Complete Guide: Colleges, Seat Intake & Counselling Process

The **Telangana State Law Common Entrance Test (TS LAW CET 2026)** was conducted on **May 18, 2026** by Osmania University on behalf of the Telangana State Council of Higher Education (TG CHE). Admission to **5-year LLB** and **3-year LLB** courses, as well as **LLM** (via TS PGLCET), is offered through centralized counselling at lawcetadm.tgche.ac.in. This document lists all participating colleges with seat intake and tuition details, followed by the complete counselling process as published on **Shiksha.com**.

TS LAW CET / PGLCET 2026 Counselling Process

The Telangana State Council of Higher Education (TGCHE) conducts the TS LAW CET counselling at lawcetadm.tgche.ac.in. The process is divided into **Phase 1** and **Phase 2**. If seats remain vacant after Phase 2, additional rounds (Spot Allotment) may be conducted. Below are the step-by-step stages of the counselling.

Step 1: Online Registration & Fee Payment

Candidates who qualify TS LAW CET / PGLCET 2026 must first register online on the official counselling portal lawcetadm.tgche.ac.in. During registration, candidates are required to pay the counselling fee (Processing Fee). Confirm the fee amount from the official portal at the time of registration. Candidates must keep a scanned copy of all required documents ready before starting registration.

Step 2: Document Verification (Certificate Verification)

After registration, candidates must appear in person at the designated helpline centres (counselling centres) for certificate verification as per the schedule announced based on rank. **Documents to carry (originals + self-attested photocopies):**

- TS LAW CET / PGLCET 2026 Hall Ticket & Rank Card
- 10th Class / SSC Certificate (date of birth proof)
- 12th / Intermediate Marks Memo (for 5-Year LLB)
- Graduation Degree Certificate / Provisional (for 3-Year LLB and LLM)
- Caste / Community Certificate (if applicable – SC/ST/BC/EWS)
- Income Certificate (if applicable)
- Residence / Domicile Certificate (for local area / Telangana State)
- Transfer Certificate (TC) from last institution
- Aadhaar Card / Passport / Voter ID (any valid photo ID)
- Recent passport-sized photographs (minimum 4)

Step 3: Web Options (College Preference Entry)

Candidates whose certificates are verified can exercise Web Options online. During the web-option exercise, candidates select and rank their preferred colleges and courses in order of priority. Candidates may select as many college–course combinations as they wish. The option to edit / modify web options is available until the deadline. Even if a college shows zero vacancies, candidates are advised to include it, as seats can open due to withdrawals by other allotted candidates.

Step 4: Seat Allotment

Based on the candidate's rank in TS LAW CET / PGLCET 2026, category, and the college preferences submitted, the TGCHE releases the **Seat Allotment List** on the official portal. The allotment is purely merit-cum-choice based. Candidates can check their allotment by logging into the portal with their application number and date of birth.

Step 5: Reporting at the Allotted College (Self-Reporting)

Candidates who are satisfied with their allotment must report to the allotted college within the stipulated date to confirm their admission by paying the **tuition fee** and submitting original documents. Failure to report within the deadline will lead to cancellation of the allotment. Candidates who wish to participate in Phase 2 counselling for a better option may choose to retain their current allotment and still participate in the next phase.

Step 6: Phase 2 Counselling

Phase 2 counselling is conducted for seats that remain vacant after Phase 1 allotment and for candidates who could not participate in Phase 1 or wish to upgrade their allotment. The same process (registration → document verification → web options → allotment → reporting) is repeated for Phase 2.

Step 7: Seat Cancellation

Candidates who wish to cancel their allotted seat in Phase 2 must contact the **Principal of the allotted college** directly. Fee refund (if applicable) will be as per TGCHE norms.

Step 8: Spot Allotment / Mop-Up Round (if applicable)

If seats remain vacant even after Phase 2, TGCHE may conduct a Spot Allotment / Mop-Up round at designated centres. Eligible candidates must attend in person with all original documents and fee.
