Understanding Marks vs Rank

Karnataka PG CET is conducted for 100 marks. Admissions are based on rank. Marks indicate your score while rank indicates your position among all candidates.

75-100	1-10
70-75	10-100
65-70	100-200
60-65	200-500
55-60	500-1000
49-55	1000-3000
45-49	3000-7500
40-45	7500-14000
30-40	13000-20000
Below 30	20000+
Below 20	30000+

Marks vs Rank

Marks are fixed scores. Rank depends on relative performance.

Score Calculation

Each correct answer = +1 mark. No negative marking. Score = Correct Answers × 1.

Rank Allotment

Ranks are assigned in descending order of marks.

Factors Affecting Rank

Number of candidates, exam difficulty, score distribution, available seats and previous trends.

Tie Breaking

Higher qualifying exam aggregate gets preference, followed by older age.

Quick Reference

75+: Top 10; 65–74: Top 200; 55–64: Top 1000; 45–54: 1000–7500; Below 45: 7500+.
