Practice Data Interpretation

Solve tables, bar graphs, pie charts and mixed DI sets under timed conditions.

Take Mock Tests

Attempt full-length mocks weekly and analyze mistakes to identify weak areas.

Improve Speed and Accuracy

Since 140 questions must be attempted in 120 minutes, focus on quick calculations and smart question selection.

Use No Negative Marking Wisely

Attempt all questions because there is no penalty for incorrect answers.
