



# UG CET - 2026



## Dear students and parents

For admission to professional courses such as Engineering, Agriculture, Veterinary, Pharmacy, B.Sc. (Nursing), etc., candidates must submit an online application for CET-2026, which is conducted by KEA.

The CET-2026 application works as an **“Application-cum-Verification” Module**. Details related to a candidate's academic study and caste reservation will be automatically fetched through web services using the SATS and RD numbers.

Therefore, a “CET Diksuchi” information booklet, containing brief details about the application process, eligibility criteria, sample certificates, and other relevant information, will be provided to candidates in their respective colleges.

Hon'ble Higher Education Minister and Chairman, KEA Dr. M.C. Sudhakar and Hon'ble Medical Education, Skill Development Minister and KEA Co-Chairman Dr. Sharang Prakash Patil released the CET Diksuchi 2026.

- AADHAR CARD
- STUDENT'S PHOTOGRAPH (IN JPG FORMAT. < 50KB)
- STUDENT'S SIGNATURE (IN JPG FORMAT. < 50KB)
- STUDENT'S MOBILE NUMBER (WITH WHATSAPP) & EMAIL REGISTRATION

**Special Note:** The name in the SSLC mark card, Aadhar card and RD certificate should be the same. If there is any discrepancy, immediately correct the Aadhar card and RD certificate as per the SSLC mark card.

### The following documents required, if applicable

(Certificates should be in the name of the candidate only)

Scheduled Caste candidates: Caste Certificate containing internal reservation details (Category-A / Category-B / Category-C) with RD number.	Kannada Medium study certificate from 1st to 10th standard
Caste certificate: For ST and Category-1 students with RD number.	Certificate for studying in rural areas of Karnataka from 1st to 10th standard
SC, ST, Category-1 candidates will have to obtain income certificate with RD number separately .  1.SC / ST candidates - Fee exemption if annual income upto Rs.10.00 Lakhs. 2.Category-1 candidates – Partial Fee exemption if annual income upto 2.5 Lakhs.	NCLC certificate with RD number (for General Category candidates seeking reservation for studies in rural areas)  <b>For Medical and Dental courses</b> Linguistic Minority certificate: Studied in Karnataka for a period of Ten Years from 1st Standard to 2nd PUC/12th and passed SSLC/10th or 2nd PUC/12th from Karnataka state.( Tamil, Telugu, Kodava & Tulu mother tongue)
Caste / Caste Income Certificate (Income and Caste Certificate)- with RD Number (for 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B students)	Religious Minority Certificate (for Muslim, Christian Religious Minority Candidates)
