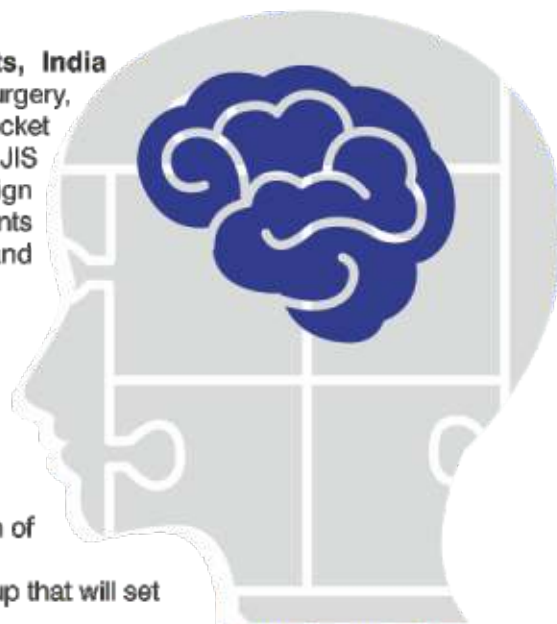

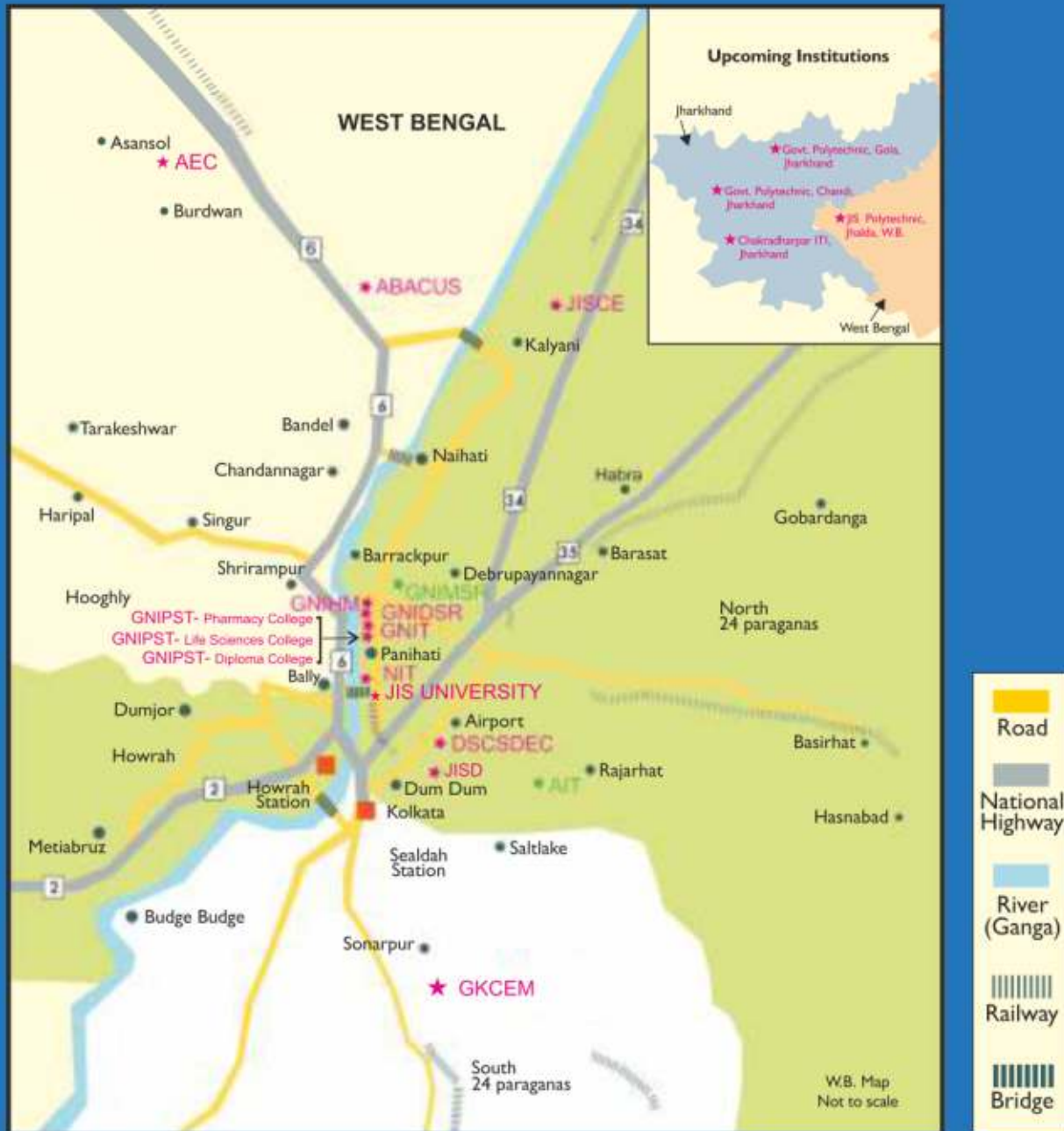
