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## ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

### Genesis

Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak, established in 1976 as a residential University with the objective of promoting inter-disciplinary higher education and research with special emphasis on studies of Life Sciences, Environmental and Ecological Sciences is making rapid progress to emerge as a leading educational institution of the nation. Presently, M.D. University is a teaching-cum-affiliating University with a formidable track record in academics, research, extension, cultural and sports activities. The University has been awarded 'A' grade by N.A.A.C. in July, 2013. It has been placed at 76<sup>th</sup> rank amongst Indian Universities by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India, as part of National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) survey 2018.

### Academic Landscape

In a span of 41 years, the University has progressed by leaps and bounds to emerge as a leading centre of higher education in the country. Being an affiliating University, it has jurisdiction over 09 districts of the state and 276 colleges of these districts come under the ambit of the University, out of which 106 are professional institutes.

At present, the University is offering 158 academic programs through 11 faculties and 38 post-graduate teaching departments. University Institute of Engineering and Technology (UIET) and University Institute of Law and Management Studies (UILMS) located at Gurugram are autonomous constituent institutes of the University. Directorate of Distance Education (DDE) of the University is widely acknowledged as a premier open learning institute in the country. It offers a wide range of courses in diverse traditional, professional and job-oriented streams, including those in the various emerging areas of science and technology.

### Research Centres and Chairs

The University has cultivated healthy tradition by establishing various Chairs to take up research on the lives, works, and contributions of eminent persons of national status such as Sir Chhotu Ram, Dr B.R. Ambedkar, Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru, Maharshi Dayanand, MaharshiValmiki, Pandit Lakhmi Chand, Sant Kabir, Ch. Ranbir Singh, Dr.Mangal Sen and Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyay with the purpose to carry out research on his life and contribution to the Indian polity. The Centre for Haryana Studies has made strides in taking up the various issues pertaining to Haryana by conducting field studies. Ch. Ranbir Singh Institute of Social and Economic Change has been established by the University as an independent advanced research centre to carry out grass-root level research on the socio-economic issues specific to the state of Haryana and to provide critical inputs for formulating strategies and programs to compliment and supplement government initiatives.

### Research Contribution

Research activities occupy a place of utmost importance in the University's working. Its faculty have contributed over 2400 research papers and over 350 chapters in books/ Published conference proceedings in the past 5 years. Notably, the University publishes three Research Journals, namely, *MDU Research Journal (Arts)*, *Journal of People and Society of Haryana*, and *MDU Law Journal*.

The faculty have been awarded over a hundred research projects by various funding agencies like UGC, CSIR, DBT, DST, etc. 19 departments of the University have received about Rs. 16.5 crores under the Special Assistance Program (SAP), Innovative Program and Basic Scientific assistance (BSR) Infrastructure Grant of the University Grants Commission, New Delhi.

To promote research on its own account, the University provides 40 University Research Scholarships annually, accumulating to about 160 in a given financial year. Fifteen (15) additional University Research Scholarships are exclusively meant for SC category students. At present, 325 students are registered for Ph.D. in different departments. There are 279 JRFs and 72 SRFs, besides 54 Rajiv Gandhi National Fellows have availed fellowship for pursuing their research degrees.

### **Collaborations & MoUs**

The University has entered into national and international level strategic tie-ups with academic and research organizations for joint academic and research programs. 22 MoUs have already been signed and nine are under consideration. Recently University has also signed MoU with National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) to provide skill development avenues to the University students and with Global Village Foundation (GVF) for collaborative work in higher education, policy planning and social issues. University has also signed an MoU with EUSAI for promotion of sports activities in March 2017. The various University Teaching Departments are having active research collaborations with 48 national and 15 international institutions.

