About ULSAT Counselling Process

ULSAT counselling begins after the exam results are declared. The School of Legal Studies, UPES Dehradun grants admission on the basis of **ULSAT scores**, **CLAT scores**, or **Class 12th merit**. Candidates are invited to participate in the counselling process through an official call letter sent via SMS and email.

The counselling process is largely conducted **online** through the UPES admission portal. Candidates must follow all steps carefully and in the correct sequence to secure their seat in UPES law programmes.

ULSAT Counselling Process — Step by Step

1

Receive Counselling Call

UPES sends an official call letter via email or SMS with the date, time, venue, or online link. Continuously monitor the UPES official website for updates.

2

Register on the Admission Portal

Visit the UPES admission portal and complete your registration. Enter your name, roll number, and exam marks accurately, then upload all required documents.

3

Fill Course Choices

Select your preferred law courses and campus options based on your interest and rank. Choose carefully — choices cannot be modified once locked.

4

Seat Allotment

Seats are allotted based on ULSAT rank, merit, seat availability, and your course choices. Students with higher ranks receive first preference.

5**Group Discussion (GD)**

Selected candidates attend a Group Discussion. A topic is assigned to a group of 6–8 candidates who must speak for or against it. The jury awards marks individually.

6**Personal Interview & Document Verification**

Candidates appear for a Personal Interview assessing knowledge of the law course. Document verification is conducted simultaneously by the examination authority.

7**Confirm Seat & Pay Admission Fee**

After seat allotment, pay the counselling or admission fee before the deadline to confirm your seat. Once paid, UPES issues your official admission letter.

■ **Additional Rounds:** If seats remain vacant after the first round, UPES conducts further counselling rounds. Candidates who did not receive a seat in the first round may participate in subsequent rounds. Keep all documents ready and monitor official announcements closely.

Documents Required for ULSAT Counselling 2026

Candidates must carry original documents along with self-attested photocopies at the time of counselling. Missing or unclear documents may delay or disqualify the admission process.

■■■ **Important:** Carry originals AND self-attested photocopies of all documents. Documents must be legible and complete. The university may reject incomplete submissions.

10 Important Points to Remember for ULSAT Counselling 2026

Follow these critical points to ensure a smooth and successful counselling experience:

■ Check Eligibility First Only ULSAT-qualified students can participate. Verify all eligibility norms before the process begins.	■ Keep All Documents Ready Marksheets, ID proof, photos, and certificates must be ready in advance. Missing documents cause delays.
■ Visit Official Website Regularly Check upes.ac.in frequently. Counselling dates and schedules can change without prior notice.	■ Register Before the Last Date Complete portal registration early. Late submissions are typically not accepted.

■ Fill Choices Wisely Select law courses and campus options carefully — choices cannot be changed once locked.	■ Seat Allotment is Merit-Based Seats are allotted based on ULSAT rank, merit, and availability. Higher ranks get priority.
■ Pay Fee on Time Pay counselling/admission fee immediately after seat allotment. Delayed payment forfeits the seat.	■ Multiple Rounds May Happen If seats remain vacant, further rounds are conducted. Stay prepared if you miss the first round.
■ Monitor Messages & Emails UPES sends schedule, verification, and allotment details via SMS and email. Keep both active.	■ Follow Every Step Properly Read all instructions carefully and follow them in order. Small errors can cause major disruptions.

How to Get a Seat in UPES Law College?

Follow this structured roadmap to successfully secure admission at the School of Legal Studies, UPES Dehradun:

01	Choose Your Course	Decide the law programme that suits your goals — BA LLB, BBA LLB, or B.Tech LLB. Each programme has specific eligibility norms.
02	Check Eligibility	Ensure you meet the minimum Class 12th marks requirement for your chosen programme before applying.
03	Apply Online	Visit upes.ac.in , complete the online form, upload documents correctly, and pay the application fee.
04	Appear for Entrance Exam	Attempt ULSAT or submit CLAT scores. Some seats may also be filled through Class 12th merit.
05	Attend GD & Interview Round	Clear the Group Discussion and Personal Interview to demonstrate your aptitude for law studies.
06	Merit List & Counselling	Check the UPES merit list. If selected, participate in the counselling and seat allotment process.
07	Confirm Admission	Pay the admission fee and submit all original documents to officially confirm your seat at UPES.
