

SRMJEEE Cutoff 2025

Campus-wise & Course-wise Closing Ranks

This document presents the expected and previous-year SRMJEEE closing ranks for all major SRM campuses. Ranks are based on data compiled from Shiksha.com and other educational portals. **Lower rank = higher score.** Cutoffs vary by round, category, and year.

Tip: SRM Ramapuram cutoffs are typically 5–10% lower than Kattankulathur. CSE and ECE remain the most competitive branches. Candidates with ranks around 8,000 can secure CSE here even if not qualifying for the main campus.

Campus 3: SRM Vadapalani — Chennai, Tamil Nadu