### **Academic Reforms**

Academic reforms always remain high on agenda of the University and it consistently endeavours to deliver higher, multi-dimensional and topical academic standards. With these goals in mind, the University has made far-reaching academic reforms for the holistic growth of students and multifarious development of the academic and research environment. Introduction of **Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)** in Post-graduate courses from the session 2016-2017 was a major progressive step towards qualitative improvement in academics. New M. Phil. /Ph.D. ordinance as per latest UGC guidelines was introduced from January 2017. To increase employability of students, a number of Vocational Courses viz. B Voc. (Information Technology/ Marketing Management), B. Voc. (Sports, Nutrition & Physiotherapy/ Catering Technology & Hotel Management) have been introduced.

Academic Audit of the teaching departments has been got done as per required norms to ensure better performance on all internal quality parameters. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), established as per guidelines of NAAC, acts as a beacon of quality assurance and maintenance of academic standards with respect to various important functional requirements. Other measures, like seeking students' feedback and reactions of other stakeholders, are routinely pursued to incorporate them as healthy decision-making inputs for academic quality improvements. Timely holding of examinations and declaration of results in accordance with the pre-determined schedule are other marked achievements of the University.

The initiatives taken by the University in this direction are visible on ground too. The University got 44<sup>th</sup> rank in National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) 2016 survey organized by Ministry of Human Resources Development (HRD), Govt. of India.

The Department of Pharmaceutical Science secured 28<sup>th</sup> rank amongst all Pharmacy Institutions of India in NIRF Survey' 2017 organized by Ministry of Human Resources Development (HRD), Govt. of India. It was ranked overall First amongst Pharmacy Institutions in Haryana, and Sixth in Northern Region of India.

### **Distance Learning Programs**

The Directorate of Distance Education (DDE), originally established as a Correspondence Cell in 1988, is contributing significantly towards achieving the national objective of providing quality education to one and all by fulfilling its motto to reach the unreached by offering useful distance education programs to learners belonging to different parts of the State/Country. The various programs offered by the Directorate range from conventional to professional as per needs of the area and employment opportunities available in the country. In order to meet the growing demands of open and distance learning, the Directorate has acquired resources for further access to rural areas.

The Directorate offers 13 popular Undergraduate/Postgraduate programs i.e. Bachelor of Arts (B.A.), Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.), Master of Arts (Hindi, English, Sanskrit, Economics, Political Science, Public Admn., History), Master of Science (Mathematics), Master of Commerce (M.Com.), Bachelor of Library & Information Science, Master of Library & Information Science for Distance Learners based on carefully designed curriculum, well planned teaching learning strategies, effective student support system for an effectual functioning, fair examination and evaluation system. The cumulative strength of the students of DDE has increase to 70184 in year 2017-18.

The Directorate has evolved the concept of "Students Support Services Camps (SSSCs)" to help and groom the distance learners in several ways. Student Support Service in open and distance learning system is quite different from other services. These services are not only confined to interactive counselling or solving the learners' problems but also include promoting distance learning to address the issue of continuous upgradation of skills so as to produce manpower resources of the kind and the number required by society, to fulfill the expectations indicated in the National Education Policy. Further, the SSSCs are aimed to facilitate learning, counselling and to solve the question bank/ assignments provided by the Directorate. Through SSSCs, the learners get an opportunity to interact with the counsellors and the peer group. The broad focus of the course of the Directorate is on learners' personality development, inculcating soft-skills, career counselling and guidance and community education.

### **University Library Services**

The University library, named after the revered social reformer Swami Vivekananda, offers highly conducive and enabling academic environment. It functions in its best mode as an effective knowledge treasury for the students and teachers in the contemporary information era. Strategically located, the Vivekananda library with excellent state-of-the art computer facilities and latest infrastructure is housed in a magnificent 3 storeyed building with 84000 sq. ft. carpet area and a seating capacity of 963 users, a separate air-conditioned reading hall with 80 seats for the researchers with another 14000 sq. ft. carpet area and 315 reading seats in its five off-shoots. It has an air-conditioned Internet Lab with 80 PCs, 1Gbps bandwidth internet connectivity, a multimedia library with 20 PCs, and an advanced Videoconferencing facility. Application of RFID technology for self check-out check-in with security gates has been implemented and the CCTV system for library security is in operation.

