Quantitative Ability Syllabus

The QA section is divided into two parts- Short Answers and Multiple-Choice questions. The QA section tests the candidate's mathematical and analytical ability. The key topics of the QA section include:

Algebra	Simple and Quadratic Equations, Logarithms, Functions and Graphs, Algebraic Formulas, Linear Equations, Inequalities
Arithmetic	Time, Work and Distance, Speed and Distance, Averages, Partnerships, Profit, loss and Discount, Boats and Streams, Simple and Compound Interest, Ratio and Proportion, Age, Mixtures and Allegation
Geometry	Basics of Geometry, Mensuration, Angles, Lines, Graphs, Circles, Polygons, Coordinate Geometry, Triangles, Heights
Modern Maths	Probability, Vectors, Data Interpretation, Series, Arrangements, Sequences, Determinants, Permutation and Combination, Set Theory, Integration and Differentiation
