Your branch matters a lot when it comes to salaries and options. Computer Science and IT branches get the highest salaries and the most job offers. Core branches like Mechanical and Civil see steady hiring, but average salaries are lower.

The Three Types of Job Offers

1. Top-Tier Jobs (Above ₹15 LPA)

Around 90+ top global companies visit the campus. These include famous names like Microsoft, Google, Amazon, Adobe, and Goldman Sachs. Getting these jobs is very hard. You need excellent coding skills, a high college score, and zero backlogs.

2. Mid-Tier Jobs (₹7 LPA to ₹15 LPA)

This group includes over 450 companies and is a great target for good students. Recruiters like Deloitte, IBM, Arcesium, and SAP Labs hire from here. Big companies like TCS also hire for their premium roles here, paying between ₹9 LPA and ₹11.5 LPA.

3. Mass Hiring & Factory Jobs (₹3.5 LPA to ₹6 LPA)

This is where the largest number of students get jobs. Large tech service companies like Wipro, Cognizant, and Capgemini hire hundreds of students at once. For core engineering branches, companies like Mahindra, Ashok Leyland, and L&T provide standard engineering roles in this price bracket.

The Big Competition

Because Chandigarh University takes in thousands of engineering students, the competition for the best jobs is fierce. You have to stand out from the crowd early on.

How to Succeed as a Student

- **Keep a high college score (CGPA):** Try to stay above 8.0 or 8.5. Many top companies will not even let you take their exam if your score is too low.
- **Manage your time well:** The university strictly requires 75% attendance. You must balance your daily classes with extra study time for interviews.
- **Get an internship early:** Companies offer internships that pay up to ₹1.3 Lakh per month. Getting an internship early is the easiest way to secure a permanent job before your final year begins.