The Library has a rich collection of knowledge resources – 3,64,734 volumes of books, 16,558 theses and dissertations, and 53,518 bound volumes of journals. Besides, 400 Indian and 76 foreign journals are subscribed in print form. Online access is provided to 23624 e-Books of renowned publishers, 24553 e-Journals through J-Gate Plus, Shodhganga – an Indian ETD Repository as its members, SCOPUS-an Elsevier database of abstracts and citation from more than 22,800 science and social science journals, Emerald Management Plus - a full text database of 298 e-Journals with journal coverage available as far back as 1898. The emerald backfiles collection provides access to over 68,000 digitized archive articles from over 120 journals. Access to Manupatra- a database of legal documents, four CMIE databases, MLA International Bibliography and J-Gate Plus has also been provided through campus network. Turnitin & Urkund – plagiarism check/similarity check software, Ezproxy – connects library clientele remotely to subscribed electronic resources, are new additions to the library e-resources.

The University invests around Rs.400/- lac annually on the enrichment of knowledgebase, besides having substantial recurring and non-recurring budget for other library activities including upgradation of existing facilities.

### **E-Governance Initiatives**

The University has embraced the use of latest technological advancement in governance system and has already acknowledged as a front runner in taking e-governance initiatives. Admission process to the various programs of University Teaching Departments and Directorate of Distance Education were made online and to stop admission related malpractices, especially to stop impersonation in the entrance tests, introduction of Biometric attendance in entrance tests has been introduced. The major e-governance initiatives taken by the University in last two years include online file tracking system, computerization of examination work and establishment of separate college portal. To provide and facilitate DIGIDHAN initiative of Government of India, POS have been installed at University Cashier Office and DIGIDHAN Awareness Programs have been organized by the University to make the employees and students aware about digital financial transactions.

### **Games and Sports**

The Directorate of Sports of the University has the distinction of producing a large number of sportspersons of national and international repute including several Arjuna and Bheem Awardees—who brought laurels not only to the University and the state, but to the nation as well. For harnessing the potential of the youth and promoting sports, the University has created excellent infrastructure including fully air-conditioned Dr. Mangal Sen Multipurpose Gymnasium, Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel Cricket Stadium and Swimming Pool of international standards. Synthetic athletics track, lawn tennis courts, boxing hall, wrestling hall, kabaddi hall, squash hall, separate sports hostel, and a sprawling sports complex having playfields are available for the students. The Directorate of Sports of the University organizes approximately 70 inter-college events for student players of the University, colleges and other universities. It also holds coaching camps for selected student players and sends teams for inter-University and world University games/tournaments.

The University awards the position holders with handsome cash prizes every year during the Annual Sports Prize Distribution Function. In the World University Games 2016, 21 students of the University participated in various tournaments. 12 student players of the University participated in the Rio Olympic Games 2016, and Ms. Shakshi Malik (M.D.U. alumna) won Bronze Medal in

Women Wrestling. The University has produced 144 international players in different games/tournaments from 1976 to 2016. The association of Indian University, New Delhi allotted 12<sup>th</sup> North Zone Inter University/ All India Inter University games competition during the session 2016-17 to M.D.U. Rohtak. The University has achieved 34 positions in various games/tournaments /championships in 2016-17.

The University also felicitated sports persons who participated in Rio Olympics. During the period – January, 2017 to March, 2017, M.D.University has won 12 Championships, and got runners' up title in 12 Championships. With the state- of-the-art infrastructure and strong emphasis on sports, the University can be proudly called as a 'Sports Nursery'.

### **Students' Welfare Activities**

The University lays special emphasis on students' welfare, and, therefore, has a full-fledged office for this purpose. The office is housed in a magnificent Students Activity Centre, equipped with all modern amenities. It has a Bookshop with availability of all types of books and stationery, Cyber Café for internet surfing, Conference Hall with Internet connectivity, well-designed modular furnished separate Common Rooms for boys and girls with the facilities of newspapers, magazines, and indoor games, and above all, a happening place for student community.

It organizes various activities *viz* Fine Art, Literary & Culture and Adventure sports, etc. A large number of camps and adventure courses like Trekking, Youth Leadership Training Camps, Rock Climbing, Snow Skiing, Value-based Spiritual Courses, Personality Development Camp, etc. are organized.

Five Zonal Youth Festivals and one Inter-Zonal Youth Festival consisting of 40 events of Music, Dance, Theatre, Literary, Fine Arts and Culture are organized during an academic session. A Techno-Management Fest, especially designed for the students of Engineering, Management and other technical Institutions and EDUFEST for Colleges of Education are organized.

M.D. University was the proud host of a cultural extravaganza, the 21<sup>st</sup> NATIONAL YOUTH FESTIVAL from January 12-16, 2017. The Festival (NYF) was organized by the Centre and Haryana government in collaboration on the theme 'Youth For Digital India'. In this carnival, more than 6000 delegates participated and more than 4 lakh spectators visited the festival site. The Mega Event was a great success, winning accolades from Government of India, Government of Haryana, participating States, and other stake holder organizations.

A Youth Centre for Skill Development is functioning especially for enhancing communication skills and providing guidance for SSB interview for selection in Armed Forces. More than 205 students (including 35 girls) who had undertaken guidance from the centre have been selected in Armed Forces & other services. The Department is also running Samarth scheme, from interest earned on special corpus, for physically challenged students. Under "Earn While Learn Scheme" Rs. 126,100/- were spent for the benefit of students.

### **Hostels and Campus Life**

The University provides residential accommodation on the campus to over 5000 students in the 19 hostels (Ten for girls and nine for boys). Maintenance of salubrious and caring environment in the hostel complexes and provision of hygienic food at reasonable charges always remains the endeavour of the University authorities. Mess in each hostel has facilities for indoor games,

recreation, STD and canteen. All girls' hostels have been provided Wi-Fi internet connectivity. Each Girls Hostel is looked after by a full time Lady Warden.

All efforts have been made to have an aesthetically pleasing side of the entire campus. Well laid out figures and meaningful creations installed on important road crossings, like the ones named as Jai Jawan – Jai Kisan Chowk, Kranti Chowk, and Maharshi Dayanand Chowk, testify to the vision and purpose in campus planning. Blooming flowers in the Rose Garden, well-paved sidewalks, carefully pruned plants along both sides of the campus roads, abundant greenery, and the resulting eco-friendly ambience give a majestic look to our clean, green and eco-friendly campus.

To imbue a sense of confidence and appreciation of the moral virtues throughout the campus, the University has taken following initiatives for value creation and nation building.

- Daily *Hawan* program initiated in University at *Yajshala*.
- Initiating University academic program (s) with University *Kulgeet*, and marking the closure of program (s) with *National Anthem*.
- Special Book Exhibition based on Swami Vivekanand Ji organized on January 12, 2016.
- Naming and marking of University Lanes in the names of National luminaries i.e. Shaheed Bhagat Singh Marg, Shaheed Rajguru Marg, and Shaheed Sukhdev Marg on March 23, 2017.
- Digital Health Card Scheme (after comprehensive health check-up of the 1<sup>st</sup> year students) was introduced. The health data of the students shall be available on University website through the password allotted to the student. This is going to be unique initiative for any State University which will help in promoting the '*Swachh Bharat: Swasth Bharat*' Mission with healthy Young India.

### **Infrastructural Development**

Infrastructure is the key component of expansion and growth of an organization. The University has the privilege of having state of the art infrastructure, one of the best in the country. Foundation Stone for Arya Bhatt Central Instrumentation Laboratory (CIL) was laid on 2/3/2017. Haryana Chief Minister, Shri ManoharLal, on April 5, 2017 laid foundation stone for Deen Dayal Upadhyay Institute for Entrepreneurship and Skill Development and on the same day Deen Dayal Upadhyay Yuva Udyan's foundation stone was laid by him. Air Conditioning Plant for Dr. Mangal Sen Multipurpose Indoor Gymnasium Hall and One Mega Solar Power Plant were also inaugurated by Haryana Chief Minister a few days ago.

There is ample residential facility for University employees – both teaching and non-teaching. Twelve New Faculty Flats for teaching staff and 36 new I-A Quarters for non-teaching staff have been recently inaugurated. New Sports Hostel (50-seater capacity) for sports persons was inaugurated in March 2017. Swarn Jayanti Dept. of Visual Arts Building was inaugurated in November 2016.

### **Special Initiatives and outreach programs**

To commemorate the golden jubilee year of the state, the University organized Haryana Swarn Jayanti Special Lecture Program on July 15, 2016. Justice Permod Kohli, Chairperson,

Central Administrative Tribunal (CAT) delivered a lecture for the program. The Department of Visual Arts of the University organized Swarn Jayanti Fine Arts Exhibition from Nov. 2016.

Fulfilling its commitment towards the society, the University has launched several outreach initiatives and programs in order to inculcate awareness in the about important social, digital, financial issues. Awareness Program (s) about cashless transactions and digital financial transactions were organized under the aegis of Centre for Haryana Studies in the current session. Affiliated colleges organized Public Outreach Programs in various villages focusing on social issues.

The University does its best to provide all possible help to the students for career counseling, personality development, skill development, skill upgradation, and seeking appropriate work placements. The Dept. of English in collaboration with the Dept. of Student Welfare have organized English speaking classes in the dept. premises. Under the aegis of this Centre, SC/ST and BC category students received all the training free of cost. The University also has a University Centre for Competitive Examinations (UCCE) which offers guidance to the students for various competitive examinations like NET, SSC, Civil Services Examination etc.

### **Gender Sensitization**

The state of Haryana proudly acknowledges the rectification of skewed sex ratio with more than 900 girls per 1000 boys reflecting the positive outcome of efforts such as “Beti Bachao Beti Padhao”. Keeping up the spirit of gender sensitization, the University endeavours to create a congenial, secure and progressive environment for the girl students. At the same time the awareness regarding gender is disseminated to all and sundry through Women Study Centre, Anti Sexual Harassment Cell in collaboration with the Haryana police.

The mascot of 21<sup>st</sup> national youth festival “Lado” reflects the sensitivity of Haryana government towards the gender inequality in the state. It also signifies bringing women at par with men. Along with these efforts, a number of Workshops on ‘Gender Sensitization and Women Safety at Work Place’ and on ‘Women Safety and Self Defense Techniques’ were organized for girl students of the University in collaboration with Haryana police (Women’s Cell).

### **Environmental Sustainability Management (ESM) Cell**

The University has successfully established an Environmental Sustainability Management Cell with a sole purpose to inculcate a proper understanding of waste management issues. The cell organizes various competitive activities as well by promoting awareness and ensuring participation of young people particularly students. In order to generate awareness about waste management , the cell organizes various activities in the form of seminars, conferences, poster presentations, etc. highlighting the issues of environmental pollutants and their remedies, environmental sustainability, climate changes, green renewal energy systems, so on and so forth.

### **Women’s Studies Centre**

Established in January, 2010 with financial support from University Grants Commission, New Delhi, Women’s Studies Centre at Maharshi Dayanand University is a leading interdisciplinary centre. From the very beginning, the thrust has been to understand women’s issues from gender perspective and thereby develop a comprehensive and critical approach to strengthen gender equality for overall empowerment of women in the society. The Centre is engaged in micro-level field studies and generation of awareness programs. For this, it actively collaborates with

academia, government establishments and civil society to have broader perspective on wider issues concerning women in contemporary India in general and Haryana in particular. Women's Studies Centre also strives to disseminate knowledge among different strata of society by promoting dialogue between academia and activists, social work and policy making. By facilitating research, advocacy, documentation and extension work, efforts are initiated to enhance the visibility of women in the community and wider society. As a strategy, it seeks to strengthen individual and institutional efforts to enable women's empowerment in the society.

### **Grievance Redressal Cell**

The University has constituted a grievance redressal cell redresses the complaints of the students of the University and its affiliated colleges particularly pertaining to the results, registration and scholarship branches, Colleges and Hostels. The Registrar, Dean, College Development Council, Controller of Examinations, Dean Students' Welfare and Chief Warden (Boys and Girls) will review the unresolved cases every week and ensure that no grievance remained unresolved beyond a fortnight

### **SC/ST Cell**

The SC/ST Cell has been established by the University under Paragraph 14 referred to sub-clause (a) of paragraph 6 of UGC guidelines, in order to process the grievances of the members of SC/ST communities, functioning under the overall supervision of the Liaison Officer, works for the welfare of SC/ST candidates. It monitors the implementation of policies and programs related to admissions, appointments and promotions of SC/ST candidates. The Cell endeavors to ensure the benefit of Central Govt. / State Govt. policies related to SC/ST students and employees.

The Special Cell is functioning under Prof.Des Raj, Liaison Officer, SC/ST Cell (Contact No 9416357414),Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak.

### **Foreign Students' Cell**

The University has a full-fledged Foreign Students' Cell headed by Advisor Students Cell. The Cell acts as the Nodal Agency and assists the International students community in acquiring information about registration, various courses, tuition fee structure, eligibility, visa requirements and their overall welfare through a unique 'single window system'.

There is a provision of 15% supernumerary seats for International students in each University Teaching Department subject to the fulfillment of eligibility conditions as per University rules. It is mandatory to obtain an eligibility certificate from the O/o the Advisor, Foreign Students' Cell, M.D.University, Rohtak.

The Cell also provides Educational and Vocational guidance. In addition, to catering to the psychological needs of the students, the Centre provides personal and career counseling to them. ## **SUPERNUMERARY SEATS**

**In addition to the sanctioned seats, supernumerary seats for the following categories will be as under:-**

### **For Kashmiri Migrants:**

1. Two supernumerary seats in each course offered in the University Teaching Departments and the University Institute of Law and Management Studies, Gurugram, (except the courses run under the norms of BCI, NCTE& PCI) have been earmarked for Kashmiri Migrants.

### **For Sports :**

2. One seat in each course (except the courses run under the norms of AICTE, PCI and NCTE) where the strength is upto 30 and 2 seats where the strength is more than 30 have been earmarked for outstanding sportspersons over and above the sanctioned intake, subject to the fulfillment of other conditions, the admission against seats be made according to the following criteria in order of preference:-

i) **Category A-I :**

- a) The candidate should have won 1<sup>st</sup>/ 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> position in Olympic Games, World Championship, World Cup, World University Games, Davis Cup, Wimbledon Championship, U.S. French and Australian Open Tennis Championships, Thomas Cup, Uber Cup, and all England Badminton Tournament.
- b) Participation in the above mentioned tournaments.

ii) **Category A-II :**

- a) 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> position in Champions Trophy, Commonwealth Games, Commonwealth Championships, Asian Games, Asian Championships, Asian Cup, World Inter-national Athletic Permit Meet and SAF Games.
- (b) Participation in the tournaments mentioned in A-II point.

iii) **Category B:**

- a) 1<sup>st</sup> /2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> position in AllU Tournaments/National Games/National Championships/ Federation Cup organized by National Sports Federations recognized by the Govt. of India.
- b) Participation in the games mentioned in B category.

iv) **Category C :**

- a) 1<sup>st</sup> /2<sup>nd</sup> /3<sup>rd</sup> position in Zonal Inter-University Tournaments/Zonal National Tournaments/representation of AIU team.

- v) Only those games which are recognized and adopted by the Inter-University Sports Board of India and approved by AIU will be considered for determining admission against sports seats. List of games approved by AIU is available at Appendix-L.

- vi) The candidates should be eligible for Inter-University Tournaments during the year of admission.

- vii) There should be continuity of participation of applicant at various levels including Inter-University Tournaments and his performance should not be more than one year old.

- viii) The candidate better in sports will be admitted as per merit decided by the Admission Committee of the concerned Department/College. **In case of any dispute in this regard, the decision of the committee comprising the following shall be final :-**

- i) **Dean of the concerned Faculty.**
  - ii) **Director (Sports)**
  - iii) **Head, Department of Physical Education**
- ix) In case of tie in sports merit, the candidate better in academic merit shall be given preference.
  - x) It will be mandatory for the admitted students to participate in the sports activities of his/her Dept./University.
  - xi) The age of the student should not exceed 28 years.
  - xii) The sports certificates and photographs of the player must be attested by the Secretary of the concerned Federation.
  - xiii) The candidate must possess the gradation certificate (other than University Tournaments) from the Sports Dept. of his/her state, on the basis of his/her representation/position at National/Inter-national/Zonal/State level tournaments in the games recognised by AIU from time to time.

**For Youth Festival/Cultural Activities.**

3. One supernumerary seat in each course (except the courses run under the norms of AICTE, NCTE & PCI) in University Teaching Departments has been earmarked to promote cultural activities subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:
  - i) Any position in the National Youth Festival organized by the Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi.
  - ii) First position holder in the North Zone Inter University Youth Festival organized by the Association of Indian Universities.
  - iii) The age of the student should not exceed 23 years.
  - iv) It will be mandatory for the admitted students to participate in the cultural activities of his/her Department/University and should have consistently participated in the youth festivals.
  - v) The maximum age limit to participate in the Youth Festival of MDU and Association of Indian Universities is 25 years. So when a student takes admission in any Department with an age of 23 years can participate for next two years as per rules.
4. There is provision of having 15% additional supernumerary seats for foreign candidates, out of which 1/3<sup>rd</sup> seats have been earmarked for the children of Indian workers in the Gulf countries and Southeast Asia. These seats will not be filled, if such foreign candidates are not available. (Except the courses run under the norms of AICTE/PCI). There will be separate Prospectus for Foreign Students.
5. Ten per cent seats over and above the existing sanctioned intake are meant for actual NRI candidates and their children or wards in all programs (**except the courses run under the norms of AICTE, NCTE & PCI**). The following documents will be required for admission against these seats:
  - i) Original Certificate/Mark Sheet of qualifying examination.
  - ii) Attested copies of Passport and Visa of the applicant/parent.
  - iii) Foreign Bank Account No. or NRI Account No. of the applicant/parent.
  - iv) Declaration regarding Non-Resident Indian status of the applicant/parent. (Appendix- N).

Once a candidate is admitted to a program as an NRI candidate, he/she will remain in this category for the full duration of the program. The University's decision regarding status of foreign/NRI candidate will be final.

6. Five additional seats over and above in M.Sc. Forensic Science, Department of Genetics have been reserved for Military Personnel / Police Personnel and Personnel from Health Department, Haryana.
7. Supernumerary seats as given below are reserved for Defence Personnel deputed by Director General Military Training, New Delhi. Meeting of all the Deans of Faculties is to be convened as per decision of the Admission Committee for supernumerary seats for the persons sponsored by Centre/State Govt.

9. One supernumerary seat for wards of M.D. University, Rohtak employees has been earmarked over and above the sanctioned seats for admission to various PG Courses (excluding M.Phil/Ph.D) being run in the University Teaching Departments and UILMS, Gurugram (except the courses run under the norms of BCI, NCTE, PCI & AICTE) from the session 2018-19.
10. One supernumerary seat for Centre and State Govt. nominated/sponsored personnel has been earmarked over and above the sanctioned seats for admission to various PG Courses (excluding M.Phil/Ph.D) being run in the University Teaching Departments and UILMS, Gurugram (except the courses run under the norms of BCI, NCTE, PCI & AICTE) from the session 2018-19.

