The IBSAT (ICFAI Business School Aptitude Test) syllabus covers four core sections: Verbal Ability, Reading Comprehension, Quantitative Aptitude, and Data Adequacy & Data Interpretation. The exam is designed to test test taker's management, analytical, and language skills without a General Awareness component.

IBSAT Quantitative Aptitude Syllabus

The IBSAT Quantitative Aptitude (QA) section tests basic high school mathematics and consists of 30 multiple-choice questions. Check the table below to know important topics for IBSAT QA section:
