Scoring **60–70 percentile in MAH CET 2026** is considered a moderate score that can secure admission in several reputed private and government-aided MBA colleges across Pune, Mumbai, Nagpur, Nashik, Aurangabad, and other cities of Maharashtra. MAH CET 2026 CAP Counselling Tips — Don't Miss These

Tip	What to Do	Why It Matters
Fill Maximum Preferences	Add 15–20 college preferences in CAP form — all 3 rounds	More preferences = better allotment chances; less competition in later rounds
Check Domicile Status	Maharashtra domicile (85% Home State seats) vs. non-domicile (15% seats)	Non-domicile students get fewer options at 60–70 %ile — plan accordingly
Verify AICTE / DTE Approval	Check if college is DTE-approved and AICTE-accredited before applying	Non-approved colleges can result in a degree not recognized for jobs
Compare Fees & ROI	Govt. aided colleges (GS College Rs.1L/yr) vs private (Rs.3–4L/yr) — huge gap	At 60–70 %ile, choosing a government-aided college gives best ROI
Attend All 3 CAP Rounds	Participate in CAP Round 1, 2, and 3 — better seats available in later rounds	Many students get better options in Round 2/3 due to Round 1 cancellations
Check Placement Track Record	Ask for last 3-year placement brochures before confirming seat	60–70 %ile colleges vary widely in placement quality — research before deciding
