Section-wise Syllabus Breakdown

Quantitative Aptitude

This section assesses your mathematical skills and problem-solving abilities. Key topics include:

- **Arithmetic:** Percentages, Ratio and Proportion, Profit and Loss, Simple and Compound Interest, Time and Work, Time and Distance.
- **Algebra:** Linear Equations, Quadratic Equations, Inequalities, Functions, Logarithms.
- **Geometry:** Lines, Angles, Triangles, Circles, Mensuration.
- **Modern Math:** Permutations and Combinations, Probability.
- **Number System:** Divisibility Rules, HCF and LCM, Remainders.

Data Interpretation and Logical Reasoning

This section tests your ability to interpret data and apply logical reasoning. Focus areas include:

- **Data Interpretation:** Tables, Bar Graphs, Pie Charts, Line Graphs.
- **Logical Reasoning:** Seating Arrangements, Blood Relations, Syllogisms, Coding-Decoding, Puzzles, Statement and Conclusions.

Verbal Ability and Reading Comprehension

This section evaluates your English language proficiency and comprehension skills. Key components include:

- **Reading Comprehension:** Passages with questions testing understanding, inference, and vocabulary.
- **Verbal Ability:** Grammar, Vocabulary, Sentence Correction, Fill in the Blanks, Para Jumbles, Analogies.
