A Guide to the Admission Process After the Exam

Overview of KMAT Kerala Counselling

KMAT Kerala counselling is held after the declaration of KMAT Kerala results. The KMAT Kerala counselling dates are announced on the official website of the participating institutions, and candidates can apply to the college/institute accepting KMAT Kerala scores of their choice through counselling.

Eligible candidates are given the opportunity to participate in the KMAT Kerala counselling process, which includes Group Discussion and Personal Interviews (GD/PI). Dates of GD/PI may vary for different colleges, hence candidates must keep a check on the announcement of dates and process.

Documents Required for KMAT Kerala Counselling

To participate in KMAT Kerala counselling or GD/PI, students must be present in person and carry the following documents:

- KMAT Kerala scorecard
- KMAT Kerala admit card
- Date of Birth certificate
- Class 10 marksheet
- Class 12 marksheet
- Graduation marksheet
- Transfer certificate
- Migration certificate
- Caste certificate
- Domicile certificate

If a candidate does not reach the counselling and GD/PI venue on the scheduled date, their seat will be offered to the next student.

The weightage of the KMAT Kerala selection rounds is as follows:
