President's Message

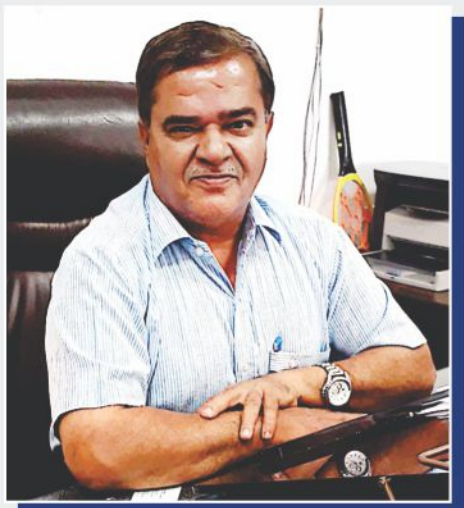

In the case of Inter college position/Inter-university participation and AIU position gradation/verification certificate issued by the Director, Sports of the University concerned can be considered. In the case of Inter College participation verification certificate issued by the Principal of the concerned college will be considered.

In the sports/games where no gradation certificate is being issued by the concerned state/U.T. in such cases the certificate must be verified by the concerned Director, Sports of the State/U.T. The certificate issued by the Federation alone will not be considered.

2. Married female selected candidates will have to submit a certificate from RMO/MO of the University Health Centre that she is not in family way, along with an undertaking that if during the course of study, it is found that she is in family way, her admission would be liable to be cancelled IPSO-FACTO and all dues paid by her shall be forfeited.

ii) Physical Efficiency Test:

All the eligible candidates will be required to qualify the physical efficiency test (PET). However, the criteria and the specifications of the individual events of the Canadian Test will be decided by the College Department of Physical Education.

General Rules

FEES RELATED RULES

1. Fee structure of the courses is as per the University norms.
2. All fee and other dues are payable strictly in advance and in full. No part payment will be accepted.
3. Students must deposit their dues to the college office on or before the due date.
4. Late fee fine of Rs. 10/- per day (excluding holiday) shall be charged.
5. The name of the defaulters will be struck off from the rolls, if the dues are not paid till the end of the month (unless permission is obtained from the Head of the Institution).
6. Re-admission may be allowed with consent of HOD on payment of Rs. 500/- along with arrears of the fee and fines, if any.
7. The securities are however, refundable in the month of March in the following year only if the student applies for refund within stipulated period till 31 March.
8. Fee concessions and stipends are granted to the deserving students subject to their good behaviour, satisfactory progress in studies and regularity in attendance. A concession in fee or a stipend may be withdrawn at any time at the discretion of the college authorities if it is found that the recipient has ceased to deserve it on account of some lapse on his/her part.

ABSENTEE FINE AND READMISSION CHARGES

CONTINUOUS ABSENCE

1. If a student fails to attend his/her class continuously for seven days from the date of commencement of the classes or from the date of admission, his/her admission shall be cancelled and seat given to the next in merit
2. If a student remains absent from his/her class for a continuous period of fourteen days or more in a month without valid reasons, medical or otherwise, his/her name will be struck off from the rolls and parents will be informed, irrespective of the fact that he/she has paid his/her dues.

LEAVE RULES

1. Students shall apply for leave when needed on the prescribed form obtainable from the college office.
2. Students must submit their application before availing leave and not after remaining absent from the college except on the basis of sickness in which case the application must be submitted on the day when the student attends the college after recovery.
3. Leave can be granted only by the Principal or by a teacher deputed for that purpose. Leave application by post shall not be accepted.
4. A Medical Certificate must accompany the application for sick leave. During House Examination application for sick leave must be certified by the college Doctor.

CHANGE OF SUBJECT OR FACULTY

Change of subject or faculty may be allowed by the college principal only if seats are available and as per the merit position. Fee for the change of subject/faculty will be Rs. 10/- for change of each subject and Rs. 50/- for change of faculty. No such change will be allowed after the last date fixed for the purpose by the University.

For change of subject / faculty the concerned student should submit an application form to Mr. Jashan Lal in the college office. The list of those students who are allowed to change the subject /faculty will be displayed on the notice board. **The change of subject/faculty without the permission of the Principal will not be entertained.**

WITHDRAWAL OF SECURITIES

Securities shall be refunded only to those students who submit security form to the fee clerk from 1st March to 31st March after the end of academic session in which he/she leaves the college. The securities not withdrawn till 31st March will lapse. Securities shall not be adjusted in respect of admission to the next class. To receive refund of security, a student will have to be present at the college in person. Securities will not be payable through authority letter or by remittance.

EXAM RELATED RULES

Every candidate shall be examined by the University according to the scheme of examination and syllabus. Final year students who fail in an examination, take the examination as an ex-student as per the existing syllabus. Students in I and II year who get compartment in a subject will appear with regular students in the relevant semester, even or odd.

UNIVERSITY AND HOUSE EXAMINATION

- 1) Students using unfair means in the class test shall be severely punished and all the concessions in fees etc. granted to such students shall be withdrawn. In serious cases the punishment may amount to heavy fine/expulsion from the college.

Admission Norms and Guidelines

ADMISSION NORMS

1. **Prospectus is not a legal document. It is only for general information and guidance.**
2. Admission to all the classes is purely on the basis of merit.
3. All admissions will be according to the minority educational institutions rules.
4. The Principal reserves the right to refuse/cancel any admission without assigning any reason in the interest of the institution.
5. The legal disputes relating to admission will be subject to Jagadhri Court.
6. The college authorities have the right to discontinue any class, course or subject.
7. Subject combinations offered by the college are restricted for the convenience of time table.
8. Students who indulge in **undesirable activities/gross misconduct** during the previous session, will not be given admission in the current session.
9. The college strictly forbids any kind of ragging in or out of the campus.
10. The students are required to furnish complete and correct information in the admission form. The admission may be cancelled at any time due to wrong information supplied at the time of admission.

Norms for Students from other Universities/Boards :

- a) Students from other University/Board seeking admission to this college will be admitted only on production of original certificates of all the examinations passed at the time of admission prior to the class which they intend to join. They should submit original **Inter-University migration certificate** and the **detailed marks certificate**.
- b) Their admission will be purely provisional subject to the confirmation of their eligibility by Kurukshetra University.

Norms for Students from Non-Hindi speaking areas and Kashmiri Migrants:

General Guidelines for all Students seeking admission in 1st year of UG/PG/Diploma Classes :
