

# AIL LET 2026 Counselling Guide

Complete Process, Documents Required, Seats & Reservation, and Fee Structure

It is important to understand the complete AIL LET Counselling Process to avoid any mistakes later. This guide walks you through every stage — from document submission to final fee payment — along with the documents required, category-wise seat matrix, and course fee structure for BA LLB and B.Com LLB.

## 1. AIL LET 2026 Counselling Process

### Step 1 – Document Submission

Candidates are required to send their academic and category documents (scanned copies of original documents) to the email address shared by AIL, or carry them to the institute on the counselling day. The counselling mode will be communicated to candidates in advance via email, along with the list of required documents.

### Step 2 – Publishing of Merit/Rank List & Counselling Schedule

AIL will publish a merit list along with the declaration of results, mentioning the names, ranks, and category of candidates who have qualified AIL LET 2026. A counselling schedule with detailed instructions will also be published on the official website.

### Step 3 – Online Counselling

Candidates are required to participate in AIL LET 2026 counselling in online mode. The exam authority will share a Google Meet link with qualified candidates via email. Candidates must join as per the category and schedule assigned to them.

### Step 4 – Admission Fee Payment & Seat Confirmation

Candidates must pay the admission fee for their allotted course as per the counselling guidelines to confirm their seat. Failure to pay the fee within the stipulated time will result in cancellation of the admission offer.

*As per the exam authority: "The counselling will be conducted on the Google Meet platform, wherein it will be mandatory for the candidate to appear along with one parent as per the date and time assigned in the schedule of online counselling. The necessary link required to log in to the meeting will be shared with the candidates before the counselling."*

## 2. AIL LET 2026 Counselling: Documents Required

The following documents must be submitted during AIL LET 2026 counselling, in the categories described below.

**(a) Self-Attested Copies to be Uploaded with the Online Application Form**

- Matric Certificate showing Date of Birth
- 10+2 Certificate with Detailed Marks Sheet
- Indian Army / Indian Navy / Indian Air Force Category Certificate, as applicable
- Gallantry Award Certificate No. IV (applicable to wards of Army personnel)
- Gap Year Affidavit (download from Prospectus and Appendix, page viii)

**(b) Original Certificates — Scanned Copies (emailed) and Physical Copies (at reporting)**

Scanned copies of original certificates must be forwarded to the institute by email. Physical (original) copies of the following documents must be deposited with the institute at the time of reporting:

- Matric Certificate giving details of Date of Birth
- 10+2 pass Certificate with detailed marks
- Character Certificate
- Migration Certificate
- Category Certificate applicable to Army Category
- Gallantry Award Certificate, applicable to wards of Army personnel
- Medical Fitness Certificate (download from Prospectus)
- Willingness Certificate (download from Prospectus)
- Affidavit by Father/Mother/Guardian stating whether the ward studied Punjabi at the Matriculation level (if the ward is above 18 years, the affidavit must be self-signed)
- Eligibility Certificate from Punjabi University, Patiala — mandatory for candidates who cleared 10+2 from boards other than Punjab, Haryana, Himachal & CBSE/ICSE
- Digital photograph with a light blue/white background; 5 physical photographs to be sent by post
- One photograph of parents, family members & local guardians
- Domicile Certificate for Punjab Resident Civil Category
- Anti-Ragging Undertaking, to be submitted by all admitted students
- Copy of Dependent Card, Part II Order of Birth / Discharge Book, as applicable

**Category-wise Document Requirement Matrix**

Category	Documents Required
Army Category (Serving Personnel)	Dependent Card of the candidate; both sides of the candidate's Aadhaar Card; 12th Class Certificate
Army Retd. / Ex-Personnel	Relevant extracts of Service Book / Discharge Book showing details of candidate and parent; both sides of the candidate's Aadhaar Card; 12th Class Certificate
All India Category	Both sides of the candidate's Aadhaar Card; 12th Class Certificate

### 3. AIL LET 2026 Seats and Reservation

### 4. AIL LET 2026 Course Admission Fees

Candidates must note that their admission will not be confirmed until the fees are paid. The admission-cum-tuition fee for the BA LLB course offered at AIL is as follows:

Note: The fees mentioned above are subject to change.

### 5. Important Instructions for Candidates

- It is mandatory for candidates to submit an ink-signed copy of the Category Certificate for Army/Indian Navy/Indian Air Force, along with documents for weightage (if claimed), at the time of physical reporting to the Institute.
- Candidates shortlisted as per the LET merit list for counselling must deposit INR 15,000 as Registration Fee along with the Willingness Certificate prior to the counselling date. Failing to do so will result in removal of the candidate's name from the counselling list and schedule — once removed, the name will not be reconsidered for admission at a later date.
- Admitted students must submit original documents to the Institute on the day of reporting (date to be intimated post-counselling). These documents will be retained by the Institute for registration and verification by Punjabi University, Patiala.
- Candidates offered admission must deposit the full fee within 48 hours. No delayed or part payment will be accepted.
