**NOTICE FOR AADHAAR AUTHENTICATION, APAAR ID
GENERATION AND UDID (FOR PwD CANDIDATES)**

Instructions for CET 2026 Registration

The State Common Entrance Test Cell, Maharashtra conducts various CET examinations every year for admissions to professional courses in the State. The online application forms for the CETs for the Academic Year 2026 will be made available on the official website of the State CET Cell. **The CET Cell intends to make Aadhaar and APAAR mandatory for all candidates registering for the CET 2026.**

All prospective candidates intending to apply for any CET are informed that the following documents are required for the registration process.

1. Aadhaar (UIDAI) Card

Candidates must verify and update the following details in their Aadhaar, wherever required:

- Name
- Date of Birth (as per Class 10 certificate)
- Latest Photograph
- Address
- Father's Name
- Mobile Number linked to Aadhaar (must be updated and active)

2. Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry (APAAR)

All prospective candidates applying for CETs are advised to generate their APAAR ID as it will be required for the registration purpose.

3. Disability Certificate and/or Unique Disability ID (UDID Card) (for PwD Candidates)

It is mandatory for PwD candidates to upload a Disability Certificate issued by the Competent Authority or a UDID Card, if available. PwD candidates are further advised to obtain UDID, as it may be required during the Common Admission Process (CAP).

3.1 Scribe Details (for PwD Candidates in case of Eligible Disabilities)

PwD candidates who are eligible to opt for scribes must submit details of two scribes at the time of online application. The following details are to be provided for each scribe:

- Name
- Aadhaar
- Recent Photograph
- Bonafide Certificate issued by the Institution
- Highest Qualification Certificate

All candidates are advised to regularly visit the official website of the State CET Cell for detailed notifications, examination schedules, and further instructions.
