Category Verification Notes:

- OBC/EWS certificates must be issued on or after **01.04.2026** to be valid during document verification.
- As per current University of Delhi rules, there is no separate provision for a Single Girl Child reservation in this program.

2. AFTER-EXAM PROCESS & SELECTION CRITERIA

Following the successful completion of the online competitive entrance exam, candidates undergo a rigorous multi-stage selection process to determine final admissions.

Stage 1: Shortlisting based on Online Entrance Exam

A limited number of candidates will be shortlisted based on their performance and merit in the objective-type online entrance test within each specific category. There is no sectional cutoff across the four test domains (English, Quantitative Ability, Logical Reasoning, and Data Interpretation).

Stage 2: Group Discussion & Personal Interview (GDPI)

Shortlisted candidates are required to attend the mandatory GDPI rounds held physically at the **Shri Ram College of Commerce, Delhi** campus.

- **Group Discussion:** Candidates discuss a assigned current topic evaluating team communication, perspective layout, and analytical skills.
- **Personal Interview:** Assessment focuses on overall personality, communication clarity, general knowledge, and specific familiarity with management and international business environments.

Stage 3: Preparation of Final Merit List

The final selected list of candidates is calculated using an aggregate percentile methodology applying the following strict weightages:

Stage 4: Document Verification & Final Admission Offer

Provisional offers are converted into final admissions subject to detailed document verification. Shortlisted candidates appearing in their final university semester must submit conclusive proof of their graduation results achieving a minimum of **50% marks** (with a 5% relaxation available to SC, ST, OBC, CW, and PwBD categories) during registration timelines.