Admission against the supernumerary seats given in point 1 to 10 shall be made on the basis of marks in the qualifying examination and candidates will not be required to appear in the entrance examination wherever prescribed. They are required to apply on separate

application form to the concerned Department/Institute by the date notified in the schedule of admissions alongwith all documents / testimonial. However, if any of the candidate wants to seek admission against General Category quota, he/she shall be required to appear in the Entrance Examination wherever prescribed after filling separate Application Form by due date. Eligibility conditions will be same as applicable to the General Category candidates.

Note :

- (i) **Duly filled application forms for admission against the supernumerary seats received after due date shall not be considered.**
- (ii) **Admission shall be made by the Admission Committee of the concerned Department as per given schedule.**

## **SECTION-II HOW TO APPLY FOR ADMISSION TO VARIOUS COURSES**

### **PART - A**

1. The candidates are advised to read the Prospectus carefully before filling the online Application Form.
2. The University has adopted online procedure for admission from the academic session 2013-14. The Prospectus can, however, be obtained from the Information & Sale Counter, M.D. University, Rohtak either in person or on payment of Rs. 150/- in cash for reference. OR can be free downloaded from the University Website [www.mdurohtak.ac.in](http://www.mdurohtak.ac.in). The Prospectus is also available on cash payment at the University Institute of Law and Management Studies, Sector 40, Gurugram.
3. The processing charges for submission of the application for admission will be charged as Rs. 600/- for general category candidates and Rs.150/- (for SC/BC candidates of Haryana only). The SC/ BC candidates belonging to the States other than Haryana will be treated as General Category candidates for all purposes.

A candidate can apply for admission to as many as courses he/she wants.

Separate application form for admission in each additional course shall be filled after paying Rs.50/- (Rs.15/- for SC/BC candidates of Haryana only) each.

Admission to various M.Tech Programs shall be made first on the basis of merit of valid GATE score. If seats remain vacant then admissions on the basis of merit of marks in the qualifying examinations shall be made.

A single application form is required for admission to different M.Tech Courses being run by the same Department of U.I.E.T. For example, for admission to M.Tech (Computer Science & Engineering) or M.Tech. (Software Engineering). Similarly, for admission to M.Tech. (Mechanical Engineering) or M.Tech. (Manufacturing & Automation Engineering). The choice of course can be exercised at the time of counseling.

4. Where entrance test is to be held, a candidate is required to pay entrance fee of Rs.200/- for traditional courses and Rs.300/- for professional courses for each test except for the courses where entrance test is common.
5. All the candidates will be required to deposit processing charges/entrance fee through Debit/Credit Card/e-challan of Axis Bank/Punjab National Bank.
6. All the candidates will be required to produce the proof of having passed the qualifying examination **atleast five days** before the display of merit list except for the courses where admissions are made purely on Entrance Test basis and GPAT basis (applicable only to

pharmacy program). In the latter cases, the candidates will produce all documents at the time of counseling.

7. The self-attested copies of certificates/testimonials of all the examinations passed by the candidate from 10th Standard onwards/other documents including certificates for claiming weightage, if any, and latest Character Certificate should be appended to the computer generated application form duly signed by the candidate be submitted to the concerned Department / Institute / Office before display of 1<sup>st</sup> Merit list.
8. Change in course or category, once opted for the purpose of admission, will not be allowed. The category and course opted in the Online Application for admission shall be the base for this purpose.
9. If the last date for receipt of applications falls on a holiday or that day is declared holiday by the University, the next working day will be considered as the last date for the purpose. However, the timings will remain unchanged.
10. The candidates claiming the benefit of reservation shall submit a certificate to this effect from the competent authority. Refer to Appendices C to L for instructions and formats of certificates.
11. The Application or any other document attached thereto once submitted shall not be returned.
