TSEdCET Admission Process – Step by Step

Admission to B.Ed. colleges in Telangana through TSEdCET follows a structured counselling process managed by Kakatiya University:

Step 1	Register & Appear for TSEdCET Apply at tgedcet.tsche.ac.in , pay exam fee (Rs. 500 Gen / Rs. 250 SC/ST), and appear for the online Computer Based Test. 2026 exam: May 12, 2026.
Step 2	Download Scorecard After results are declared, download your TSEdCET rank card from the official portal. Your rank determines counselling preference.
Step 3	Online Counselling Registration Register for counselling at tgedcet.tsche.ac.in . Pay the counselling registration fee and upload scanned documents.
Step 4	Certificate Verification Visit the designated Help Centre allotted to you for physical verification of original documents: Graduation Certificate, Marks Memos, Caste Certificate, Aadhaar Card, etc.
Step 5	Web Option Entry Enter your college and course preferences online in order of preference. You can enter as many options as you wish. Rank + category + preferences determine allotment.
Step 6	Seat Allotment TSEdCET seat allotment is released online. Check your allotment using your hall ticket number / registration ID on the official portal.
Step 7	Report to Allotted College Report to the allotted college within the specified dates, pay the college fee, and confirm your admission to secure your seat.

Eligibility Criteria for B.Ed Admission via TSEdCET

The following eligibility criteria apply for admission to B.Ed. colleges in Telangana through the TSEdCET / TGEEdCET score:

01 Educational Qualification

Must have passed a Bachelor's Degree (B.A./B.Sc./B.Com./B.E./B.Tech. or equivalent) OR a Master's Degree in any subject from a recognised university.

02 Minimum Marks

General Category: minimum **50% marks** in the qualifying degree. Reserved Category (SC/ST/BC/PwD): **45% marks** relaxation applicable.

03 Medium of Instruction

Should have studied the subject intended to teach as one of the main/optional subjects during graduation (e.g., to teach Maths, must have studied Maths in graduation).

04 Residency / Domicile

Candidate must be a resident of Telangana OR have studied SSC/10th or Intermediate/12th from a school/college in Telangana (as per TSCHE norms).

05 Age Limit

There is **no minimum or maximum age limit** for TSEdCET. Candidates of all ages can apply and appear for the exam.

06 Attempts

No restriction on the number of attempts. Candidates may re-appear for TSEdCET in subsequent years if they wish to improve their rank.

07 NCTE Approval

The B.Ed. college/course must be **NCTE-recognised**. Admission through TSEdCET is only valid for NCTE-approved institutions in Telangana.

Note: Candidates with an Engineering degree (B.E./B.Tech.) are eligible for B.Ed. in Mathematics or Science/Technology subjects. Candidates with B.A. in Regional Languages are eligible to teach the respective language. Always verify specific subject eligibility with the concerned university.

Top Tips for TSEdCET Counselling

01 Enter Maximum Web Options

Enter as many colleges as possible during web option entry — at least 20–30 options ordered by your preference. More options = better chance of getting a seat.

02 Prioritise Government Colleges

List all government/aided colleges first if cost is a priority. Government B.Ed. seats are highly sought after and fill very quickly.

03 Check NCTE Recognition

Before finalising a private college, verify its NCTE recognition status at ncte.gov.in. Admission through an unrecognised institution has no value for teaching jobs.

04 Know Your Subject Eligibility

Ensure the subject you wish to teach is eligible based on your graduation subjects. E.g., B.Sc. Physics → can teach Physical Science; B.A. History → can teach Social Studies.

05 Keep Documents Ready

Prepare self-attested copies of all documents before counselling begins. Missing documents = forfeiture of seat.

06 Monitor Shiksha.com for Updates

Track real-time TSEdCET counselling schedule, seat matrix, and cut-off updates on shiksha.com/teaching-education/tsedcet-exam.
