How to Apply for CBSE 12th Revaluation 2026

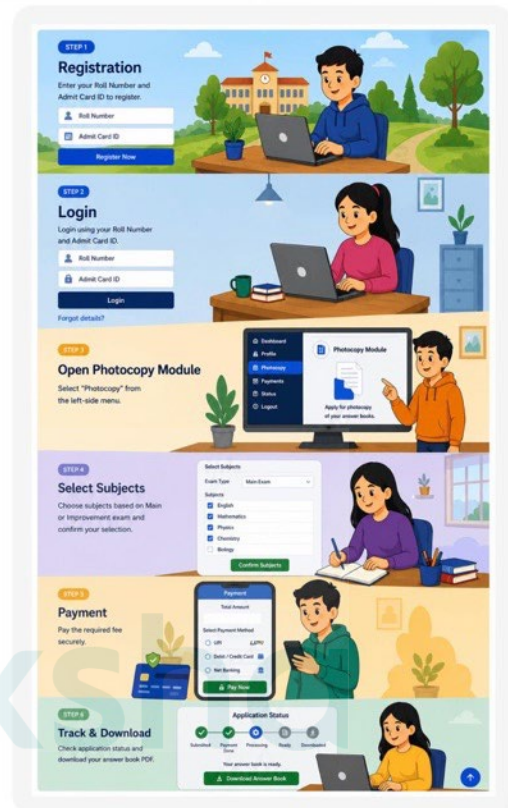
The steps to apply for CBSE photocopy of answer sheet is given below.

- Visit the CBSE website
- You'll find an option to request a photocopy of your answer sheet or revaluation
- Click the required link to begin filling the application form
- Fill in your details
- Pay the fees online
- Once CBSE processes your request, a scanned copy of your answer sheet will be uploaded
- Download it and review it carefully before filling the form for revaluation
- The request for revaluation can be raised similarly
- The result for revaluation is declared later

Step by step Process for CBSE Class 12 Revaluation 2026?

The process to apply for CBSE 12th revaluation is given below.

Step 1: Apply for scanned answer sheet

Students must first request a scanned copy of the evaluated answer sheet for the concerned subject.

Step 2: Check Marks

After receiving the scanned copy, students should compare the evaluation with the CBSE marking scheme.

Step 3: Report discrepancies

Students can submit their observations to the board regarding mismatch of marks

Step 4: Expert review

A subject expert committee will examine the request before issuing the final decision.

What to check in CBSE 12 th Revaluation?

- Take the printout of the marking scheme of the set of question paper supplied to you in the examination. Keep the question paper and marking scheme with you.
- Please evaluate your answer book based on the marking scheme. If you observe a mistake, please clearly mention that in particular, question marks have not been awarded despite the answer matching the marking scheme, or no marks are awarded even if the answer is similar to the marking scheme.
- In case you wish to say more, please mention it clearly.
- Students need to submit information in such a manner that it can be easily understood and identified so that your request can be addressed appropriately.

Important Points Related to CBSE Revaluation 2026

- Only those candidates who have applied for the photocopy of answer books shall be
- Eligible to apply for verification of issues observed and/or re-evaluation or challenge the marks awarded to any question(s).
- The applicant will have to refer to the marking scheme in the subject concerned, which will be available on the website along with the question paper. Thereafter, candidates can submit an application for re-evaluation in the required question(s) with reasoning. The Status of the requests made shall be uploaded and available on the login details of

- A decrease of even by one mark shall be affected.
- The result of the re-evaluation will be final, and no appeal or review against the revaluation will be entertained.

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
