
SET Syllabus (Latest)

Important Topics of SET Syllabus

Section 1: General English

The General English section of the SET exam tests the candidate's hold over the English language and proficiency. To ace this section, students should focus on improving their vocabulary and grammar use. Check below the important topics of General English in the SET exam.
