

Rajasthan PTET 2026

Exam Centre — State Wise Details

The Rajasthan Pre Teacher Education Test (PTET) 2026 is conducted by Vardhman Mahaveer Open University (VMOU), Kota, for admission to two-year B.Ed and four-year integrated B.A. B.Ed / B.Sc. B.Ed courses. The PTET 2026 exam was held on June 14, 2026, in offline (pen-and-paper) mode across designated centres throughout Rajasthan.

How PTET Exam Centres Are Organised

PTET exam centres are organised into different zones across the state so that candidates can select a convenient location nearby. The exam authority allocates centres based on candidates' home districts, or as close to their home address as possible, subject to seat availability at each centre.

Exam Centre Zones (Major Cities)

PTET exam centres are set up across Rajasthan's major divisions/cities. The table below lists the broad zones under which exam centres are typically organised.

Zone / Division	Major City
Jaipur Zone	Jaipur
Jodhpur Zone	Jodhpur
Kota Zone	Kota
Udaipur Zone	Udaipur
Ajmer Zone	Ajmer
Bikaner Zone	Bikaner

Note: These are broad divisional zones; the specific centre name, complete address, and exact locality within the allotted city are confirmed only on each candidate's individual admit card.

How to Check Your Allotted Exam Centre

1. Visit the official PTET 2026 exam portal, ptetvmoukota2026.in, and open the admit card link.
2. Log in using your login ID/application number and date of birth.
3. Your hall ticket will display the allotted exam centre, address, reporting time, and shift.
4. Download and print the admit card; carry it to the centre along with a valid photo ID.

Important Points About Exam Centres

- The exact centre address is confirmed only on the admit card — always verify it before travelling.
- The conducting body (VMOU, Kota) may add, remove, or reassign centres, including allotting a different centre than the one opted for.
- No requests for changing the allotted centre are entertained once allocation is complete.

Documents & Guidelines for Exam Day

Candidates should carry the following essentials to the PTET 2026 exam centre. Entry is not permitted without these documents.

- PTET 2026 Admit Card (printed copy, valid and downloaded from the official portal).
- A valid government-issued photo ID — Aadhaar Card, PAN Card, Voter ID, or Driving Licence.
- A recent passport-size photograph, matching the one uploaded during registration (carry a spare if required by the centre).
- A blue or black ball-point pen.

Exam Day Guidelines

- Reach the exam centre well before the reporting time mentioned on the admit card, since late entry after the exam begins is generally not allowed.
- The PTET exam is conducted in offline, pen-and-paper mode and runs for a duration of 3 hours, covering Mental Ability, Teaching Attitude & Aptitude, General Awareness, and Language Proficiency.
- Follow all instructions given by exam invigilators regarding seating, conduct, and permitted items inside the exam hall.
- Restricted items such as mobile phones, smartwatches, calculators, and other electronic devices are typically not allowed inside the centre — check the official admit card/instructions for the complete prohibited list.
