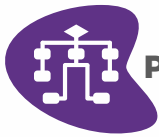

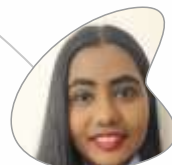

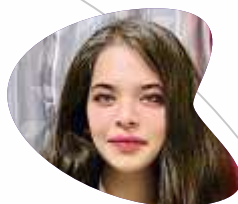

Eligibility, Selection Criteria



Eligibility:

Maharashtra State (MS) Candidate

1. Candidate should be an Indian National.
2. 50% in 10+2 / 12th / HSC Examination with English subject (OR)
3. 50% in Three Years Diploma Recognized by Government Competent Authority (OR Passed its equivalent examination with 50% Marks in aggregate (45% in case of candidates of backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging to Maharashtra State only)

Other Than Maharashtra (OMS) Candidate

1. Candidate should be an Indian National.
2. 50% in 10+2 / 12th / HSC Examination with English subject (OR)
3. 50% in Three Years Engineering Diploma Recognized by Government Competent Authority (OR) Passed its equivalent examination with 50% Marks in aggregate.

Foreign Nation / NRI / OCI / PIO, Children of Indian workers in the Gulf countries

1. 50% in 10+2 / 12th / HSC Examination with English subject with 50% marks in aggregate (OR) its equivalent examination in any stream with 50% marks in aggregate.

Selection Process:

The final selection of a candidate will be based on the performance as per the Assessment Stages mentioned below:

Personal Interview (100 marks) TOTAL (100 marks)

Personal Interview will explore the critical thinking, analytical skills and knowledge of the students expressed through verbal and non-verbal communication.

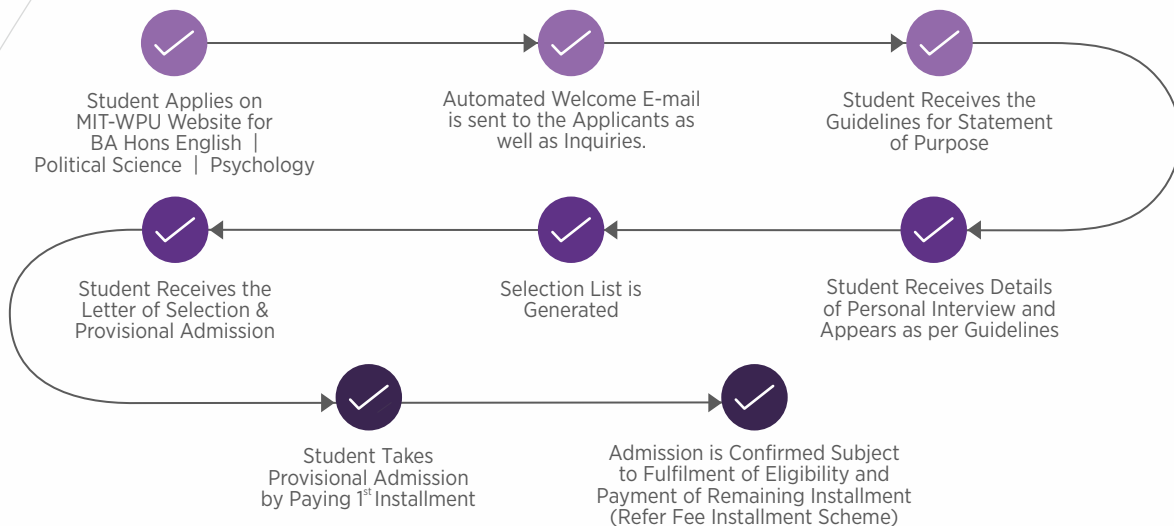
