Education Consultant Note: The MAH B.Ed CET 2026 official cutoff will be released by State CET Cell Maharashtra (cetcell.mahacet.org) during the CAP counselling rounds (expected April–May 2026). The expected cutoffs below are projected based on 2021–2024 trends, number of applicants (86,000+ in 2024), seat availability, and category-wise patterns. Candidates should treat these as planning benchmarks.

1. MAH B.Ed CET — Category-wise Qualifying Cutoff Marks

Candidates must score at or above the prescribed minimum qualifying marks to be eligible for CAP counselling.

5. Key Factors Affecting MAH B.Ed CET 2026 Cutoff

Rising Applicant Pool:	Over 86,000 candidates appeared in 2024. With a projected 3–5% increase in 2026, expect cutoffs to rise by 2–4 marks at top colleges.
Seat Availability:	Total B.Ed seats across Maharashtra remain around 1.5 lakh. Seat redistribution between government and aided colleges affects cut-offs for specific institutes.
Exam Difficulty:	The MAH B.Ed CET is 100 marks; no negative marking. A 1–2 mark change in average difficulty shifts cut-offs proportionally.
Category Reservations:	SC/ST/NT/SBC/OBC reservations ensure that reserved category cut-offs are typically 10–20 marks lower than General category.
ELCT (English-medium):	Colleges with English Language Comprehension Test (ELCT) seats have separate cut-offs; expected range 75–85 for General category.
Location Preference:	Mumbai and Pune institutes consistently have the highest demand; Nashik, Kolhapur, and Latur region colleges have more moderate cut-offs.

6. How to Check Official Cutoff / Allotment List

Step 1	Visit cetcell.mahacet.org (State CET Cell Maharashtra official portal).
Step 2	Click on 'MAH B.Ed CET 2026' under the Teaching & Education section.
Step 3	Navigate to 'CAP Round — Institute-wise Allotment'.
Step 4	Select the round (Round 1 / Round 2 / Round 3), university, and college.

Step 5	Click 'Show Allotment List' to view the opening and closing cutoff ranks/marks.
Tip	The closing score of the last admitted candidate in each category is the effective cutoff.
